Suffocation Hazard

- **USE ONLY** the mattress provided by the manufacturer.
- **ALWAYS** place baby on their back to reduce the risk of SIDS and suffocation.
- If a sheet is used with the pad/mattress, use only the one provided by the product manufacturer or one specifically designed to fit the dimensions of the product mattress.

Fall Hazard

- Always check that the bassinet is securely locked on the base/stand by pulling upwards on the bassinet.

- A bedside sleeper is designed to provide a sleeping area for an infant until they begin to push up on hands and knees or are approximately 5 months of age. Move your child to another sleeping product when your child reaches this stage.

Entrapment Hazard

- To prevent death from entrapment, the bedside sleeper must be properly secured to the adult bed using the attachment system.

- There must be no more than 1/2 inch (13 mm) gap between the bedside sleeper and the adult bed.
- Check tightness before each use by pulling the bedside sleeper in a direction away from the adult bed.
- If the gap exceeds 1/2 inch (13 mm), **DO NOT** use the product.
- Do not fill the gap with pillows, blankets, or other items that are suffocation hazards.
- This bedside sleeper is designed for use only with adult beds between 22.05 and 27.17 inches from the floor to the top of the adult mattress.
- To avoid death from the infant's neck being caught on the top rail on the side that is next to the adult bed, the top rail must be no higher than the adult bed mattress.

General Warnings

- Always read and follow the manufacturer's assembly instructions for each product use mode (bedside sleeper or bassinet).
- Always use **ALL** required parts for each use mode. Check the instruction manual for a list of required parts.
- Periodically check the product for loose, damaged, or missing parts.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Larex Baby Bassinet (Model BSC002) is a versatile 3-in-1 product designed for newborns and infants up to approximately 5 months or 9 kg (19.84 lbs). It functions as a standalone bassinet, a bedside sleeper, and features adjustable height and portable design with wheels.

PARTS LIST

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Follow these steps to assemble your Larex Baby Bassinet. It can be assembled or disassembled in a few minutes.

1. Insert the Height Adjustable Bars into the Sleeper Frame.
2. Attach the Bottom Legs to the Height Adjustable Bars.
3. Connect the Crossbar between the two Bottom Legs.
4. Insert the Stabilizing Bars into the Sleeper Frame.
5. Place the Mattress securely inside the Sleeper Frame.
6. Ensure all connections are firm and secure before use.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Bedside Sleeper Mode

To use the bassinet as a bedside sleeper, unzip the side panel and lower it. This allows for easy access to

your baby for nursing or comforting during the night. Ensure the bassinet is securely attached to the adult bed using the provided fixing belts and that there is no gap between the bassinet and the bed.

Height Adjustment

The bassinet features 7 adjustable height positions to match the height of most standard US beds and sofas. Adjust the height by pressing the buttons on the height adjustable bars and sliding the bassinet to the desired level. Ensure both sides are adjusted to the same height for stability.

7 Height Adjustments

Make it easier to get a customized fit.

Portability and Wheels

The Larex Baby Bassinet is equipped with silent universal wheels with brakes, allowing for easy movement between rooms. To move, unlock the brakes on the wheels. To secure the bassinet in place, engage the wheel brakes.
