## INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and effective use of your TECKNET AF-2004 Rechargeable Personal Safety Alarm. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the device and retain it for future reference.

The TECKNET AF-2004 is a compact and portable personal safety device designed to emit a loud siren and a bright strobe light to attract attention and deter potential threats. It features a rechargeable battery and multiple activation methods for user convenience and safety.

## PRODUCT OVERVIEW

### Components

- Personal Safety Alarm Unit
- Keychain Attachment
- USB-C Charging Cable

### Key Features

- **130dB Siren:** Emits a loud, attention-grabbing sound.
- **SOS Strobe Light:** High-intensity flashing light for visibility and disorientation.
- **Rechargeable Battery:** Long standby time with USB-C charging.
- **Low Battery Indicator:** Notifies user when charging is needed.
- **Two Activation Modes:** Pull-pin and double-press button.
- **Compact and Portable:** Lightweight design with keychain for easy carrying.

## SETUP

### Initial Charge

Before first use, fully charge your personal safety alarm. Connect the provided USB-C cable to the charging port on the device and plug the other end into a standard USB power adapter (not included) or a computer USB port. The charging indicator light will show the charging status (e.g., red for charging, green for fully charged).

A full charge typically takes approximately 1.5 hours.

### Attaching to Keychain

Use the integrated keychain attachment to secure the alarm to your keys, bag, belt loop, or other easily accessible items. Ensure it is securely fastened to prevent accidental loss.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### Alarm Activation Modes

The TECKNET AF-2004 offers two methods for activating the alarm:

#### 1. Pull-Pin Activation:

To activate the alarm, firmly pull the ring-shaped pin away from the main unit. The 130dB siren and strobe light will activate instantly.

To deactivate, reinsert the pin fully into the alarm unit.

## 2. Button Activation:

For a more discreet activation, double-press the button located on the side of the alarm. This will also trigger the 130dB siren and strobe light.

To deactivate, press and hold the button for approximately 4 seconds.

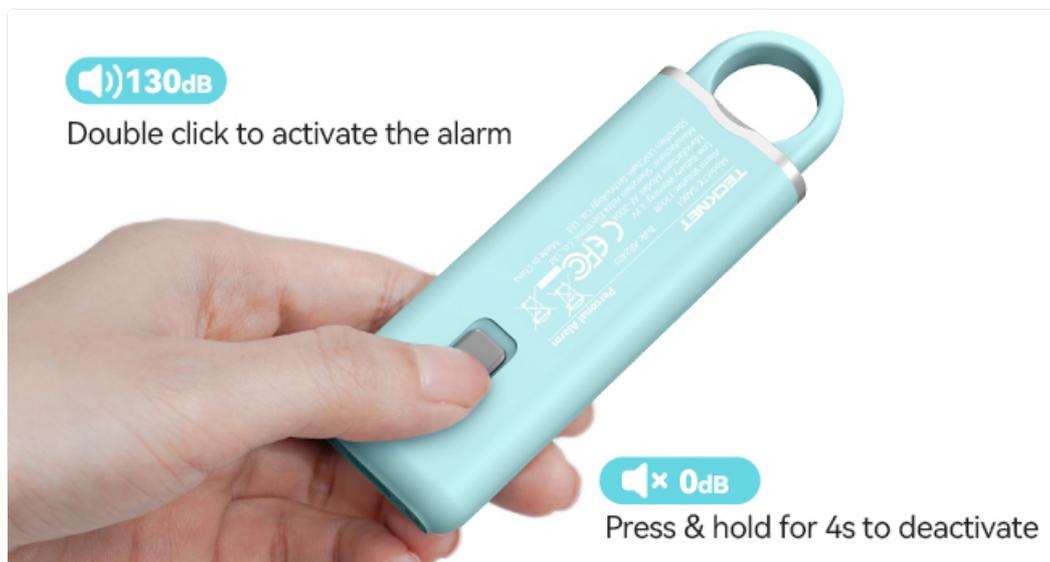


Image: Illustration of double-clicking the side button to activate the alarm and pressing and holding to deactivate.

## Light Modes

The integrated LED light can be used independently of the alarm function:

- **1st Click:** Activates the flashlight mode (steady light).
- **2nd Click:** Activates the flashing mode (strobe light).
- **3rd Click:** Turns off the light.

## MAINTENANCE

### Charging

The alarm features a low battery indicator to alert you when charging is required. Connect the USB-C cable to a power source. A full charge provides:

- Up to 500 days of standby time.
- Up to 90 minutes of continuous alarm sound.
- Up to 5 hours of continuous flashing light.
- Up to 3 hours of continuous steady light.

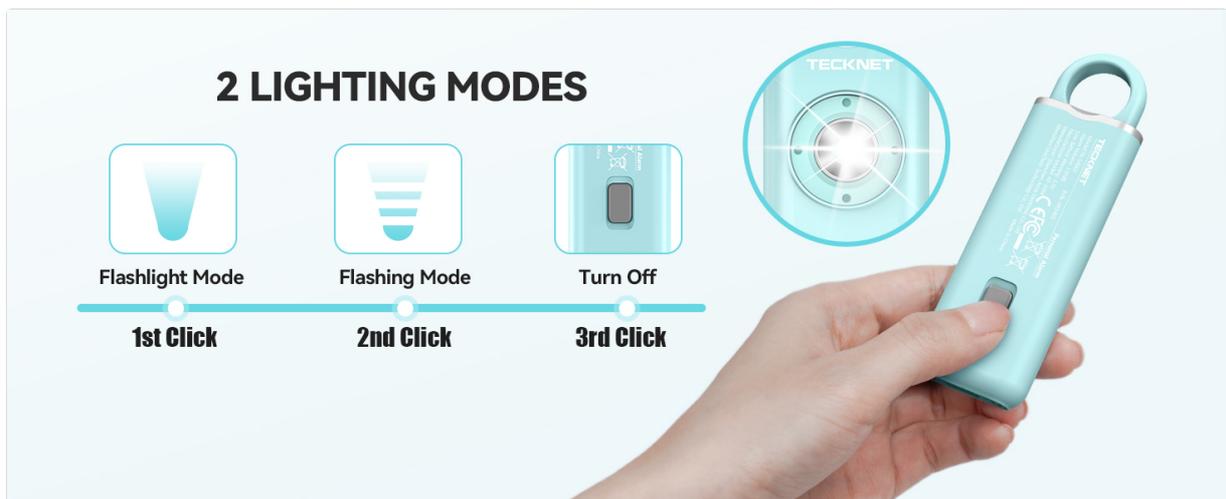


Image: Details on the impressive battery life of the TECKNET alarm, including standby time and usage duration for alarm and light functions.

### Cleaning and Storage

- Wipe the device with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Store the alarm in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Ensure the device is fully charged before storing for extended periods to maintain battery health.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Alarm does not activate.	Low battery; Pin not fully pulled; Button not double-pressed or held correctly.	Charge the device; Ensure pin is fully removed; Double-press the button quickly or press and hold for deactivation.
Light does not turn on.	Low battery; Button not pressed correctly.	Charge the device; Press the button once for steady light, twice for flashing light.
Alarm sounds weak.	Low battery.	Charge the device fully.

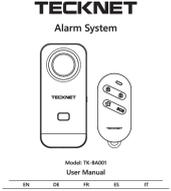
