1. Introduction

This manual provides essential information for the proper use and maintenance of your BoxWave DirectSync USB-B to USB-C Cable. 2. SETUP AND CONNECTION

- 2. **Connect USB-B:** Gently insert the USB-B connector of the DirectSync cable into the corresponding USB-B port on your device. Ensure it is fully seated.
- 3. **Connect USB Type-C:** Insert the USB Type-C connector of the DirectSync cable into the USB Type-C port on your computer, laptop, or charging adapter.
- 4. **Verify Connection:** Once both ends are connected, your devices should recognize each other for data transfer or begin charging, depending on the function.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The DirectSync cable facilitates two primary functions: data synchronization and power delivery (charging).

3.1 Data Synchronization

To transfer data between your USB-B device and a USB Type-C computer:

- Connect the cable as described in the "Setup and Connection" section.
- Ensure your computer's operating system recognizes the connected device. This may involve installing specific drivers for your USB-B device if prompted.

• No Connection/Recognition:

- Ensure both ends of the cable are securely plugged into their respective ports.
- Try connecting to a different USB Type-C port on your computer or a different USB-B device to isolate the issue.
- Restart your computer and the connected device.
- Check your device's manual for specific connection requirements or driver installations.

· Slow Data Transfer:

- Ensure both connected devices support USB 3.0 or higher for optimal speeds.
- Close any unnecessary applications running on your computer that might be consuming system resources.
- Verify the cable is not damaged.

• Not Charging:

- Confirm the USB Type-C power adapter or port is functional and provides sufficient power.
- Check your device's charging port for any debris that might obstruct the connection.
- Try a different charging source.
