# Silva Homeline BS 8000 Vacuum Cleaner

## USER MANUAL

### 1. Important Safety Instructions

---

Please read all instructions carefully before using the appliance and retain them for future reference. Failure to follow these instructions may result in electric shock, fire, or serious injury.

- Ensure the voltage indicated on the rating label corresponds to your mains voltage before connecting the appliance.
- Do not use the vacuum cleaner near water or in wet conditions.
- Always unplug the appliance from the power outlet before cleaning, maintenance, or when not in use.
- Do not allow children to operate the vacuum cleaner without supervision.
- Avoid vacuuming hot ashes, sharp objects, liquids, or flammable materials.
- Do not operate the appliance with a damaged cord or plug. Contact qualified service personnel for repair.
- Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all parts of the body away from openings and moving parts.

### 2. Product Overview

---

The Silva Homeline BS 8000 is a cylinder vacuum cleaner designed for efficient household cleaning. It features a metal telescopic tube, motor filter, and HEPA filter for improved air quality.

### **Components:**

- Main Unit (with motor and dust bag compartment)
- Flexible Hose
- Metal Telescopic Tube
- Floor Nozzle
- Dust Bag (inside main unit)
- Motor Filter (pre-motor filter)

- HEPA Filter (exhaust filter)
- Power Cord with Plug

### 3. Setup

---

Follow these steps to assemble your vacuum cleaner before first use:

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Retain packaging for storage or future transport.
2. **Attach Flexible Hose:** Insert the end of the flexible hose into the suction inlet on the main unit until it clicks securely into place.
3. **Assemble Telescopic Tube and Nozzle:** Connect the handle end of the flexible hose to the metal telescopic tube. Then, attach the floor nozzle to the other end of the telescopic tube. Ensure all connections are firm.
4. **Check Dust Bag:** Open the dust bag compartment (refer to the 'Maintenance' section for location) and ensure a dust bag is correctly installed.
5. **Connect to Power:** Extend the power cord and plug it into a suitable electrical outlet.

### 4. Operating the Vacuum Cleaner

---

Once assembled, your vacuum cleaner is ready for use.

1. **Power On/Off:** Press the power button located on the main unit to switch the vacuum cleaner on. Press it again to switch off.
2. **Adjust Suction Power:** If your model features a suction control dial or slider, adjust it according to the surface being cleaned (e.g., lower for delicate fabrics, higher for carpets).
3. **Vacuuming:** Guide the floor nozzle over the surface to be cleaned. For optimal results, move the nozzle slowly and steadily.
4. **Cord Rewind:** After use, unplug the power cord from the outlet. Press the cord rewind button (if available) to automatically retract the cord into the main unit.

### 5. Maintenance

---

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your vacuum cleaner.

#### 5.1. Emptying/Replacing the Dust Bag

- Always unplug the vacuum cleaner before performing any maintenance.
- Open the dust bag compartment cover, usually located on the top or front of the main unit.
- Carefully remove the full dust bag. Dispose of it according to local regulations.
- Insert a new, genuine Silva Homeline dust bag, ensuring it is correctly seated in the holder.
- Close the dust bag compartment cover securely.

#### 5.2. Cleaning Filters

Your BS 8000 vacuum cleaner is equipped with a motor filter and a HEPA filter.

- **Motor Filter:** This filter protects the motor from dust. It is typically located behind the dust bag. Remove and tap it gently to dislodge dust. Replace if heavily soiled or damaged.
- **HEPA Filter:** The HEPA filter is usually located at the exhaust of the vacuum cleaner. It captures fine

particles and allergens. Check this filter regularly. If it is washable, rinse it under cold running water and allow it to air dry completely before reinserting. If not washable, replace it when visibly dirty.

- Ensure all filters are completely dry before reassembling the vacuum cleaner.

### 5.3. Cleaning the Exterior

Wipe the exterior surfaces of the vacuum cleaner with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

## 6. Troubleshooting

---

If you encounter issues with your vacuum cleaner, refer to the table below for common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Vacuum cleaner does not switch on.	No power supply.	Check if the plug is securely inserted into the outlet. Check the fuse/circuit breaker.
Low suction power.	Full dust bag, clogged filters, or blockage in hose/nozzle.	Replace dust bag. Clean motor and HEPA filters. Check hose and nozzle for obstructions.
Unusual noise during operation.	Foreign object in the fan or motor, or damaged component.	Switch off and unplug. Inspect for foreign objects. If noise persists, contact customer support.
Dust escaping from the vacuum cleaner.	Dust bag not installed correctly, or filters are missing/damaged.	Ensure dust bag is correctly seated. Check and replace filters if necessary.
