# Generic 12-Cup Coffee Maker Pot Replacement Model 8080 User Manual

For Mr. Coffee 12-Cup Coffee Maker Models RF, LM, PC, SC Series

## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

This manual provides instructions for the proper use and care of your Generic 12-Cup Coffee Maker Pot Replacement, Model 8080. This carafe is designed to be a compatible replacement for specific Mr. Coffee 12-cup coffee maker models. Please read this manual thoroughly before first use to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your replacement pot.

## 2. COMPATIBILITY

### 3. SETUP

---

Before using your new replacement coffee pot for the first time, follow these steps:

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove the carafe and its lid from the packaging.
2. **Inspect:** Check the glass carafe and lid for any signs of damage during transit. Do not use if damaged.

3. **Wash:** Wash the carafe and lid thoroughly with warm, soapy water. Rinse completely to remove any residue.
4. **Dry:** Dry all components completely before placing them into your coffee maker.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

Using the replacement carafe with your compatible Mr. Coffee machine is straightforward:

1. **Placement:** Ensure the carafe is correctly seated on the warming plate of your coffee maker. The lid should be properly aligned to activate the drip-stop mechanism of the coffee maker.
2. **Filling:** Use the clearly marked cup measurements on the side of the carafe to fill it with the desired amount of water for brewing.
3. **Pouring:** The ergonomic handle and pour spout are designed for comfortable grip and drip-free pouring. Tilt the carafe gently to pour brewed coffee.

## 5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

---

Proper cleaning and care will extend the life of your replacement coffee pot:

- **Cleaning:** The glass carafe and lid are dishwasher safe. For best results and to prevent mineral buildup, wash after each use.
- **Hand Washing:** If hand washing, use a soft sponge or cloth with warm, soapy water. Avoid abrasive cleaners or scouring pads that could scratch the glass.
- **Heat Resistance:** The carafe is made from heat-resistant glass, suitable for use on your coffee maker's warming plate. Avoid sudden temperature changes, such as placing a hot carafe directly into cold water, which could cause thermal shock and breakage.
- **Storage:** Store the carafe in a safe place where it will not be easily knocked over or dropped.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues with your replacement coffee pot, consider the following:

- **Carafe Does Not Fit:** Double-check the compatibility list in Section 2. Ensure your Mr. Coffee model is listed. Verify the height and base diameter of your original carafe against the replacement.
- **Coffee Tastes Weak:** Some replacement carafes may have slightly different measurement markings than your original. If your coffee tastes weaker, try adjusting the amount of water or coffee grounds used. For example, if the new carafe's '4 cup' mark results in more volume than your old carafe's '4

cup' mark, you may need to use less water or more coffee.

- **Leakage:** Ensure the lid is securely placed on the carafe and that the carafe is properly seated on the coffee maker's warming plate. Inspect the carafe for any cracks or damage that could cause leaks.
- **Drip-Stop Not Activating:** Confirm the carafe's lid is correctly positioned to engage with your coffee maker's drip-stop mechanism. If the lid is misaligned, coffee may continue to drip when the carafe is removed.
