1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the MEETION BTM011 Ergonomic Wireless Bluetooth Vertical Mouse. This device is designed to provide a comfortable and efficient computing experience by promoting a natural hand position, reducing wrist strain. It offers versatile connectivity options for multiple devices and adjustable precision to suit various tasks.

Ergonomic Design

Keep Your Wrist and Arm in a Straight Line



The ergonomic design of the MEETION vertical mouse helps maintain a natural hand and wrist posture, reducing discomfort compared to traditional mice.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the various components and buttons of your MEETION BTM011 mouse.

1. **Left Button:** Standard left-click function.
2. **Right Button:** Standard right-click function.
3. **Scroll Wheel:** For scrolling up and down.
4. **Forward Button:** Navigates forward in web browsers or file explorers.
5. **Back Button:** Navigates backward in web browsers or file explorers.
6. **DPI Switch Button:** Adjusts cursor sensitivity.
7. **Mode Switching Button:** Switches between 2.4G, Bluetooth 1, and Bluetooth 2 modes.
8. **Power Switch (ON/OFF):** Turns the mouse on or off.
9. **Battery Compartment:** Located at the bottom, for 1x AA battery and USB receiver storage.

4. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Battery Installation

The mouse requires one AA battery (not included).

1. Locate the battery compartment cover on the bottom of the mouse.
2. Slide the cover open.
3. Insert one AA battery, ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
4. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

Six Functional Buttons



Insert one AA battery into the compartment. The USB receiver is also stored here.

4.2 Power On/Off

Slide the power switch located on the bottom of the mouse to the "ON" position to turn it on. Slide to "OFF" to conserve battery when not in use.

4.3 Connectivity Modes

The MEETION BTM011 mouse supports three connection modes: 2.4GHz wireless (via USB receiver) and two independent Bluetooth 5.3 channels (BT1 and BT2). You can connect to up to three devices simultaneously and switch between them.

The mouse supports 2.4G wireless and two Bluetooth 5.3 connections for seamless switching between devices.

4.4 2.4GHz USB Connection

1. Take out the USB receiver from the battery compartment of the mouse.
2. Insert the USB receiver into an available USB-A port on your computer. If your computer only has USB-C ports, use the provided USB-A to USB-C adapter.
3. Turn on the mouse using the power switch.
4. Press the Mode Switching Button until the 2.4G Connection Indicator (green light) lights up. The mouse should now be connected.

4.5 Bluetooth Connection (BT1 / BT2)

1. Turn on the mouse using the power switch.
2. Press the Mode Switching Button to select either Bluetooth 1 (BT1) or Bluetooth 2 (BT2). The corresponding blue indicator light will blink, indicating pairing mode.
3. On your device (computer, laptop, tablet, smartphone), go to Bluetooth settings.
4. Search for new devices. You should find "Meetion_MS_BT1" or "Meetion_MS_BT2".
5. Select the device to pair. Once paired, the blue indicator light will stop blinking and remain solid for a few seconds.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 DPI Adjustment

The mouse features 4 adjustable DPI levels: 1200, 1600, 2400, and 3200. Press the DPI Switch Button (located behind the scroll wheel) to cycle through these settings. Each press changes the cursor speed, allowing you to select the precision suitable for your task.

Adjust the DPI to match your preference for cursor speed and precision.

5.2 Multi-Device Switching

To switch between connected devices, simply press the Mode Switching Button located on the bottom of the mouse. The corresponding indicator light (green for 2.4G, blue for BT1/BT2) will illuminate to show the active connection.

5.3 Forward/Back Buttons

Use the Forward and Back buttons, conveniently located on the side of the mouse, for quick navigation in web browsers, file explorers, and other applications that support these functions.

6. POWER MANAGEMENT

6.1 Auto-Sleep Mode

To conserve battery life, the mouse will automatically enter sleep mode after 20 minutes of inactivity. This intelligent feature helps extend the battery's operational time.

6.2 Waking the Mouse

To wake the mouse from sleep mode, simply press any button. It will instantly reconnect to the last active device.

6.3 Battery Life

With typical usage, a single AA battery can power the mouse for up to 3 months. Actual battery life may vary based on usage patterns and battery quality.

7. MAINTENANCE

To ensure optimal performance and longevity of your mouse, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the surface of the mouse. For stubborn dirt, a slightly damp cloth can be used, but ensure no moisture enters the device. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Battery Replacement:** Replace the AA battery when the low battery indicator lights up or when mouse performance degrades. Always dispose of used batteries responsibly.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, turn off the mouse and store it in a dry, cool place.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your MEETION BTM011 mouse, refer to the following solutions:

Problem	Solution
Mouse not responding	Ensure the mouse is turned ON. Check if the battery is inserted correctly and has sufficient charge. Replace if necessary. Verify the correct connection mode (2.4G, BT1, or BT2) is selected. For 2.4G, ensure the USB receiver is securely plugged into the computer. Try a different USB port. For Bluetooth, ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your device and the mouse is paired. Try re-pairing.
Cursor movement is erratic or slow	Clean the optical sensor on the bottom of the mouse. Ensure you are using the mouse on a suitable surface (non-reflective, non-transparent). Adjust the DPI setting using the DPI Switch Button. Check battery level. Low battery can affect performance.
Cannot connect via Bluetooth	Ensure the mouse is in Bluetooth pairing mode (blue indicator blinking). Make sure your device's Bluetooth is turned on and discoverable. Remove any previous pairings of the mouse from your device's Bluetooth list and try pairing again. Try connecting to the other Bluetooth channel (BT1 or BT2).
Forward/Back buttons not working	Ensure the application you are using supports these navigation buttons. Check for any software conflicts or custom button assignments if you are using third-party mouse software.
