- The top bunk is not suitable for children under 6 years of age.
- Use only mattresses that are 6 inches thick or less for both bunks to ensure proper guardrail height.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging and lay them out on a clean, soft surface to prevent scratches. Verify all parts against the included parts list.
2. **Assemble Frame:** Follow the diagrams in the assembly manual to connect the headboards, footboards, and side rails using the provided hardware. Do not fully tighten all bolts until the entire frame is assembled.
3. **Install Slats:** Secure the 14 bed slats to the designated support rails on both the upper and lower bunks. Ensure even spacing and secure attachment.
4. **Attach Ladder:** Connect the 3-step ladder to the bunk bed frame as indicated in the instructions.
5. **Final Tightening:** Once all components are in place, systematically tighten all bolts and screws. Do not overtighten.
6. **Placement:** Position the assembled bunk bed in its desired location, ensuring it is stable and level.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS (USAGE)

To ensure safe and proper use of your Xilingol Low Bunk Bed, please observe the following guidelines:

- **Mattress Requirements:** Use only twin-size mattresses. For the upper bunk, the mattress thickness should not exceed 6 inches to maintain the effectiveness of the guardrails.
- **Weight Capacity:** Adhere to the maximum weight limits specified in the "Specifications" section for both the upper and lower bunks.
- **Ladder Use:** Always use the integrated 3-step ladder for accessing the upper bunk. Do not climb on the guardrails or other parts of the bed.
- **Guardrails:** Ensure guardrails are always in place and securely fastened. Do not remove them.
- **Underbed Space:** The design allows for flexible use of the underbed space. This area can be used for storage or

play, but ensure it remains clear of obstructions that could impede safe movement or cause injury.

- **Side Hanging Bar:** Utilize the side hanging bar for lightweight items such as clothes or small bags. Do not overload the bar.

MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will extend the life and safety of your bunk bed.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the wooden surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners that could damage the finish.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically inspect all bolts, screws, and connections. Tighten any loose hardware to maintain

structural integrity. This should be done at least once every three months.

- **Wood Care:** Protect the wood from extreme temperature changes and direct sunlight, which can cause warping or fading.
- **Damage Inspection:** Regularly check for any signs of wear, damage, or splintering. Discontinue use if significant damage is found and contact customer support.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bed feels wobbly or unstable.	Loose hardware connections.	Check and tighten all bolts and screws. Ensure the bed is on a level surface.
Parts do not align during assembly.	Incorrect orientation of parts or incomplete tightening.	Review the assembly manual diagrams. Loosen all hardware, realign parts, then retighten.
Missing hardware or damaged part.	Packaging error or transit damage.	Contact customer support immediately for replacement parts. Do not attempt to use damaged parts.

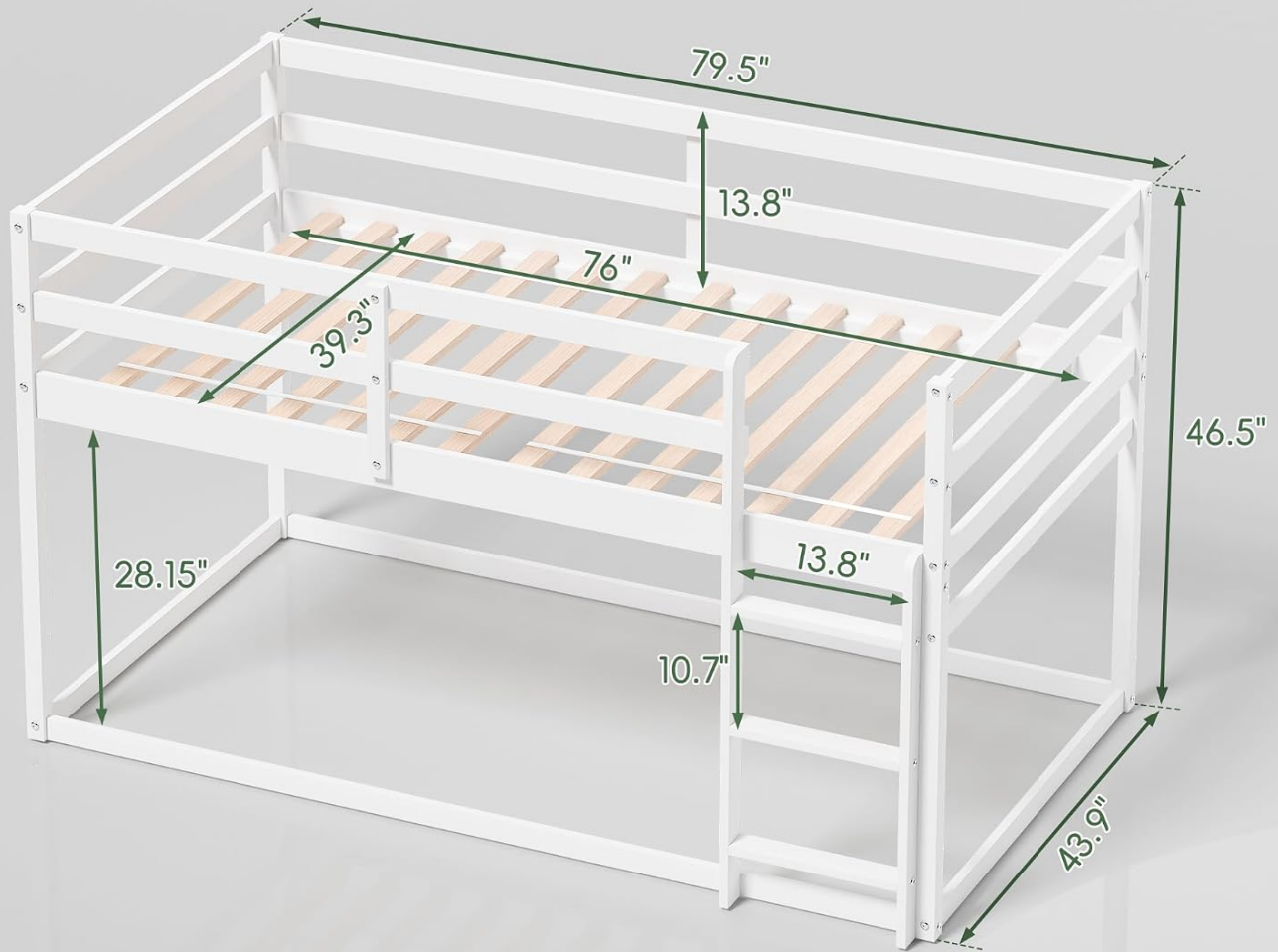


Image: A technical diagram illustrating the precise measurements of the bunk bed, including length, width, and height.
