## 1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

---

This R for Rabbit Jack N Jill NXG Baby Car Seat is designed and manufactured to provide maximum safety and comfort for your child. Please read this manual thoroughly before installation and use. Keep these instructions in a safe place for future reference.

- **ECE R44 Certified:** This car seat meets the European safety standard ECE R44, ensuring it has undergone rigorous testing for crash protection.
- **5-Point Harness System:** Always secure your child using the integrated 5-point harness system. Ensure the harness straps are snug against your child's body and not twisted.
- **Advanced Side Impact Protection:** The car seat features advanced side impact protection to safeguard your child from potential side collisions.
- **Proper Orientation:** The car seat supports both rear-facing and front-facing orientations based on your child's age and weight. Refer to the 'Operating Instructions' section for detailed guidance.

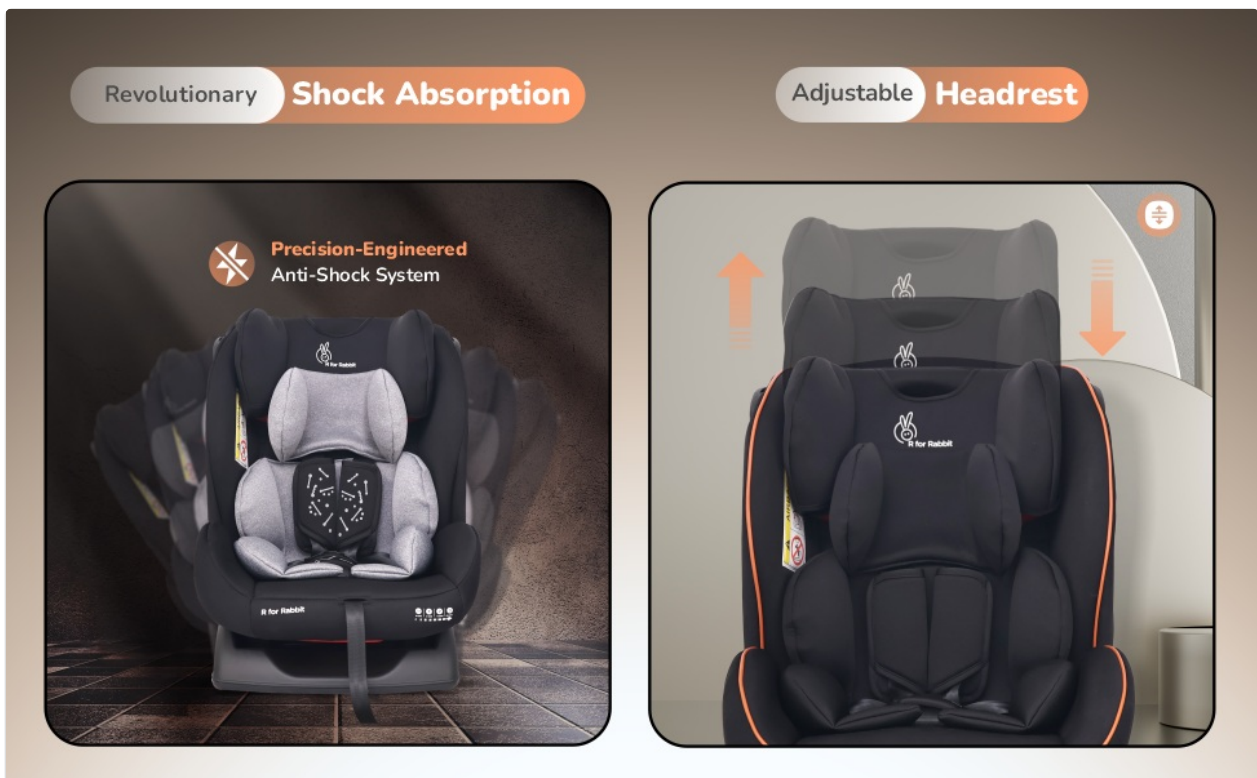


Figure 2: Advanced side impact protection for enhanced safety.

## 2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The R for Rabbit Jack N Jill NXG Car Seat is designed for adaptability and comfort, accommodating children from birth up to 12 years (0-36 kg). Its features are engineered to provide a safe and pleasant travel experience.

- **Dual Facing Capability:** Supports both rear-facing (0-15 months, up to 13 kg) and front-facing (15 months-12 years, up to 36 kg) positions.
- **Comfort and Ergonomics:** Features a spacious, ergonomically designed seat with breathable anti-allergic fabric and plush cushioning.
- **Adjustable Headrest:** The headrest can be adjusted to multiple positions to grow with your child, ensuring optimal head and neck support.
- **Revolutionary Shock Absorption:** Equipped with a precision-engineered anti-shock system to minimize impact during sudden stops or collisions.
- **ErgoTech Spine Protection:** Engineered to support your baby's growing spine, promoting proper posture and comfort.
- **Durable Construction:** Built with a high-strength, strong base structure using injection mould technology for enhanced durability and safety.

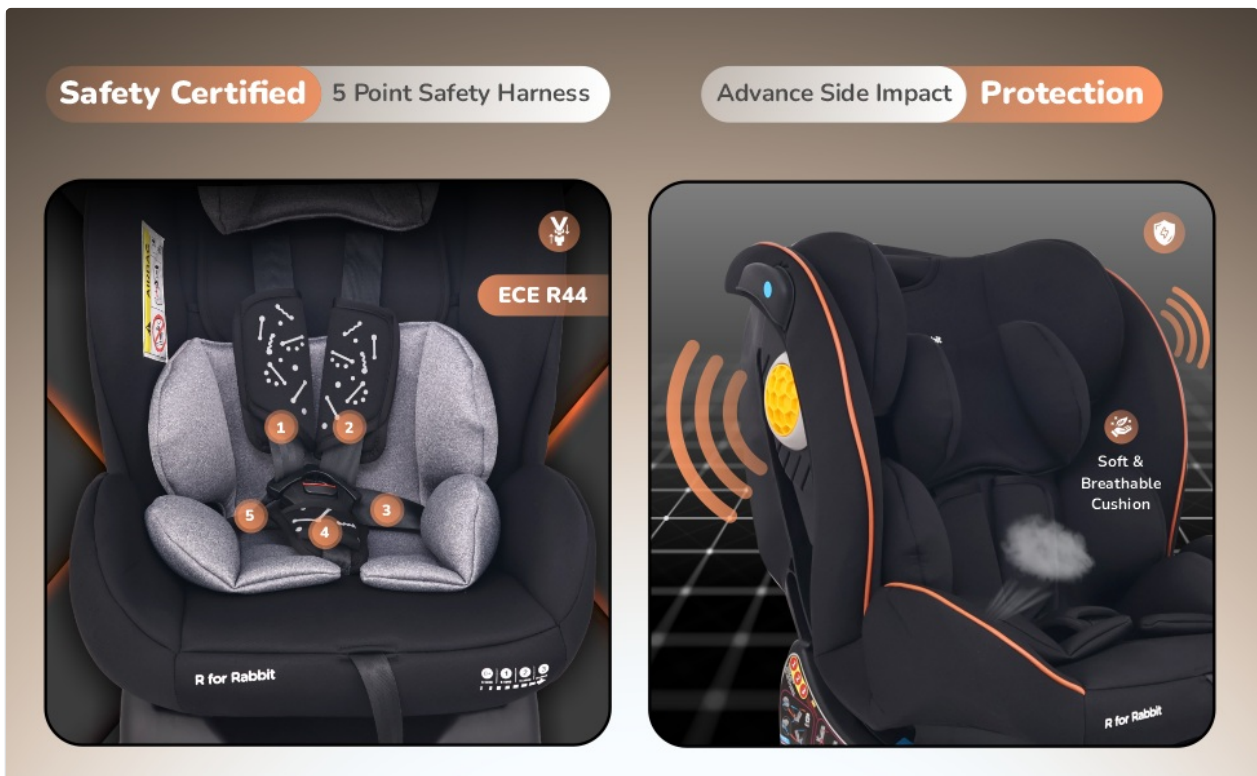


Figure 3: Precision-engineered anti-shock system for enhanced protection.

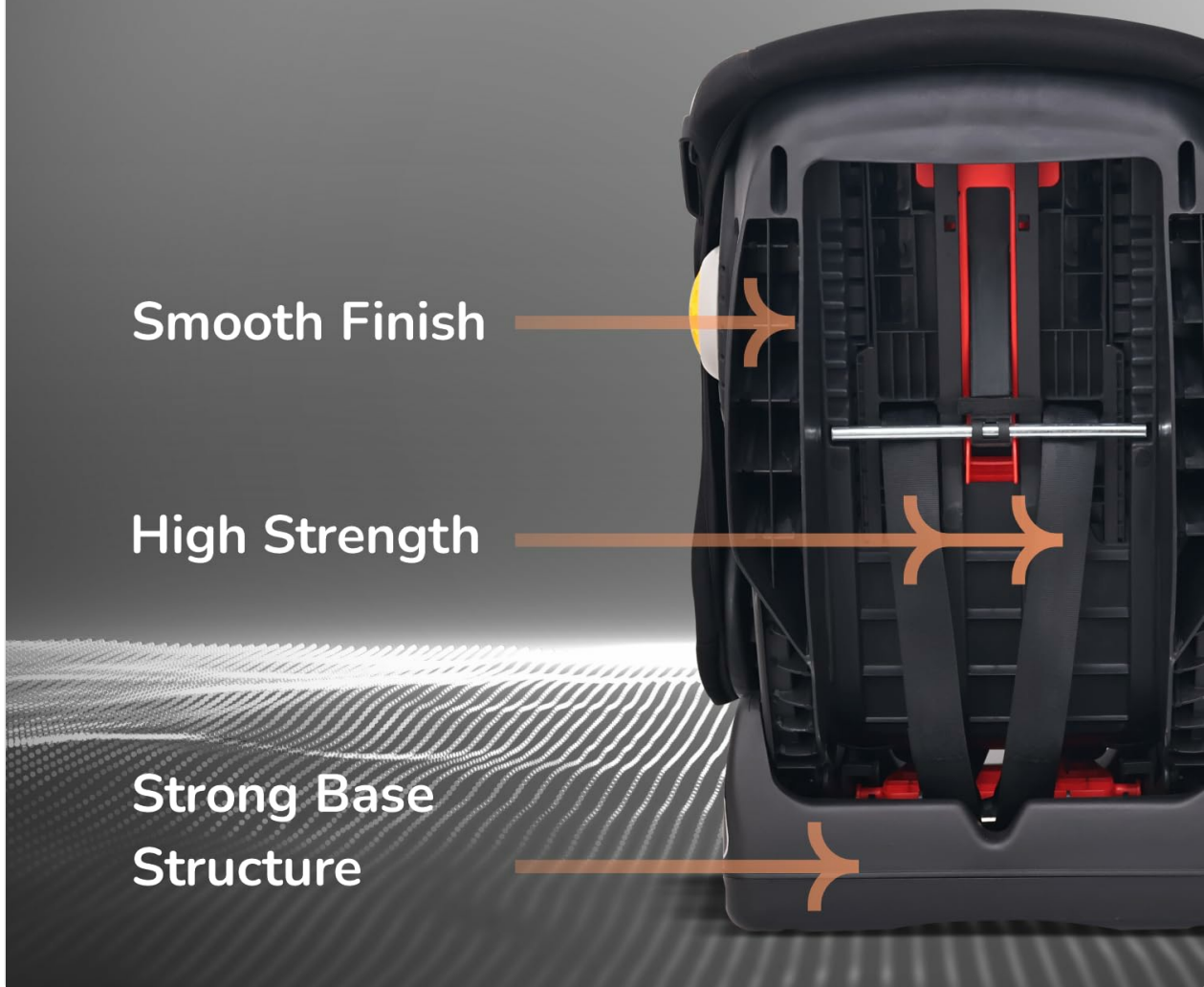


Figure 4: Injection mould construction for a strong and durable base.

### 3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The R for Rabbit Jack N Jill NXG Car Seat is installed using your vehicle's 3-point seat belt. Always ensure the car seat is securely fastened and does not move more than 1 inch (2.5 cm) in any direction at the belt path.

#### 3.1 Choosing the Correct Orientation

- **Rear-Facing (Group 0):** For newborns and infants from 0 to 15 months, weighing up to 13 kg. This position offers superior protection for the delicate head, neck, and spine.
- **Front-Facing (Group 1, 2, 3):** For toddlers and children from 15 months to 12 years, weighing 9 kg to 36 kg.

## 3.2 Seat Belt Installation (General Steps)

1. Place the car seat on the vehicle seat in the desired orientation (rear-facing or front-facing).
2. Route the vehicle's lap and shoulder belt through the designated belt paths on the car seat. Refer to the labels on the car seat for correct belt path for each orientation.
3. Buckle the vehicle seat belt.
4. Press down firmly on the car seat while pulling the shoulder belt to remove all slack from the lap belt. Ensure the car seat is tightly secured.
5. Check for tightness: The car seat should not move more than 1 inch (2.5 cm) side-to-side or front-to-back at the belt path.

**Always consult your vehicle's owner's manual and the car seat's detailed instruction booklet for specific installation steps and warnings.**

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### 4.1 Securing Your Child

1. Place your child in the car seat.
2. Bring the 5-point harness straps over your child's shoulders and between their legs.
3. Connect the buckle tongues into the buckle. Ensure you hear a click.
4. Pull the harness adjustment strap to tighten the harness. The harness should be snug, and you should not be able to pinch any excess webbing at your child's shoulder.
5. Position the chest clip at armpit level.

### 4.2 Adjusting Recline Positions

The car seat offers 4 recline positions for optimal comfort. Locate the recline adjustment lever, typically at the front or side of the base. Squeeze the lever and adjust the seat to the desired recline angle. Ensure the recline position is appropriate for your child's age and the car seat's orientation (e.g., more reclined for rear-facing infants).

### 4.3 Adjusting Headrest and Harness Height

The headrest and harness height can be adjusted simultaneously to ensure proper fit as your child grows. Locate the headrest adjustment mechanism, usually at the top of the seat back. Squeeze the lever or button and slide the headrest up or down until the harness straps are at or just below your child's shoulders for rear-facing, or at or just above their shoulders for front-facing.

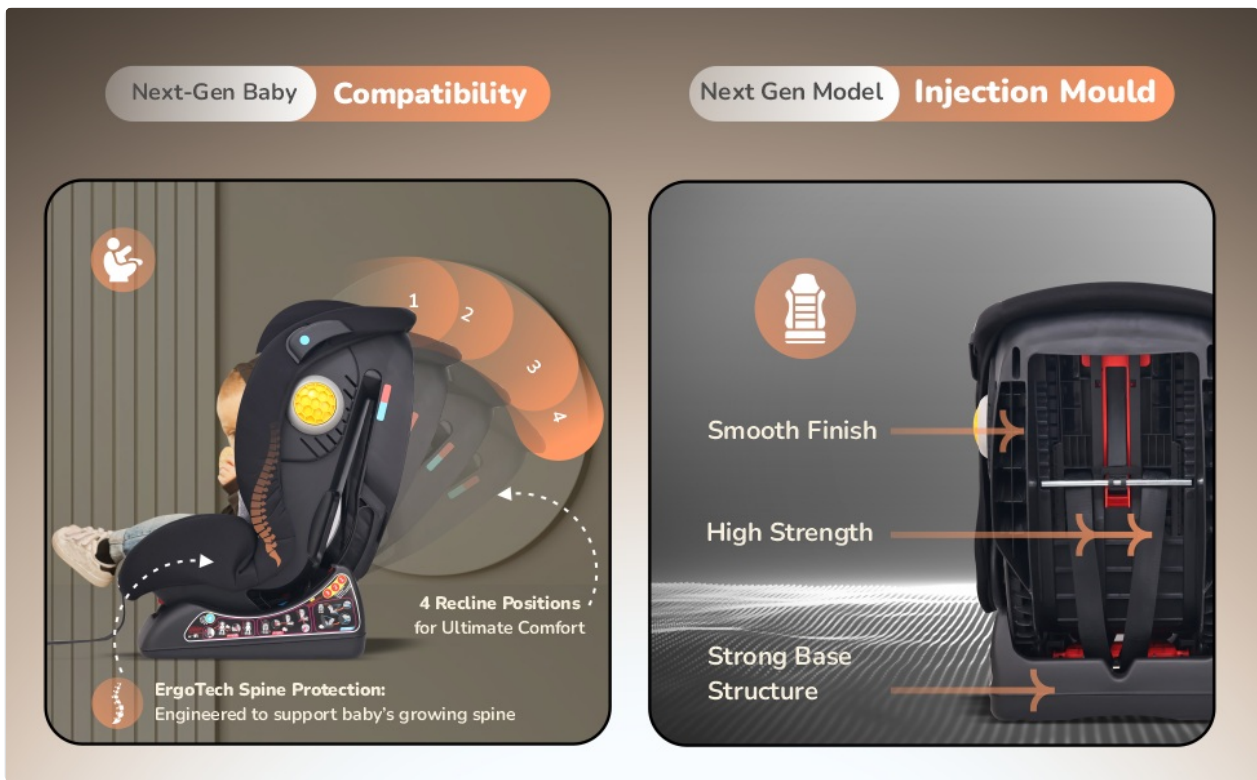


Figure 7: Adjustable headrest for growing children.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning and maintenance will help prolong the life of your car seat and ensure its continued safety and hygiene.

- **Fabric Cover:** The fabric cover is removable and designed for **hand wash only**. Use mild soap and cold water. Do not bleach, iron, or tumble dry. Allow to air dry completely before reattaching to the car seat frame.
- **Harness Straps:** Wipe harness straps with a damp cloth using mild soap and water. Do not immerse harness straps in water or machine wash, as this can weaken the webbing.
- **Plastic Parts:** Clean plastic parts with a damp cloth and mild soap. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Buckle:** Periodically check the buckle for debris. If necessary, clean the buckle by flushing it with warm water. Do not use detergents or lubricants.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your R for Rabbit Jack N Jill NXG Car Seat, please refer to the following common solutions.

- **Harness not tightening or loosening smoothly:** Check for any twists in the harness straps behind the car seat. Ensure no fabric or debris is obstructing the harness adjustment mechanism.
- **Car seat feels loose after installation:** Re-read the installation instructions carefully. Ensure the vehicle seat belt is routed correctly through the designated belt paths and pulled taut. Press down firmly on the

car seat while tightening the belt.

- **Buckle difficult to engage or release:** Check for food crumbs or debris inside the buckle. Clean the buckle as described in the 'Maintenance' section.
- **Child can unbuckle the harness:** Ensure the harness is snug and the chest clip is at armpit level. Some children may learn to manipulate buckles; ensure the harness is tight enough to prevent this. If the issue persists, contact customer support.
