1. INTRODUCTION

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Weight Capacity:** The upper bunk has a maximum weight capacity of 250 lbs. The lower bunk has a maximum weight capacity of 350 lbs. Do not exceed these limits.
- **Recommended Age:** The upper bunk is suitable for children aged 6 years and older.
- **Guardrails:** The bunk bed is equipped with full-length guardrails on the upper bunk for safety. Ensure they are always securely in place.
