## INTRODUCTION

This vanity features a rustic design with a standing pedestal cabinet, a boat marble ceramic sink, and a natural wood texture finish. 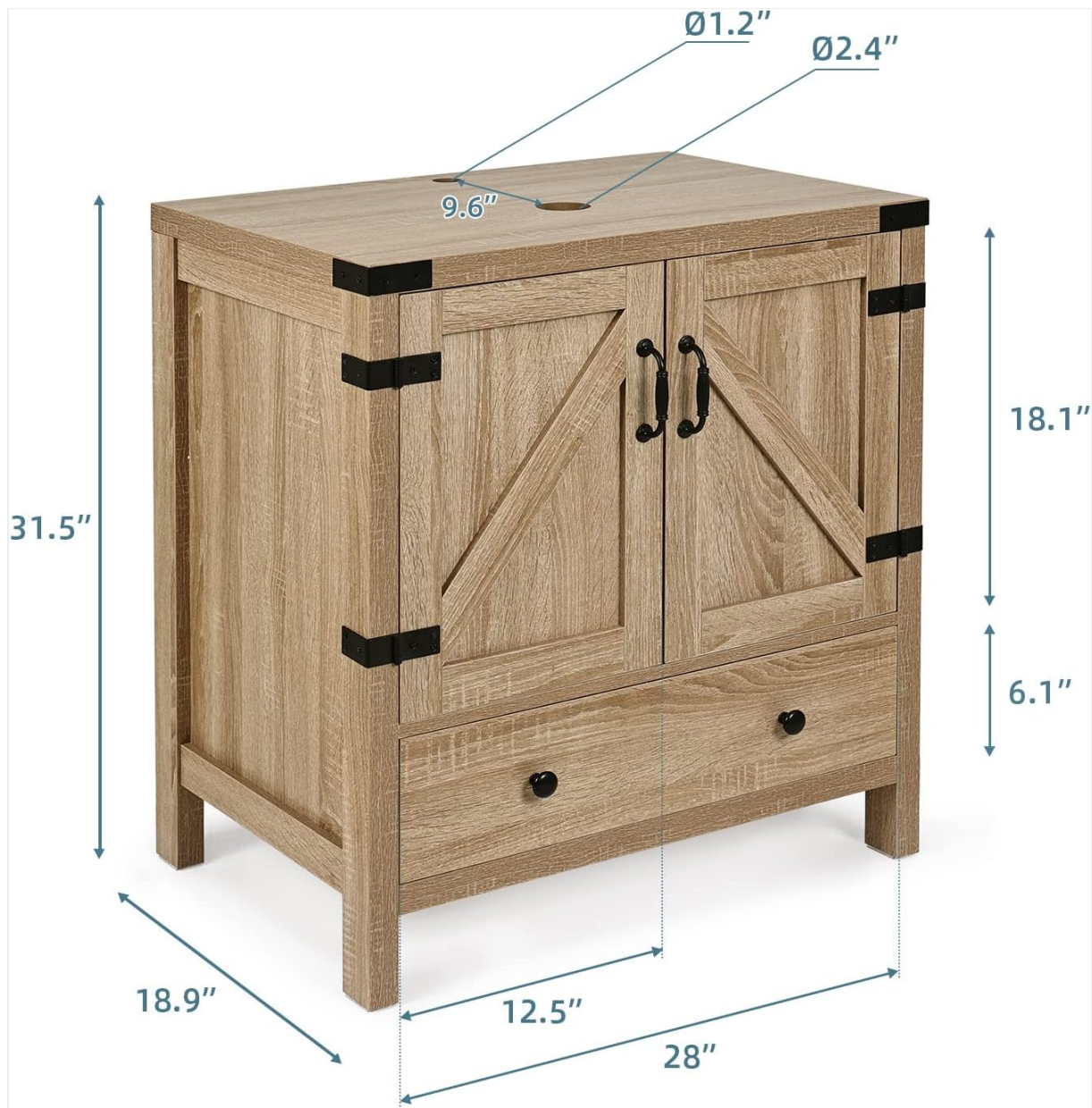

### SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

This vanity requires self-assembly. It is recommended to have two people for assembly due to the size and weight of some components. Please refer to the included installation manual for detailed diagrams and step-by-step instructions. Ensure you have all tools required before starting.

#### General Assembly Steps:

- Unpack and Inspect:** Carefully unpack both packages. Lay out all parts and hardware. Compare them with the parts list in your included manual to ensure nothing is missing or damaged.
- Assemble the Cabinet Frame:** Follow the instructions to connect the side panels, back panel, and bottom panel of the vanity cabinet using the provided hardware. Ensure all connections are tight and stable.
- Install Drawer Slides and Shelf:** Attach the drawer slides to the cabinet interior and assemble the drawer. Install any internal shelves as per the manual.
- Attach Doors and Handles:** Mount the cabinet doors using the hinges provided. Install the zinc alloy handles on both the doors and the drawer. The magnetic door mechanism ensures smooth closing.
- Place the Sink:** Carefully position the boat marble ceramic sink onto the top of the assembled vanity cabinet. Ensure it is centered and stable.

6. **Install Faucet and Drain:** Mount the faucet onto the sink according to the manufacturer's instructions. Install the pop-up drain assembly into the sink.
7. **Connect Water Lines:** Connect the hot and cold water lines from your wall supply to the faucet. Ensure all connections are sealed properly to prevent leaks. It is recommended to have a qualified plumber perform this step.
8. **Secure Vanity to Wall (Optional but Recommended):** For added stability, especially in homes with children or pets, secure the vanity to the wall using anti-tip hardware (if included or purchased separately).

### OPERATION

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The SOLIDEE bathroom vanity is designed for standard bathroom use. The cabinet doors feature a magnetic closure for smooth and effortless operation, providing access to the main storage area. The bottom drawer offers additional space for smaller items. The ceramic sink and faucet function as a typical bathroom basin for washing and hygiene.

### MAINTENANCE

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Proper care will extend the life and appearance of your vanity.

- **Cleaning the Cabinet:** Wipe the engineered wood surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that can damage the finish. Dry immediately to prevent water damage.
- **Cleaning the Sink:** The ceramic sink can be cleaned with mild soap and water. For stubborn stains, use a non-abrasive bathroom cleaner. Rinse thoroughly and wipe dry.
- **Faucet Care:** Clean the faucet with a soft cloth and mild soap. Avoid harsh chemicals that can strip the finish.
- **Preventing Water Damage:** Always wipe up water spills on the cabinet surfaces promptly, especially on the countertop area, to prevent swelling or discoloration of the engineered wood.
- **Hardware:** Periodically check and tighten any loose screws on handles, hinges, or drawer slides.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are solutions to common issues you might encounter:

| Drawer not closing smoothly  | Misaligned drawer slides; obstruction in the slide mechanism; loose screws. | Ensure drawer slides are properly aligned and secured. Check for any debris or objects blocking the slides. Tighten all screws on the drawer and slides.    |
| Cabinet doors do not align   | Hinges are loose or improperly adjusted.                                    | Adjust the screws on the hinges to align the doors. Refer to the assembly manual for specific hinge adjustment instructions.                                |
| Vanity feels unstable/wobbly | Uneven floor; loose assembly connections.                                   | Ensure the vanity is on a level surface. If not, use shims under the legs. Re-tighten all assembly screws. Consider securing the vanity to the wall.        |
