1. INTRODUCTION

2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- **Secure Installation:** Ensure the coop is installed on a level, stable surface. Use the provided ground nails and additional anchoring if necessary to prevent tipping in strong winds.
- **Check for Damage:** Before assembly, inspect all components for any damage. Do not proceed with assembly if parts are damaged. Contact customer support for replacements.
- **Keep Children and Pets Away:** Keep children and pets away from the assembly area to prevent accidents.
- **Proper Ventilation:** Ensure adequate ventilation within the coop for the well-being of your animals.
- **Predator Protection:** While the mesh provides protection, regularly inspect for any signs of damage

or weak points that could compromise security against predators.

3. COMPONENTS LIST

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly is designed to be straightforward, but it is recommended to have at least two people for easier setup. Follow the professional instructions provided in the packaging for detailed, step-by-step guidance.

1. **Prepare the Area:** Choose a level, clear outdoor space for the coop. Ensure adequate drainage.
2. **Assemble the Frame:** Connect the galvanized steel pipes according to the diagrams in the instruction manual. Utilize the quick spring clasp connections and ensure all joints are securely fastened. The improved pole connections enhance stability.
3. **Attach the Wire Mesh:** Unroll the coated hexagonal wire mesh and secure it to the frame using the provided zip ties or fasteners. Ensure the mesh is taut and covers all open sides to prevent gaps. The small gaps in the mesh provide extra protection against predators.
4. **Install the Door:** Attach the door frame and hinge mechanism. Ensure the security lock functions correctly.
5. **Secure to the Ground:** Use the ground nails to anchor the coop firmly to the earth. For added stability, especially in windy conditions, consider additional heavy-duty anchors.
6. **Install the Waterproof Cover:** Drape the 420D Oxford cloth cover over the domed roof. Secure it using the strong straps or bungee cords, ensuring it is taut and covers the designated area to provide protection from sun, rain, and snow. The pitched roof design allows for runoff.

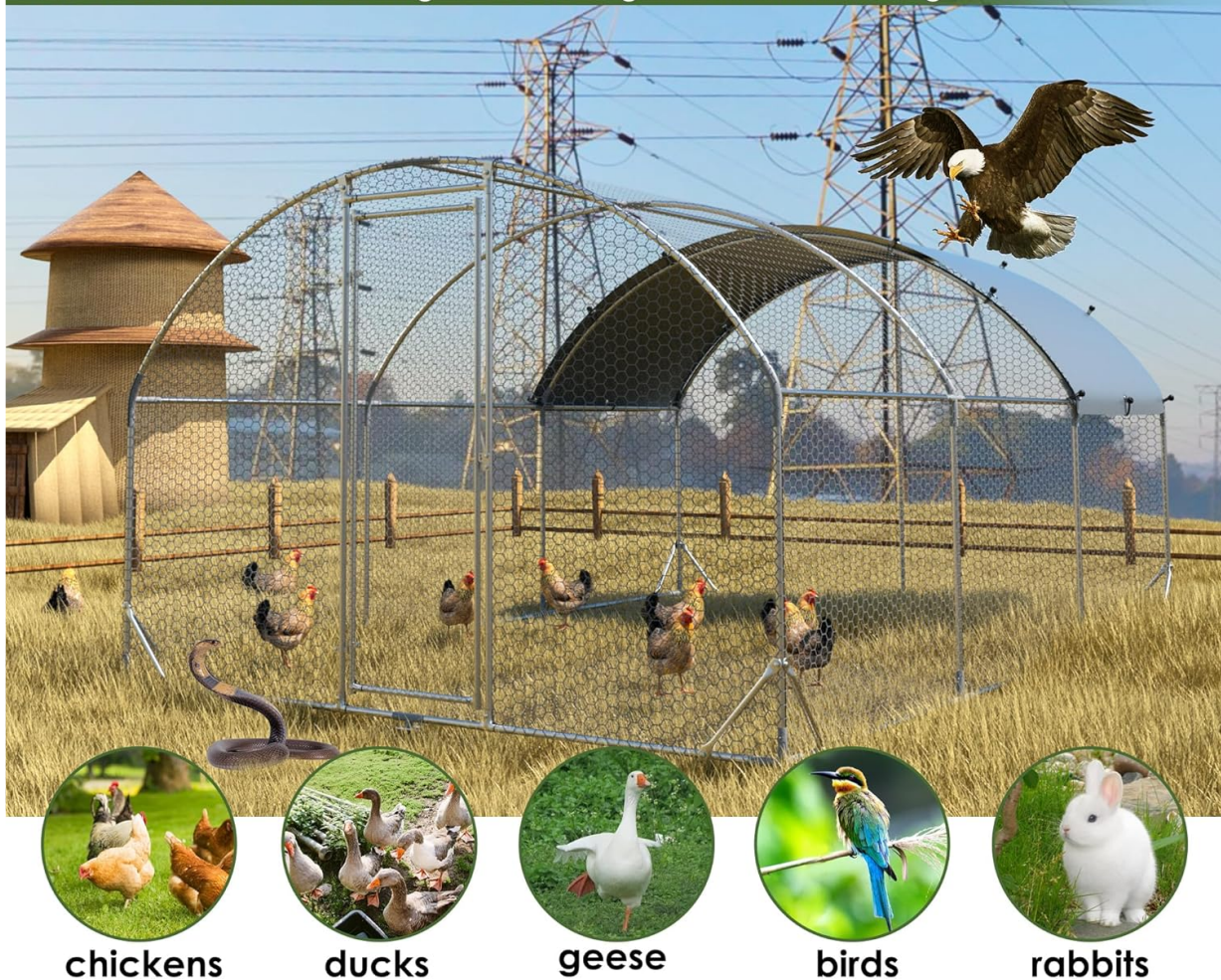
5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The kejector chicken coop provides a versatile and spacious enclosure for various animals.

- **Animal Capacity:** The 3-Unit Domed Roof model is designed to accommodate approximately 20-30 domestic fowl, such as chickens, ducks, or geese. It is also suitable for rabbits, cats, small dogs, and other similar-sized animals.
- **Daily Use:** Ensure the security lock on the door is always engaged when animals are inside to prevent escape and protect against predators.
- **Space for Activity:** The large interior provides ample room for animals to play, rest, and roam freely, promoting their well-being.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will extend the lifespan of your kejector chicken coop and ensure the safety and comfort of your animals.

- **Cleaning:** Periodically clean the interior of the coop to maintain hygiene. The metal frame can be wiped down with a damp cloth.
- **Cover Care:** The 420D Oxford cloth cover can be cleaned with mild soap and water. Ensure it is completely dry before re-installing or storing to prevent mildew.
- **Inspect Mesh:** Regularly check the hexagonal wire mesh for any tears, holes, or loose fastenings. Repair or reinforce as needed to maintain predator protection.
- **Check Connections:** Periodically inspect all frame connections, bolts, and ground anchors to ensure they remain tight and secure. Tighten any loose components.
- **Seasonal Adjustments:** In areas with heavy snowfall, it is advisable to clear snow from the roof to prevent excessive weight accumulation.

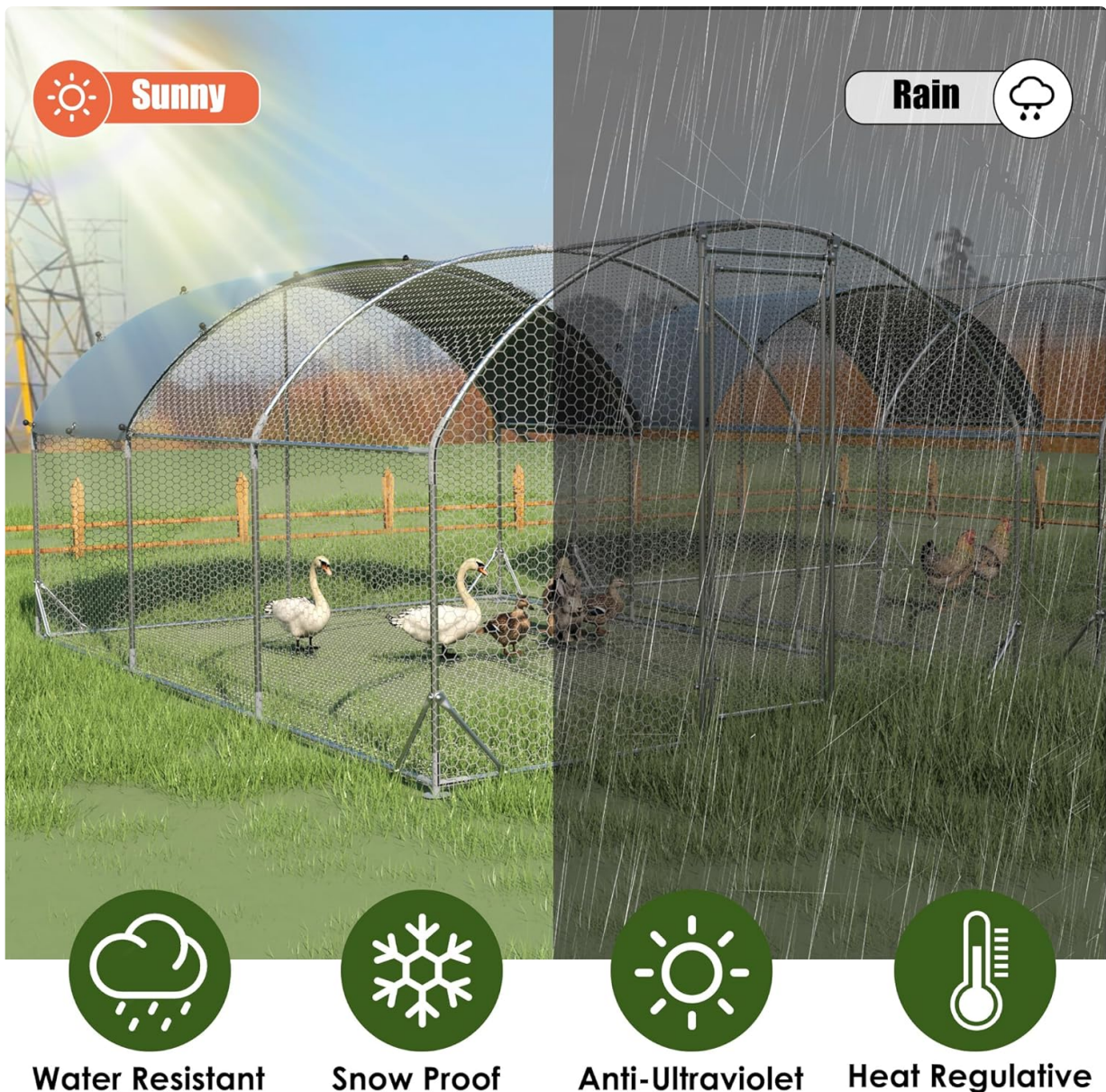


Image: The coop's weather resistance, demonstrating its ability to protect animals from sun, rain, and snow.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your chicken coop, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

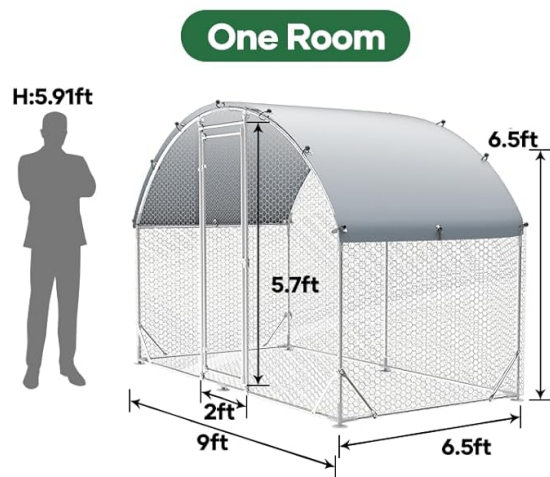
Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Coop feels unstable or wobbly.	Loose frame connections; insufficient ground anchoring.	Ensure all pipe connections are fully engaged and tightened. Verify ground nails are firmly in place. Consider adding more robust anchors or sandbags.
Wire mesh is sagging or has gaps.	Insufficient zip ties/fasteners; mesh not pulled taut during installation.	Add more zip ties, ensuring they are evenly spaced and tight. Re-tension the mesh where possible.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Water pooling on the roof cover.	Cover not taut; improper installation.	Re-adjust the cover, ensuring it is pulled taut and secured with all bungee cords/straps. Verify the pitched roof design is maintained.
Door does not close or lock properly.	Misaligned frame; debris in latch mechanism.	Check if the coop frame is square and level. Clear any obstructions from the lock and latch. Lubricate if necessary.

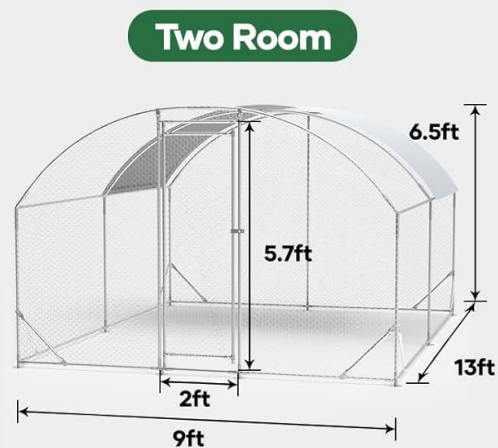

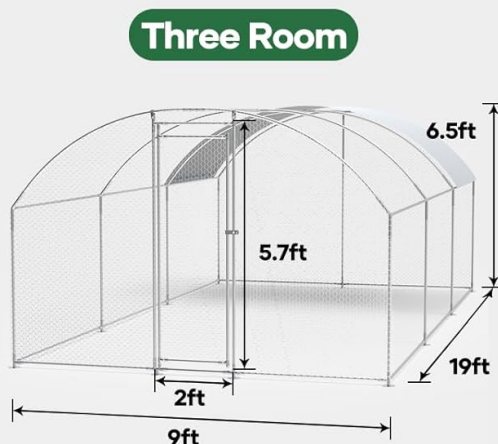

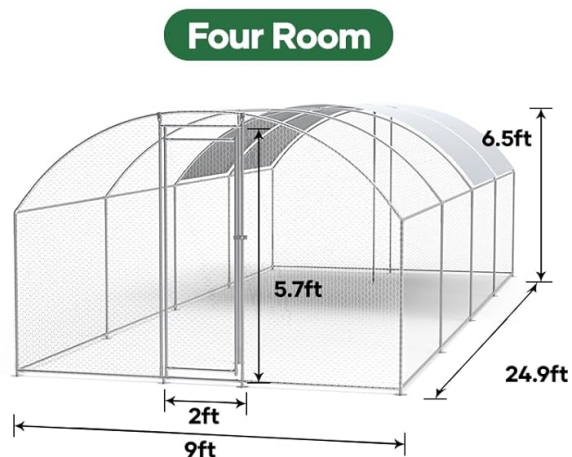
