# CLEVO W255 Series Laptop Keyboard User Manual

## INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the installation, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your new CLEVO W255 series laptop keyboard. Please read this guide carefully before proceeding with any installation or use to ensure proper function and longevity of the product.

## SETUP AND INSTALLATION

3. **Connect New Keyboard:** Align the new keyboard's ribbon cable(s) with the connectors on the motherboard. Gently push down the locking mechanism to secure the cable(s). Ensure the cables are seated correctly and not bent or creased.
4. **Secure New Keyboard:** Place the new keyboard into its slot. Ensure it sits flush with the laptop's palm rest. Re-insert any screws that secure the keyboard.
5. **Test Functionality:** Before reassembling the entire laptop, connect the power adapter (without the battery) and power on the laptop to test the new keyboard. Check all keys for proper response.
6. **Final Reassembly:** If the keyboard functions correctly, proceed with reassembling the rest of your laptop.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your new CLEVO W255 series laptop keyboard functions identically to the original keyboard it replaces. Below are general operating guidelines.

### Standard Key Functions

- **Alphanumeric Keys:** Used for typing letters, numbers, and symbols.
- **Modifier Keys:** Shift, Ctrl (Control), Alt (Alternate), and Fn (Function) keys modify the behavior of other keys when pressed simultaneously.

- **Function Keys (F1-F12):** These keys often have secondary functions when pressed in combination with the **Fn** key. Refer to your laptop's user manual for specific Fn key combinations.

  - Check for physical obstructions (e.g., debris) under the keycap. Use compressed air to clear.
  - If multiple keys in a row or column are not working, it might indicate a ribbon cable issue or a fault with the keyboard itself.
- Incorrect Characters Appearing:**
  - Verify your operating system's keyboard layout settings match your physical keyboard (e.g., US layout).
  - Ensure Num Lock or Caps Lock are not accidentally engaged if they are affecting input.
