TYBERLEY Pagani Design 1718 Quartz Chronograph Watch User Manual

Model: PD1718-YUGH

1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The TYBERLEY Pagani Design 1718 is a vintage-inspired men's quartz chronograph wristwatch, featuring a distinctive Panda dial and powered by a reliable Japanese VK64 quartz movement. Crafted from durable 316L stainless steel, it offers 100 meters of water resistance and luminous hands for visibility in low light conditions. This manual provides essential information for the proper setup, operation, and care of your watch.

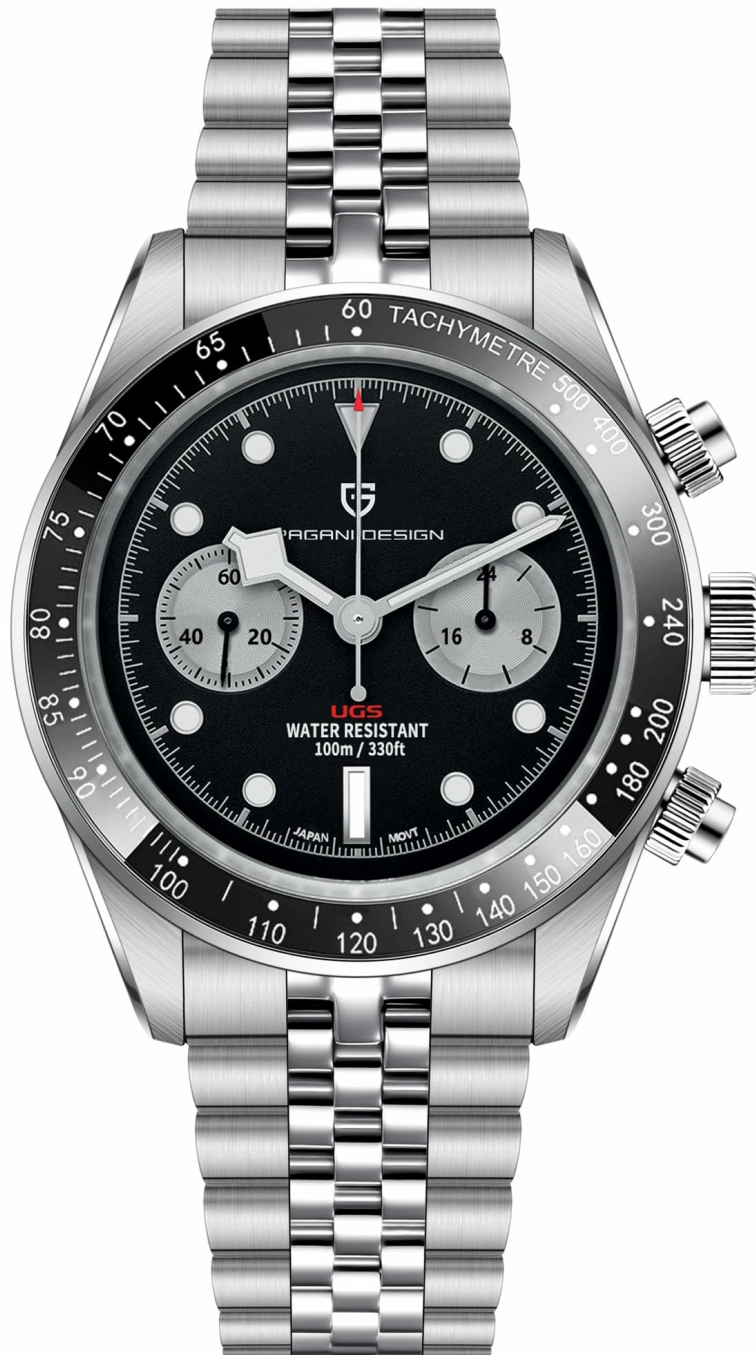


Image 1: The TYBERLEY Pagani Design 1718 watch, showcasing its black dial, silver stainless steel bracelet, and chronograph sub-dials.

2. COMPONENTS AND CONTROLS

Familiarize yourself with the main components and controls of your watch.

- **Crown:** Used for setting the time and date. This model features a screw-down crown for enhanced water resistance.
- **Pushers (Buttons):** Located at 2 o'clock and 4 o'clock, these control the chronograph functions.
- **Main Dial:** Displays hours, minutes, and the central chronograph second hand.
- **Sub-dials:**
 - 3 o'clock position: 24-hour time indicator.
 - 9 o'clock position: Chronograph minute counter.
- **Bezel:** Fixed tachymeter bezel for measuring speed.
- **Luminous Markings:** Hands and hour markers are coated with luminous material for low-light visibility.

3. SETUP AND INITIAL USE

3.1 Unboxing and Inspection

Upon receiving your watch, carefully remove it from its packaging. Inspect the watch for any visible damage. The package should include:

- TYBERLEY Pagani Design 1718 Watch
- Original Packaging Box
- Instruction Manual (this document)
- Cleaning Cloth
- Bracelet Adjuster Tool (for metal bracelets)

3.2 Setting the Time and Date

1. **Unscrew the Crown:** Gently rotate the crown counter-clockwise until it loosens and pops out slightly to position 1.
2. **Set the Date (if applicable):** Pull the crown out to position 2 (first click). Rotate the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise to adjust the date. Avoid setting the date between 9 PM and 3 AM, as this can damage the movement.
3. **Set the Time:** Pull the crown out to position 3 (second click). The central second hand will stop. Rotate the crown to set the hour and minute hands. To ensure accuracy, synchronize with a reliable time source.
4. **Secure the Crown:** Once the time and date are set, push the crown back into position 1 and screw it clockwise firmly against the case to ensure water resistance.

3.3 Adjusting the Bracelet

If your watch has a metal bracelet, use the included bracelet adjuster tool to remove or add links for a comfortable fit. If you are unsure, it is recommended to have this done by a professional watchmaker to prevent damage.

4. OPERATING THE CHRONOGRAPH

The chronograph function allows you to measure elapsed time.

1. **Start:** Press the upper pusher (at 2 o'clock) to start the central chronograph second hand.
2. **Stop:** Press the upper pusher again to stop the chronograph. The elapsed time will be indicated by the central second hand and the 9 o'clock minute sub-dial.
3. **Reset:** After stopping, press the lower pusher (at 4 o'clock) to reset the chronograph hands to their zero positions.

The 3 o'clock sub-dial continuously displays the current time in a 24-hour format.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

5.1 Water Resistance

Your watch is water-resistant to 100 meters (330 feet). This rating makes it suitable for everyday use, including splashes, rain, and showering.

- **Important:** Ensure the crown is fully screwed down before any contact with water.
- **Do NOT** press any buttons underwater.
- **Avoid** using the watch in extremely hot or cold temperatures, such as saunas or hot baths, as this can compromise seals.
- **Not recommended** for scuba diving or prolonged submersion.

5.2 Cleaning

Regularly clean your watch with a soft, dry cloth. For stainless steel bracelets, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by drying. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

5.3 Battery Replacement

This watch is powered by a Japanese VK64 quartz movement, which requires a battery. The typical battery life is 2-3 years. When the battery needs replacement, it is recommended to take the watch to a qualified watchmaker to ensure proper sealing and prevent damage to the movement.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Watch Not Running:** Check if the crown is fully pushed in. If the watch still does not run, the battery may need replacement.
- **Time Inaccuracy:** Ensure the crown is fully screwed down after setting the time. Extreme temperatures or strong magnetic fields can affect quartz watch accuracy.
- **Chronograph Not Resetting to Zero:** If the chronograph hands do not reset precisely to zero, consult a professional watchmaker for adjustment.
- **Water Inside Watch:** If you notice condensation or water inside the watch, immediately take it to a professional watchmaker for inspection and repair to prevent further damage.
