IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all instructions carefully before using the appliance. Keep this manual for future reference.

- Hot Surface Warning: The cooktop surface will be hot after cooking. Do not touch with bare hands until it has
 cooled down.
- Child Safety Lock: This appliance includes a child safety lock feature to prevent accidental operation.
- Over-Temperature Protection: The cooktop is equipped with an over-temperature protection system to prevent overheating.
- Automatic Shutdown: The 99-minute timer function includes an automatic shutdown feature for safety.
- Residual Heat Warning: An indicator will show when residual heat is present on the cooking zones.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The ADVWIN 2 Burner Electric Cooktop is a versatile cooking appliance designed for both countertop and built-in use. It features two independent heating zones with knob controls, a child safety lock, a timer, and multiple power levels for precise cooking.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Unpacking

- Carefully remove the cooktop from its packaging.
- Inspect the appliance for any damage. Do not operate if damaged.
- Ensure all included components, such as the electric cooktop unit and four small foot pads, are present.

Installation Options

This electric cooktop offers two installation methods: countertop use or built-in installation.

Countertop Use

- Attach the four small foot pads to the bottom of the cooktop using a screwdriver.
- Place the cooktop on a stable, flat, and heat-resistant surface.
- Ensure adequate ventilation around the unit.

Built-in Installation

- Ensure the opening size in your countertop is correct. The recommended cut-out size is 28 x 19.9 inches.
- Consult a qualified electrician for proper wiring and installation to meet local electrical codes.

Electrical Connection

- The cooktop operates on a standard 110-120V, 50-60Hz electrical supply.
- Plug the appliance into a grounded electrical outlet.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Powering On/Off

- To turn on a burner, press the corresponding 'ON/OFF' button.
- To turn off a burner, press the corresponding 'ON/OFF' button again.

Adjusting Power Levels

The cooktop offers 9 power levels for precise temperature control.

- After turning on a burner, use the rotary knob to select the desired power level from 1 to 9.
- Level 1 is the lowest heat setting, and Level 9 is the highest.
- The left burner provides up to 1600W, and the right burner provides up to 800W.

Timer Function

The integrated timer allows you to set a cooking duration up to 99 minutes.

- Press the timer button (clock icon) to activate the timer.
- · Use the rotary knobs to adjust the desired time.

• The cooktop will automatically shut off once the set time has elapsed.

Child Safety Lock

To activate the child safety lock, press and hold the lock button (padlock icon) for approximately 3 seconds. The display will show 'LO' to indicate it is locked. To deactivate, repeat the process.

This electric cooktop is compatible with a wide range of cookware types, including:

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

The ceramic glass surface of the cooktop is designed for easy cleaning.

- Always ensure the cooktop is turned off and completely cooled before cleaning.
- Wipe the ceramic glass surface with a damp cloth and mild detergent.
- For stubborn stains, use a non-abrasive ceramic cooktop cleaner.
- Avoid using abrasive sponges, scouring pads, or harsh chemicals that could scratch or damage the surface.
- Clean the control knobs and surrounding areas with a soft, damp cloth.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your ADVWIN Electric Cooktop, please refer to the following common troubleshooting steps:

• **Appliance not turning on:** Check if the cooktop is properly plugged into a working electrical outlet. Ensure the power button for the desired burner has been pressed.

- No heat from burner: Verify that the power level is set above '0'. Ensure the child safety lock is not activated.
- Error codes on display: If an error code appears, unplug the unit for a few minutes and then plug it back in. If the error persists, contact customer support.
- **Uneven heating:** Ensure your cookware has a flat bottom and is centered on the heating zone.
