## 1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the HP Pavilion 15.6" FHD Laptop. This device is designed for general computing tasks, offering a balance of performance and portability. It features an Intel Core i3-N305 processor, 16GB of DDR4 RAM, and a 1TB storage solution comprising a 512GB PCIe SSD and an additional 500GB HP P500 Portable SSD. The laptop includes a 15.6-inch Full HD anti-glare display, Wi-Fi 6 connectivity, and runs on Windows 11.

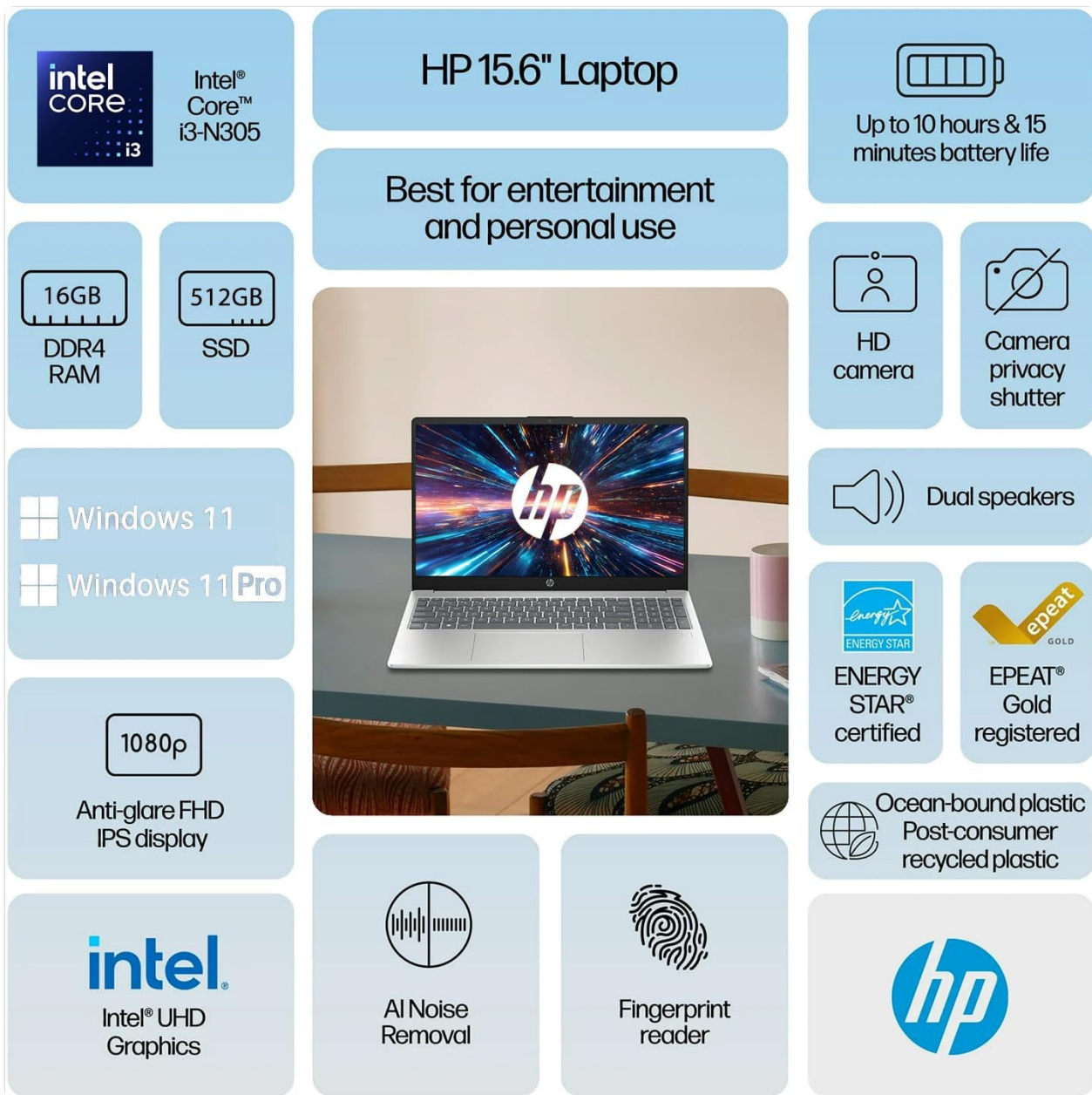


Figure 2: Overview of HP Pavilion 15.6" Laptop features.

## 2. INITIAL SETUP

### 2.1 Unpacking and First Power On

1. Carefully remove the laptop and all accessories from the packaging.
2. Connect the power adapter to the laptop's power connector and then to a power outlet.
3. Open the laptop lid. The laptop may power on automatically, or you may need to press the power button located on the keyboard.
4. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the initial Windows 11 setup, including language selection, network connection, and user account creation.

### 2.2 Connecting the HP P500 Portable SSD

The HP P500 Portable SSD is an external storage device included with your laptop. To connect it:

1. Locate the USB-C cable provided with the portable SSD.
2. Connect one end of the USB-C cable to the HP P500 Portable SSD.
3. Connect the other end of the USB-C cable to an available USB-C port on your HP Pavilion laptop.
4. The operating system will automatically detect and configure the drive. You can access it through File Explorer.

## 3. OPERATING YOUR LAPTOP

### 3.1 Keyboard and Touchpad

The laptop features a full-size English (US) keyboard and a multi-touch touchpad. Refer to the HP Support website for detailed information on keyboard shortcuts and touchpad gestures.

### 3.2 Fingerprint Reader

The built-in fingerprint reader allows for secure and quick login. To set up your fingerprint:

1. Go to **Settings > Accounts > Sign-in options**.
2. Under "Ways to sign in," select **Fingerprint recognition (Windows Hello)** and follow the on-screen instructions to register your fingerprints.

### 3.3 Connectivity (Wi-Fi 6 and Bluetooth 5.3)

Your laptop supports Wi-Fi 6 for high-speed wireless internet and Bluetooth 5.3 for connecting wireless peripherals.

- **Wi-Fi:** Click the Wi-Fi icon in the taskbar, select your desired network, and enter the password if prompted.
- **Bluetooth:** Go to **Settings > Bluetooth & devices** to pair new Bluetooth devices.

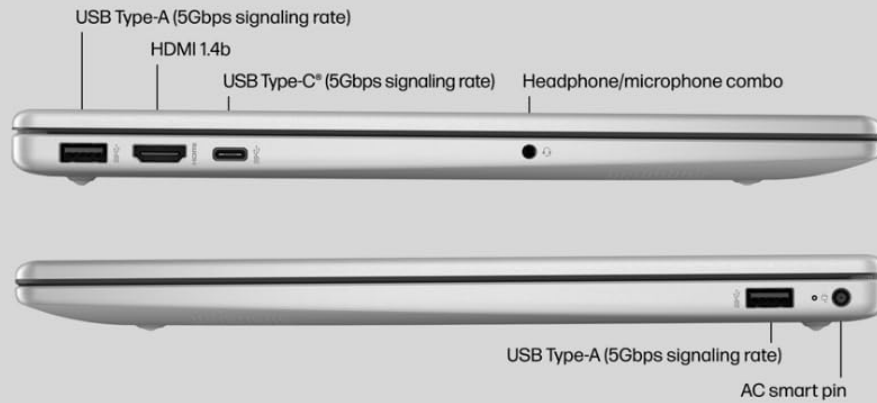


Figure 5: Laptop demonstrating Wi-Fi 6 and audio capabilities during a video call.

### 3.4 External Ports

The laptop is equipped with various ports for connecting external devices:

- **USB-C (1x):** For data transfer and connecting USB-C compatible devices.
- **USB Type-A (2x):** For connecting standard USB devices like mice, keyboards, or external drives.
- **HDMI (1x):** For connecting to external displays or projectors.
- **Headphone / microphone combo jack (1x):** For connecting headphones or a headset with a microphone.
- **Power connector (1x):** For connecting the AC adapter.

## 4. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

### 4.1 Battery Care

- To maximize battery lifespan, avoid extreme temperatures.
- For optimal performance, allow the battery to discharge partially before recharging.
- The laptop supports HP Fast Charge, allowing it to charge 0 to 50% in approximately 45 minutes.

### 4.2 Cleaning Your Laptop

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water or a screen cleaner to clean the display.
- For the keyboard and chassis, use a soft, dry cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- Ensure the laptop is powered off and unplugged before cleaning.

### 4.3 Software Updates

Regularly update your Windows 11 operating system and drivers to ensure optimal performance and security.

- **Windows Updates:** Go to **Settings > Windows Update** and check for updates.
- **Driver Updates:** HP provides driver updates through its support website or HP Support Assistant software.

## 5. TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

### 5.1 Power Issues

- **Laptop does not turn on:** Ensure the power adapter is securely connected to both the laptop and a working power outlet. Try a different outlet.
- **Battery not charging:** Verify the power adapter is functioning correctly. Check for any physical damage to the adapter or charging port.

### 5.2 Display Problems

- **No display on screen:** Connect an external monitor via HDMI to check if the issue is with the laptop's internal display. If the external monitor works, the internal display may require service.
- **Flickering or distorted display:** Update your graphics drivers. Adjust display resolution in Windows settings.

### 5.3 Connectivity Problems

- **Wi-Fi not connecting:** Ensure Wi-Fi is enabled. Restart your router and modem. Forget the network and reconnect.
- **Bluetooth device not pairing:** Ensure the Bluetooth device is in pairing mode and within range. Restart the laptop and the Bluetooth device.

### 5.4 Performance Issues

- **Slow performance:** Close unnecessary applications. Check Task Manager for high CPU/RAM usage. Ensure sufficient free space on the primary SSD.
- **System freezes:** Perform a system restart. Check for recent software installations or updates that might be causing conflicts.

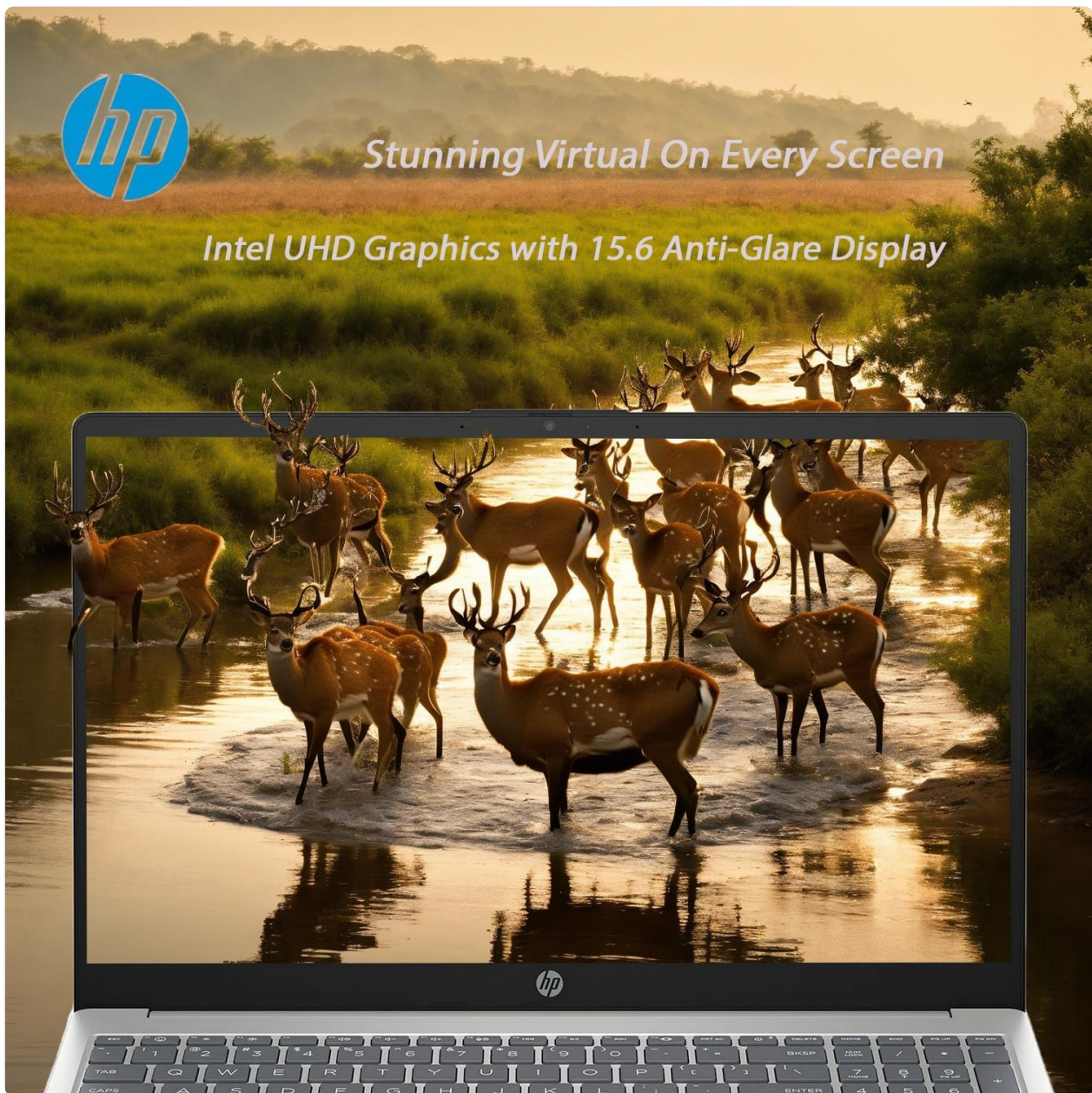


Figure 7: The laptop's 15.6-inch anti-glare display.
