## 3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the Shintenchi Kitchen Pantry Cabinet is required. A detailed assembly instruction manual is included in the packaging. Please follow these steps:

- 1. Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging. Verify that all components and hardware listed in the included manual are present.
- 2. Identify Parts:** Familiarize yourself with each part by comparing them to the diagrams in the assembly manual. Most pieces are labeled for easier identification.
- 3. Follow Step-by-Step Instructions:** Assemble the cabinet according to the sequence provided in the separate assembly manual. Pay close attention to diagrams and hardware usage for each step.
- 4. Secure Connections:** Ensure all screws and fasteners are tightened securely, but do not overtighten to avoid damaging the engineered wood material.
- 5. Install Anti-Tip Device:** For safety, install the anti-tip device as instructed in the manual, securing the cabinet to a wall stud. This is crucial for stability.
- 6. Door Alignment:** After assembly, check the alignment of all doors. If doors appear uneven or difficult to close, adjust the hinges as per the assembly manual's instructions. Minor adjustments can often correct alignment issues.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your Shintenchi Kitchen Pantry Cabinet is designed for versatile storage. Utilize its features as follows:

- **Internal Shelves:** The cabinet features 6 internal shelves. One of these shelves is adjustable to 3 different heights, allowing you to customize storage space for various items, from dishes to kitchen appliances.
- **Door Shelves:** The four side shelves on each door provide additional storage for smaller items such as beverages, condiments, and jars. Guardrails are included to help stabilize contents.
- **Drawer:** A spacious drawer is equipped for easy access to utensils, cutlery, or other small accessories.
- **Versatile Use:** While ideal for kitchen pantry storage, this cabinet can also function as a sideboard for glassware in a dining room, a storage unit for books or decorative items in a living room, or an organizer for toiletries and towels in a bathroom.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

To maintain the appearance and longevity of your Shintechi Kitchen Pantry Cabinet, follow these simple maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** The cabinet features a smooth finish designed for easy cleaning. Wipe surfaces with a soft, damp cloth to remove dust and spills.
- **Avoid Harsh Chemicals:** Do not use abrasive cleaners, strong detergents, or chemical solvents, as these can damage the finish.
- **Spill Management:** Promptly wipe up any liquid spills to prevent moisture absorption and potential damage to the engineered wood.
- **Regular Checks:** Periodically check all screws and fasteners to ensure they remain tight. Retighten if necessary to maintain structural integrity.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your cabinet, consider the following troubleshooting tips:

- **Cabinet Feels Flimsy or Unstable:**

- Ensure all assembly screws and connections are fully tightened.
- Verify that the anti-tip device is correctly installed and securely anchored to a wall stud.
- Ensure the cabinet is placed on a level surface. Use shims if necessary to stabilize.

- **Doors Are Uneven or Difficult to Close:**

- Check the hinge adjustments. Most hinges allow for minor adjustments to align doors. Refer to the assembly manual for specific hinge adjustment instructions.
- Ensure the cabinet frame is square and not twisted, which can affect door alignment.

- **Shelves Do Not Hold Expected Weight:**

- Avoid overloading shelves. Distribute weight evenly.
- Ensure shelf support pins are fully inserted into the designated holes.

- **Missing or Damaged Parts:**

- Contact Shintenchi customer support or the seller immediately for assistance with replacement parts.
