PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Front Panel

- Video Output (CVBS): Yellow RCA connector for standard definition video.
- Left/Right Audio Output: White and Red RCA connectors for analog audio.
- Coaxial Output: For digital audio connection to compatible audio systems.
- HDMI Output: For high-definition video and audio connection to TVs or projectors.
- LAN Port: For network connection (not for streaming services).
- USB 2.0 Input: Additional USB port for media playback.
- Power Input: For connecting the power adapter.

SETUP

Follow these steps to connect your GIEC G2805 Blu-ray DVD Player to your TV or projector:

- 1. **Connect Power:** Plug the power cable into the player's power input and then into a wall outlet.
- 2. Connect to Display:
 - For High-Definition (Recommended): Connect one end of the included HDMI cable to the HDMI OUT port on the player and the other end to an HDMI input on your TV or projector.
 - For Standard Definition: Connect a composite video cable (yellow) to the Video Output port on the
 player and the corresponding input on your TV. Connect RCA audio cables (red and white) to the
 Left/Right Audio Output ports and the corresponding inputs on your TV or audio receiver.
- 3. Power On: Press the power button on the player or the remote control to turn on the device.
- 4. **Select Input:** On your TV or projector, select the correct HDMI or AV input source that corresponds to the connection you made in step 2.
- 5. **Initial Language Setting:** If the on-screen display is not in English, navigate to the settings menu to change the OSD (On-Screen Display) language. Refer to the "Language Settings" video below for a visual

guide.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Playing Discs

- 1. Press the **Eject** button on the player or remote to open the disc tray.
- 2. Place a Blu-ray or DVD disc onto the tray with the label side facing up.
- 3. Press the **Eject** button again to close the tray. The player will automatically begin loading the disc.
- 4. Use the remote control to navigate the disc menu and select your desired content.

Playing USB Media

- 1. Insert a USB storage device (max 128GB) or mobile hard drive (max 2TB) into one of the USB ports on the player.
- 2. Navigate to the "File Manager" option on the main interface using the remote control.
- 3. Select the desired video, audio, or picture file to begin playback.

Remote Control Functions

The included remote control provides full functionality for the player, including play, pause, stop, fast forward, rewind, menu navigation, and volume control. Ensure batteries are inserted correctly.

MAINTENANCE

- Keep the player in a clean, dry, and well-ventilated area.
- Avoid exposing the player to direct sunlight, high temperatures, or humidity.
- Clean the exterior of the player with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners or abrasive materials.
- Handle discs by their edges to prevent fingerprints and scratches. Clean discs with a soft, lint-free cloth

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Solution
No power.	Ensure the power cable is securely connected to both the player and a working power outlet.
No picture/sound.	Check HDMI or AV cable connections. Ensure the correct input source is selected on your TV/projector.
Disc does not play.	Check if the disc is clean and free of scratches. Ensure it is inserted correctly. Verify the disc format is supported (Region A Blu-ray, All Region DVDs).
Remote control not working.	Check and replace batteries if necessary. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the player.
Interface language is not English.	Access the settings menu and change the OSD language to English. Refer to the setup video for detailed steps.
