## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, and maintaining your Hisense 55A7NF 4K UHD Smart Fire TV. Please read it thoroughly before using your television to ensure proper functionality and safety. The Hisense A7 Series offers a brilliant and detailed picture with 4K UHD resolution. It features Wide Color Gamut technology for enhanced color reproduction, Dolby Vision HDR and Dolby Atmos for an immersive audio-visual experience, and Game Mode Plus for optimized gaming performance. With Fire TV built-in, you can access a wide range of streaming content and utilize the Voice Remote with Alexa for convenient control.

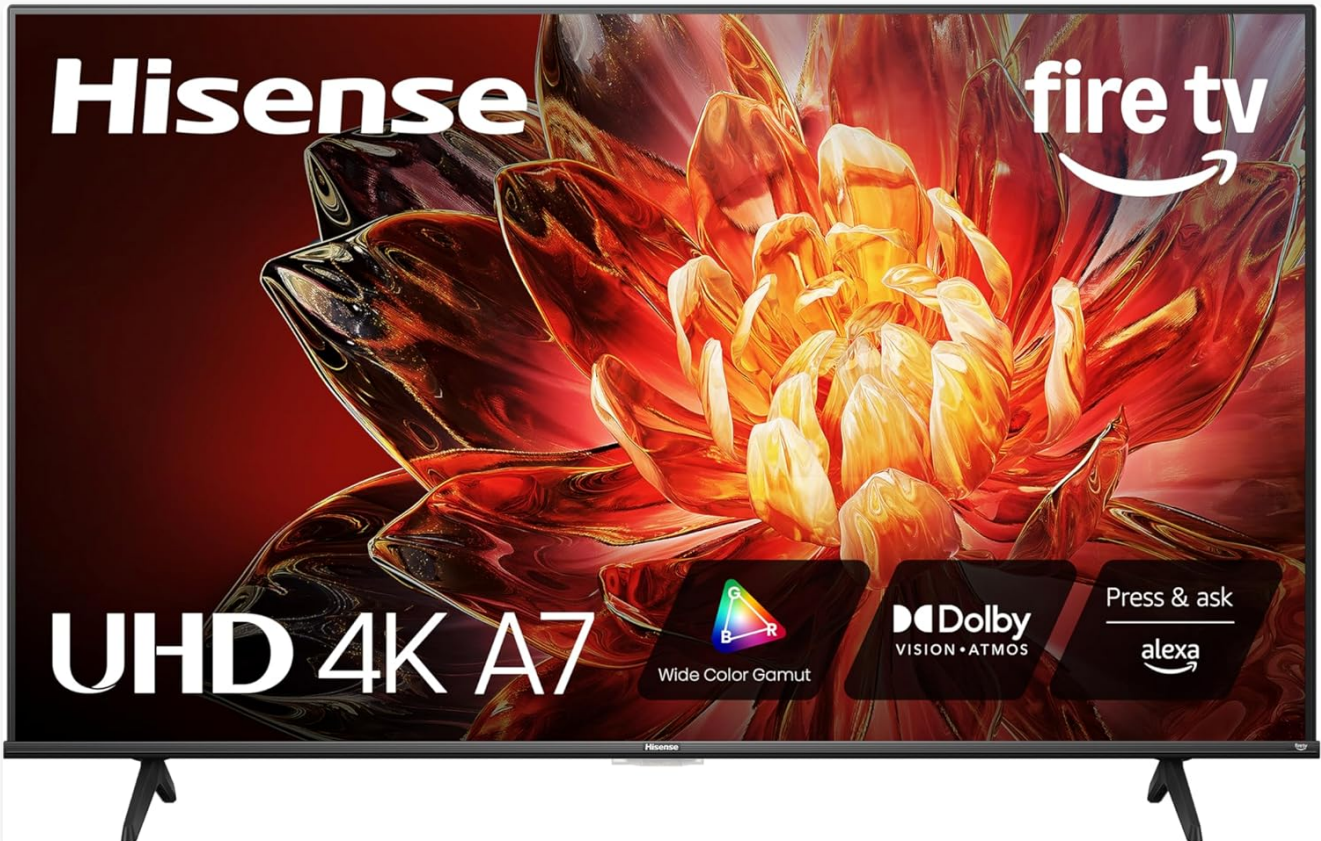


Image: Front view of the Hisense 55A7NF 4K UHD Smart Fire TV.

## 2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

---

Verify that all the following items are included in your package:

- Hisense 55A7NF 4K UHD Smart Fire TV
- Power Cable
- Remote Control (with 2 AAA batteries)
- TV Stand (2 pieces)
- Quick Setup Guide

## 3. SETUP

---

### 3.1 Attaching the TV Stand

1. Carefully place the TV screen-down on a soft, clean surface to prevent damage.
2. Align each stand leg with the corresponding screw holes on the bottom of the TV. Ensure the 'R' (Right) and 'L' (Left) markings on the stand legs match the TV.
3. Secure each leg with the provided screws using a Phillips head screwdriver. Do not overtighten.

### 3.2 Wall Mounting (Optional)

If you prefer to wall mount your TV, ensure you use a VESA-compatible wall mount kit (sold separately) that supports the 55-inch screen size and weight of the 55A7NF model. Follow the instructions provided with your wall mount kit.

### 3.3 Connecting Power

Plug the power cable into the TV's power input, then into a standard electrical outlet. The TV will enter standby mode.

### 3.4 Initial Setup and Remote Pairing

1. Insert the included AAA batteries into the Voice Remote.
2. Press the Power button on the remote to turn on the TV.
3. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the initial Fire TV setup, including connecting to your Wi-Fi network and signing in to your Amazon account.
4. The remote should automatically pair. If not, press and hold the Home button on the remote for 10 seconds until the LED indicator flashes blue, then release.

## 4. OPERATING YOUR TV

### 4.1 Fire TV Interface

The Fire TV interface provides access to streaming apps, live TV, and smart home controls. Navigate using the

directional pad on your remote. Personalized profiles can be created for customized watchlists and recommendations.

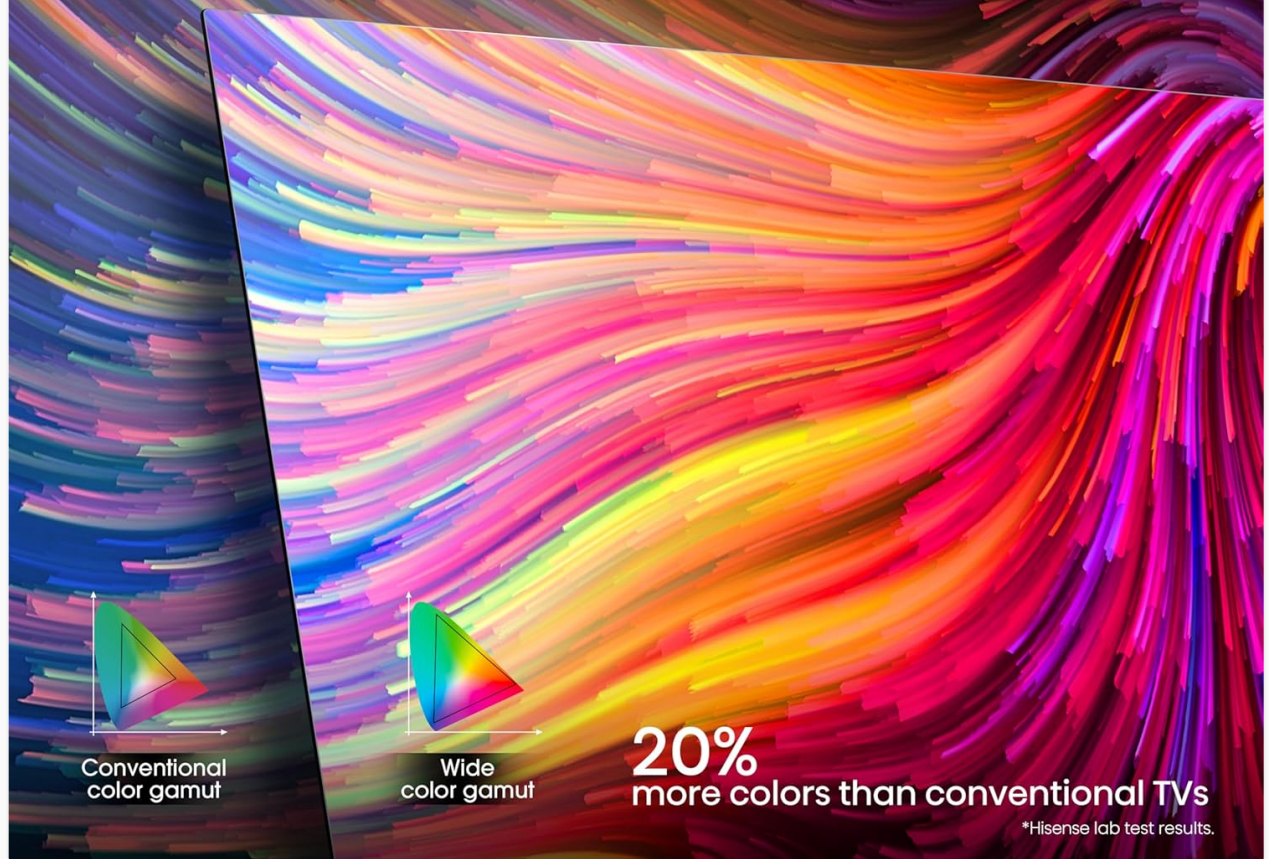

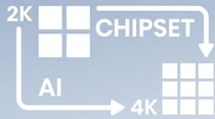

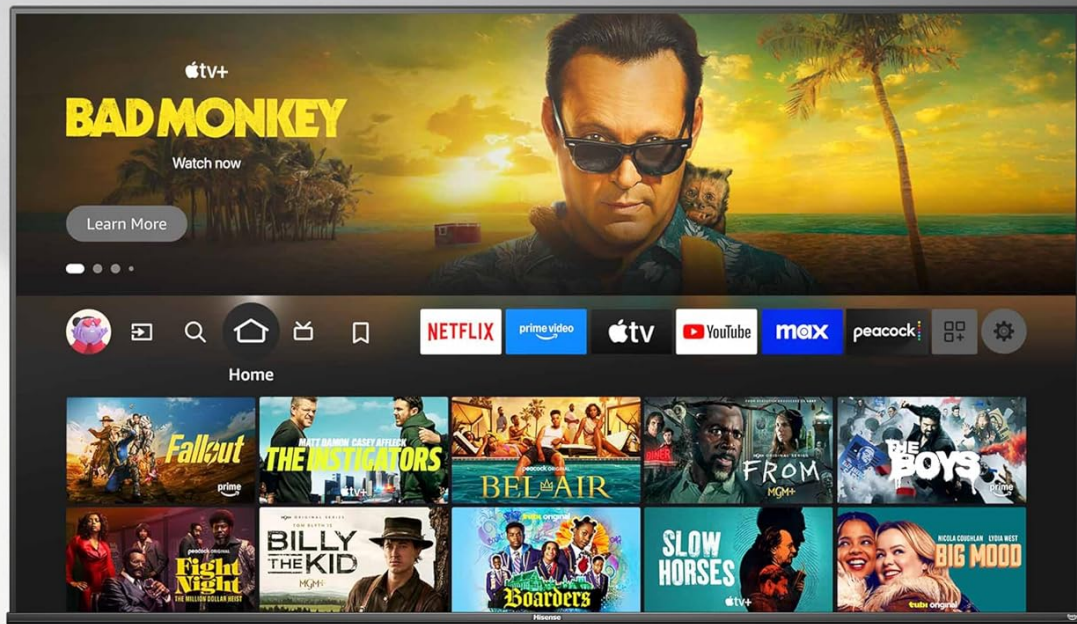

- **HDMI Inputs (3):** Connect gaming consoles, set-top boxes, Blu-ray players, and other HDMI-enabled devices. One HDMI input supports eARC for enhanced audio return.
- **USB Ports (2):** Connect USB flash drives for media playback.
- **ANT (Antenna) Input:** Connect an antenna for over-the-air broadcast channels.
- **Digital Audio Out (Optical):** Connect to a soundbar or audio receiver for digital audio output.
- **AV Input:** Connect older devices using composite video and stereo audio cables.
- **Headphone Jack:** Connect headphones for private listening.
- **Ethernet Port:** Connect to your network via a wired connection for stable internet access.
- **Wi-Fi 5:** Built-in wireless connectivity for internet access.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

### 6.1 Cleaning the Screen

Gently wipe the screen with a soft, lint-free cloth. For stubborn marks, lightly dampen the cloth with water or a specialized screen cleaner. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

## 6.2 Cleaning the TV Body

Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the TV's frame and back. Do not use liquid cleaners directly on the TV.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues with your TV, refer to the following common solutions:

- **No Power:** Ensure the power cable is securely connected to both the TV and the electrical outlet. Try a different outlet.
- **No Picture/Sound:** Check all cable connections (HDMI, antenna, etc.). Ensure the correct input source is selected on the TV.
- **Remote Not Responding:** Replace the batteries in the remote. Re-pair the remote by holding the Home button for 10 seconds.
- **Network Connection Issues:** Check your Wi-Fi router and internet connection. Try restarting both the TV and your router. For wired connections, ensure the Ethernet cable is properly connected.
- **Picture Quality Issues:** Adjust picture settings (brightness, contrast, color) in the TV menu. Ensure your content source is high-quality.

If problems persist, consult the full user manual available on the Hisense support website or contact customer support.

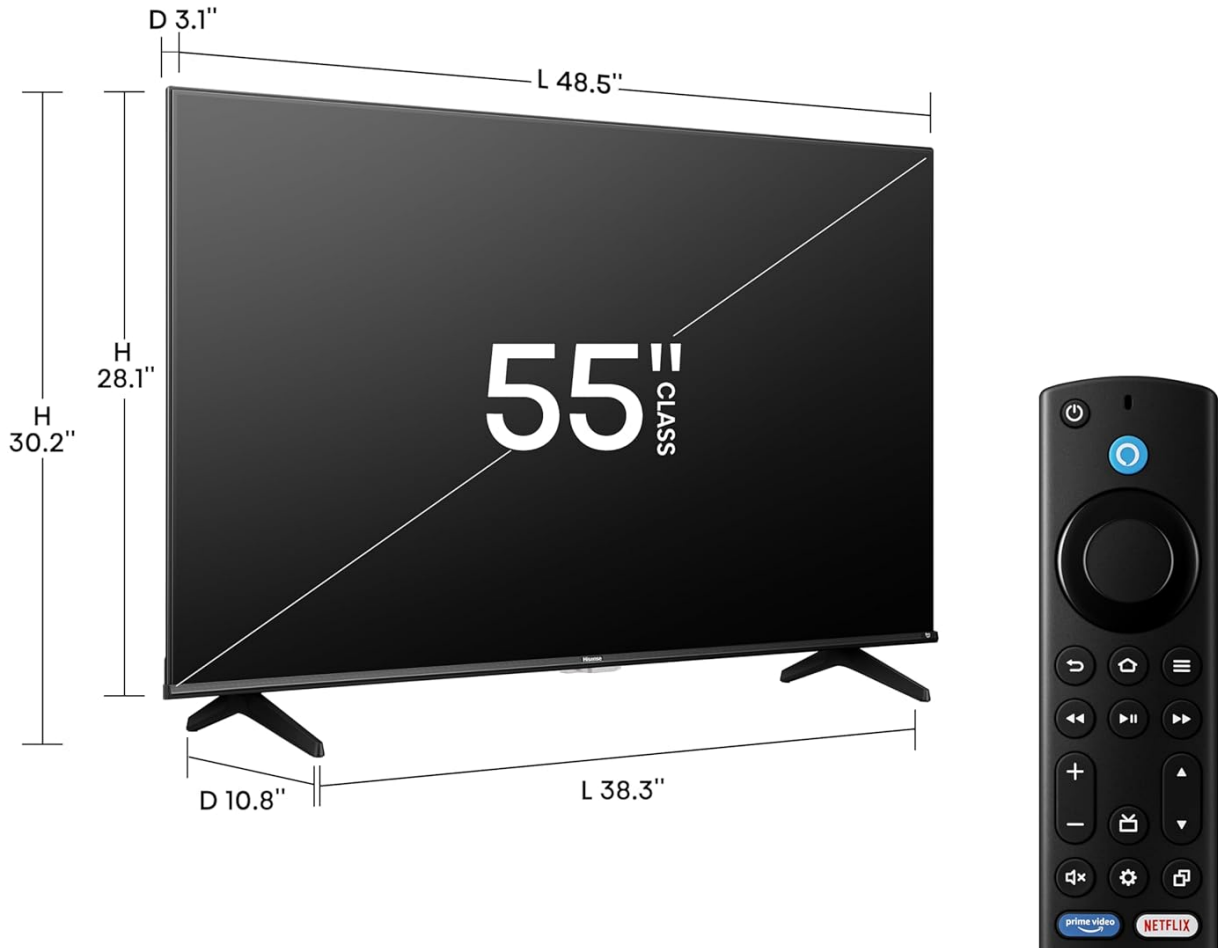


Image: Diagram illustrating the dimensions of the Hisense 55-inch Class A7 Series TV.
