1. Introduction

This manual provides essential information for the proper use and maintenance of your Kobo Stylus 2. Designed for seamless integration with Kobo Libra Colour and Kobo Sage eReaders, the Stylus 2 enhances your reading and note-taking experience.

The Kobo Stylus 2 is lightweight and ergonomically designed, featuring a redesigned tip for comfortable and precise interaction. It allows for marking up eBooks and PDFs, taking notes, and highlighting content directly on your compatible Kobo eReader.

2. SETUP

2.1 Unboxing

Upon opening the Kobo Stylus 2 packaging, ensure all components are present:

- · Kobo Stylus 2
- · Two replacement tips

2.2 Charging

The Kobo Stylus 2 is rechargeable via USB-C. To charge:

- 1. Locate the USB-C charging port on the stylus. This port is typically revealed by rotating and pulling the pen body.
- 2. Connect a USB-C cable (not included) to the stylus and to a compatible power source.
- 3. A charging indicator light will typically illuminate during charging and turn off or change color when fully charged.

Note: A full charge provides extended usage time. Refer to the specifications section for battery life details.

2.3 Compatibility

The Kobo Stylus 2 is compatible with the following Kobo eReaders:

- Kobo Libra Colour eReader
- · Kobo Sage eReader

Ensure your eReader's software is up to date for optimal stylus performance.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Basic Usage: Marking, Highlighting, and Erasing

The Kobo Stylus 2 allows for direct interaction with your eReader screen.

- Writing/Drawing: Use the stylus tip directly on the screen to write notes or draw.
- **Highlighting:** Press and hold the intuitive highlighter button on the stylus barrel while dragging the tip over text to highlight.
- Erasing: Use the eraser on the back of the Kobo Stylus 2 to correct mistakes.

3.2 Note-taking and Annotation

- **Notebooks:** Access the notebook feature on your Kobo eReader to create new notes, sketches, or diagrams.
- In-text Annotation: Write directly on the pages of your books to add comments,

underline important passages, or circle key terms.

• Color Highlighting (Kobo Libra Colour): On the Kobo Libra Colour eReader, you can write notes and make highlights in various colors.

3.3 Text Conversion

For advanced notebooks, the Kobo Stylus 2 allows you to convert handwritten notes to typed text:

- 1. Write your notes as usual in an Advanced Notebook.
- 2. Double-tap on your handwritten notes to initiate the conversion to typed text.

4. MAINTENANCE
