



Image: Visual representation of the tablet's full features, including Android 15, parental controls, and battery capacity.

4. SETUP AND FIRST USE

4.1 Charging the Tablet

Before first use, fully charge your tablet using the provided 1.8M charging cable and power adapter. The charging port is located on the side of the tablet. A full charge ensures optimal performance and battery life.

4.2 Powering On/Off

- To power on: Press and hold the power button located on the side of the tablet until the screen lights up.
- To power off: Press and hold the power button, then select 'Power off' from the on-screen options.
- To restart: Press and hold the power button, then select 'Restart' from the on-screen options.

4.3 Connecting to Wi-Fi

To access online content and apps, connect your tablet to a Wi-Fi network:

1. Swipe down from the top of the screen to open the Quick Settings panel.
2. Tap and hold the Wi-Fi icon to open Wi-Fi settings.
3. Toggle Wi-Fi on if it's off.
4. Select your desired network from the list and enter the password if prompted.

4.4 Initial Setup and Google Kids Space

Follow the on-screen prompts to complete the initial setup, including setting up a Google account. The tablet comes with Google Kids Space pre-installed, offering a curated environment for children. You can configure Kids Space during the initial setup or later through the app.

5.3 Parental Controls with Google Family Link

Manage your child's digital experience using Google Family Link. This allows you to:

- Filter content and block inappropriate websites.
- Set daily screen time limits and device bedtime.
- Approve or block app downloads.
- Track your child's device location (if enabled).

Download the Google Family Link app on your own device to manage these settings remotely.

5.4 Eye Protection Mode

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning

- Screen: Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water or a screen cleaner. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- Case: The EVA case can be wiped clean with a damp cloth.

6.2 Battery Care

- Avoid fully discharging the battery frequently.
- Do not expose the tablet to extreme temperatures.
- Use only the provided charger and cable.

6.3 Software Updates

Periodically check for system updates in the tablet's settings to ensure optimal performance and security. Connect to Wi-Fi before downloading updates.

6.4 Storage Management

To maintain performance, regularly clear unnecessary files and uninstall unused apps. You can expand storage up to 1TB using a microSD card (sold separately).

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Plimpton Kids20 tablet, please refer to the following common solutions:

- **Tablet not turning on:** Ensure the battery is charged. Connect the tablet to the charger and wait a few minutes before attempting to power it on again.
- **Wi-Fi connectivity issues:** Check if your Wi-Fi router is working correctly. Restart the tablet and try reconnecting to the network.
- **Apps crashing or freezing:** Close the problematic app and reopen it. If the issue persists, restart the tablet. Ensure apps are updated to their latest versions.
- **Slow performance:** Close background apps, clear cache, and ensure sufficient storage space. Consider performing a factory reset as a last resort (this will erase all data).

7.1 Factory Reset

A factory reset will erase all data from your tablet and restore it to its original factory settings. Back up any important data before proceeding.

1. Go to Settings > System > Reset options.
2. Select 'Erase all data (factory reset)'.
3. Confirm your choice and follow the on-screen instructions.




