1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION


Read all instructions carefully before assembling and using this bunk bed. Keep this manual for future reference.

- **Weight Capacity:** The upper bunk has a maximum weight capacity of 440 lbs. The lower bunk also has a maximum weight capacity of 440 lbs. The climbing net has a maximum weight capacity of 110 lbs, and the climbing rope has a maximum weight capacity of 154 lbs. Do not exceed these limits.
- **Mattress Requirements:** The upper bunk requires a Twin size mattress with a maximum thickness of 6 inches. The lower bunk requires a Queen size mattress with a maximum thickness of 8 inches. Mattresses are not included.
- **Guardrails:** The upper bunk is equipped with a full-length guardrail for safety. Ensure it is always securely in place.
- **Climbing Features:** Always supervise children when using the climbing net and inclined ramp. Ensure these components are securely attached.
- **Assembly:** Follow all assembly instructions precisely to prevent instability. Ensure all fasteners are tightened securely.
- **Sharp Edges:** Exercise caution around any potential sharp edges during assembly and use.
- **Ventilation:** After assembly, allow for 1-2 weeks of ventilation to dissipate any paint odors from the solid wood components.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW AND DIMENSIONS

The Giantex Twin Over Queen Bunk Bed is designed to provide a versatile and space-saving sleeping solution with playful features. It combines a twin-size upper bunk with a queen-size lower floor bed, featuring a house-shaped frame, climbing net, and inclined ramp.

3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The Giantex Twin Over Queen Bunk Bed is delivered in two separate boxes and requires assembly. A user manual with detailed assembly instructions is included with the product. It is recommended that two people work together for efficient and safe assembly.

3.1 Before You Begin

- Verify all parts and hardware are present by comparing them with the included parts list.
- Clear a spacious area for assembly to avoid damage to components or flooring.
- Gather necessary tools (e.g., screwdriver, Allen wrench - typically included).

3.2 Assembly Steps (General Guidance)

Refer to the detailed step-by-step instructions provided in the separate user manual included in the packaging. The general process involves:

1. Assembling the base frame for the lower queen-size bunk.

2. Constructing the upper twin-size bunk frame, including guardrails.
3. Attaching the support structures and the house-shaped frame.
4. Installing the climbing net and inclined ramp.
5. Securing all slats for both bunks.

Important: Do not use high-powered drills for tightening screws, as this may damage the wood or strip the screws. Hand-tighten all fasteners to ensure a secure fit without over-tightening.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- The upper bunk is suitable for a twin-size mattress.

5. MAINTENANCE

- **Fasteners:** Periodically check all screws, bolts, and other fasteners to ensure they remain tight. Retighten as necessary to maintain stability.
- **Wood Care:** Protect the wood from extreme temperature changes and direct sunlight to prevent warping or fading.
- **Slats:** Ensure all plywood slats are in good condition and properly seated to provide adequate mattress support.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Cracked Wood:** Minor cracks can occur during assembly if screws are over-tightened or if an electric drill is used with excessive force. If a structural component cracks, contact customer support for assistance.
- **Missing Parts:** If any parts are missing upon delivery, refer to the parts list in your user manual and contact Giantex customer support immediately for replacements.
- **Difficulty Assembling:** Review the assembly instructions carefully. If you encounter persistent difficulties, consider seeking assistance from another person or contacting customer support.
