1. SETUP

1.1 Battery Installation

The OMAIC NS-RCFNA-21 remote control requires two AAA batteries (not included) for operation. Follow these steps to install them:

- 1. Locate the battery compartment cover on the back of the remote control.
- 2. Slide the cover downwards to open the compartment.
- 3. Insert two AAA batteries, ensuring the positive (+) and negative (-) terminals align correctly with the indicators inside the compartment.
- 4. Slide the battery compartment cover back into place until it clicks securely.

1.2 Pairing the Remote with Your Smart TV

To enable full functionality, including voice control, the remote must be paired with your compatible Smart TV. Follow the on-screen instructions or these general steps:

- 1. Ensure your TV is powered on.
- 2. Insert two AAA batteries into the remote control as described above.
- 3. Press and hold the **Home** button on the remote for approximately 10-15 seconds, or until the indicator light on the remote begins to flash.
- 4. On your TV, navigate to the Settings menu.
- 5. Select Controllers & Bluetooth Devices.
- 6. Choose TV Remotes, then Add New Remote.
- 7. Your TV will begin searching for the new remote. Select the OMAIC remote from the list when it appears.
- 8. A confirmation message will appear on your TV screen once pairing is successful.

2. OPERATING THE REMOTE

2.1 Button Functions

The OMAIC NS-RCFNA-21 remote control features a user-friendly layout with dedicated buttons for various functions:

2.2 Voice Control Functionality

The remote features integrated voice control for convenient operation:

- 1. Press and hold the Microphone/Voice Button located near the top of the remote.
- 2. Speak your command clearly into the microphone. Examples include: "Play [movie title]", "Open Netflix", "Search for [genre] movies", or "Go to channel [number]".
- 3. Release the button when you are finished speaking. The TV will process your command.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

5.1 Remote Not Responding

- **Check Batteries:** Ensure batteries are correctly inserted and have sufficient charge. Replace with fresh AAA batteries if needed.
- **Re-pair Remote:** If the remote becomes unresponsive, try re-pairing it with your TV using the steps outlined in Section 1.2.
- **Remove Obstructions:** Ensure there are no physical obstructions between the remote control and your TV's infrared receiver.

5.2 Voice Control Not Working

- **Verify Pairing:** Voice control requires successful Bluetooth pairing. Confirm the remote is paired correctly (refer to Section 1.2).
- Check TV Settings: Ensure that the voice assistant feature is enabled in your TV's settings.
- **Speak Clearly:** Speak directly into the microphone on the remote, holding the voice button down while speaking.

5.3 Buttons Lagging or Delayed Response

- Replace Batteries: Low battery power can cause delayed responses. Replace batteries with new ones.
- **Reduce Interference:** Ensure other electronic devices are not causing interference. Try moving closer to the TV.


