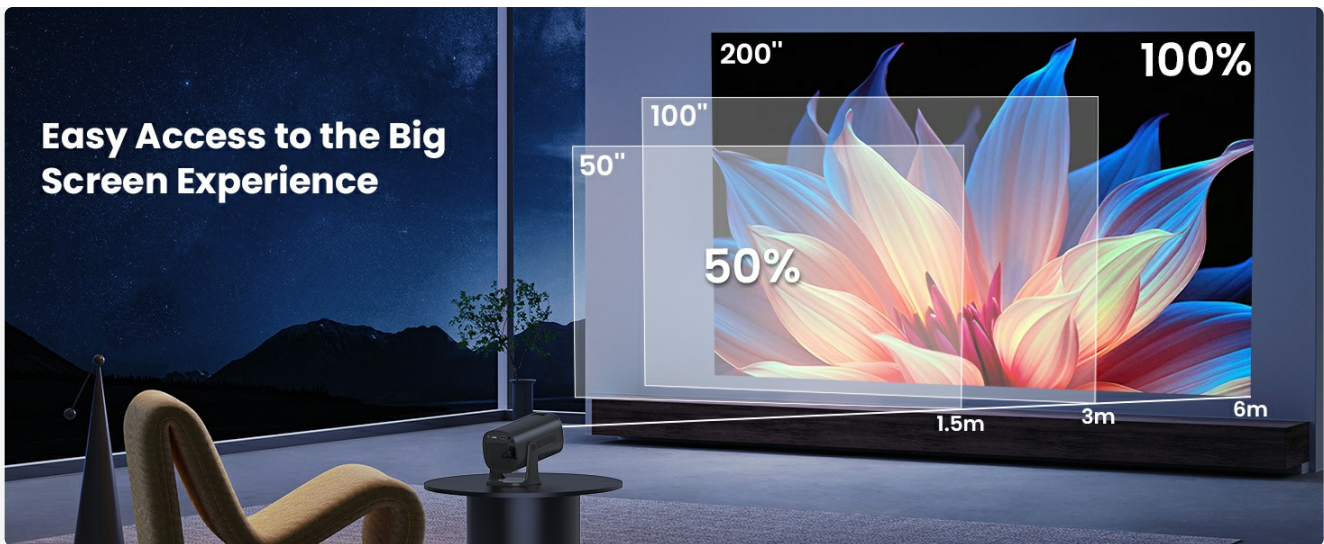


The AGIMA X3 Projector in a modern living room, showcasing its projection capabilities.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

To prevent fire, electric shock, or injury, please observe the following safety precautions:

- Do not block the ventilation openings. Ensure adequate space around the projector for proper airflow.
- Do not expose the projector to rain or moisture to avoid electric shock.
- Avoid looking directly into the projector lens when the lamp is on, as the bright light can cause eye damage.
- Use only the power adapter supplied with the projector.
- Do not attempt to disassemble or repair the projector yourself. Refer all servicing to qualified personnel.
- Keep the projector away from heat sources and direct sunlight.
- Ensure the projector is placed on a stable, level surface to prevent it from falling.
- The projector features intelligent eye protection, utilizing diffuse reflection imaging to filter blue light and protect your eyes during viewing.

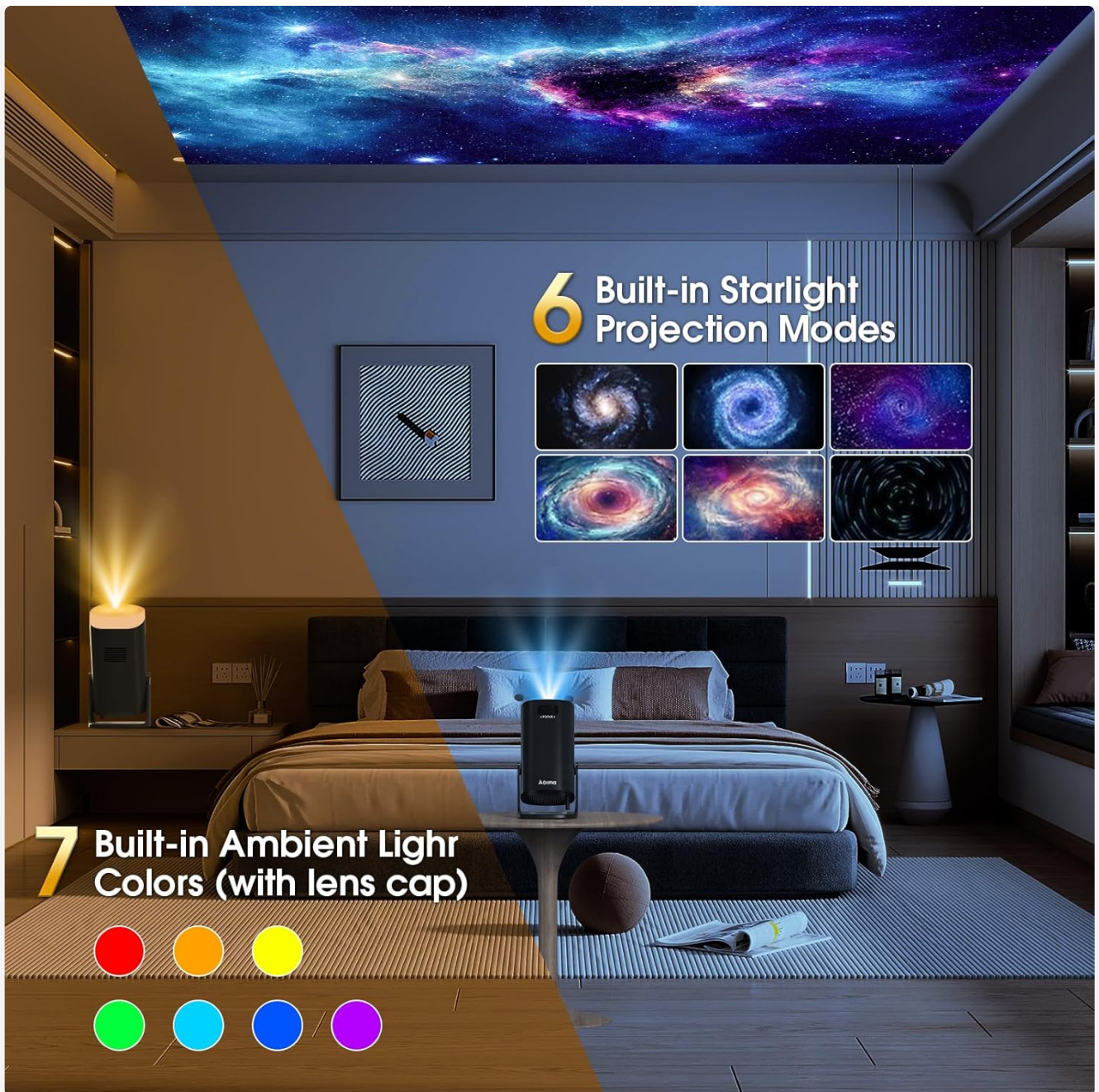
3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the projector's components:

Ports and Connections:

- **HDMI Port:** Connect to laptops, game consoles, TV sticks, etc.
- **USB Port:** Connect USB drives for media playback.
- **3.5mm Audio Jack:** Connect external headphones or speakers.
- **Power Input:** Connect the power adapter.

5. SETUP

5.1 Power Connection

1. Connect the power adapter to the projector's power input port.
2. Plug the power adapter into a wall outlet.
3. Press the power button on the projector or remote control to turn it on.

5.2 Placement and Projection

Position the projector on a stable surface. The AGIMA X3 is portable and can be mounted on a table. Adjust the projector's angle to achieve the desired screen position.

- **Projection Size:** The projector offers projection sizes from 39 inches to 200 inches.
- **Projection Distance:** Optimal viewing distances range from 4 feet to 25 feet.

5.3 Focus Adjustment

5.4 Automatic Keystone Correction

The AGIMA X3 features automatic keystone correction. This function automatically adjusts the image to be rectangular, even if the projector is placed at an angle. This eliminates the need for manual adjustments.

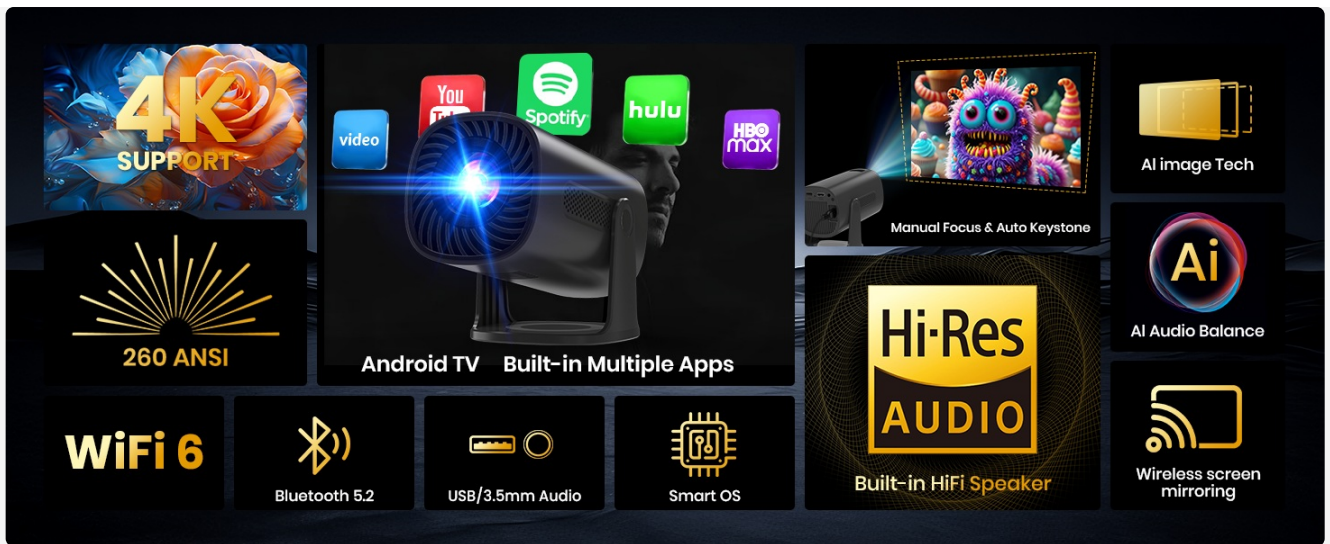

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Smart OS Navigation (Android TV)

The projector comes with an integrated Android TV OS, providing access to various applications directly. Use the remote control to navigate the interface.

- **Home Screen:** Access pre-installed apps like YouTube, Spotify, and Video.
- **App Store:** Download additional applications.
- **Settings:** Configure network, display, audio, and system preferences.

6.2 Connecting to Wi-Fi

To access online content and applications, connect your projector to a Wi-Fi network:

1. Go to **Settings** on the home screen.
2. Select **Network & Internet**.

6.3 Bluetooth Pairing

3. Turn on Bluetooth and select your device from the list to pair.

6.4 Connecting External Devices (HDMI, USB)

- **USB:** Insert a USB flash drive into the USB port to play media files directly.

6.5 Star Mode and Ambient Light

The AGIMA X3 offers unique visual modes:

- **Star Mode:** Choose from 6 dynamic galactic projection modes to create a romantic or meditative ambiance.
- **Ambient Light:** Select from 7 adjustable ambient light colors to transform your space and create a cinematic atmosphere.

6.6 Screen Mirroring (IOS/Android)

The projector supports wireless screen mirroring for both iOS and Android devices. Refer to the on-screen instructions or the projector's settings for specific steps to connect your smartphone or tablet.

6.7 Zoom Function

Adjust the projection size from 50% to 100% without moving the projector. This digital zoom feature allows for flexible installation and fine-tuning of the image size.

7. MAINTENANCE

7.1 Cleaning

- **Lens:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth specifically designed for optical lenses. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Casing:** Wipe the projector's exterior with a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn dirt, use a slightly damp cloth and then dry thoroughly.
- **Ventilation Openings:** Periodically clean the ventilation openings with a soft brush or compressed air to prevent dust buildup, which can affect performance and lifespan.

7.2 Storage

When not in use for an extended period, store the projector in a cool, dry place. Use the lens cap to protect the lens from dust and scratches.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your AGIMA X3 Projector, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No image projected	Power cable disconnected, incorrect input source, lens cap on.	Check power connection, select correct input source (HDMI/USB), remove lens cap.
Blurry image	Out of focus, incorrect keystone.	Adjust focus manually, ensure automatic keystone correction is active or adjust manually if needed.
No sound	Volume too low, external audio device not connected, incorrect audio output.	Increase volume, check Bluetooth connection, ensure internal speakers are selected or external audio is properly connected.
Wi-Fi connection issues	Incorrect password, out of range, router issues.	Verify password, move projector closer to router, restart router.
Remote control not working	Dead batteries, obstruction, out of range.	Replace batteries, remove obstructions, ensure line of sight to projector's IR receiver.
