1. Introduction

3. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

- 3. For the tweeters, utilize the included in-line filters. These filters are essential for proper frequency distribution and protection of the tweeter.
- 4. Secure all connections to prevent accidental disconnections or shorts.

- Audio Settings: Utilize your head unit's equalizer, balance, and fader controls to fine-tune the sound to your preference.

• Source Selection: Play audio from various sources (radio, Bluetooth, USB) to experience the full range of your speakers' capabilities.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound from speakers	Loose wiring, incorrect polarity, head unit issue, amplifier issue	Check all wiring connections. Verify correct positive/negative polarity. Test head unit and amplifier functionality.
Distorted sound	Volume too high, incorrect audio settings, damaged speaker, insufficient power	Reduce volume. Adjust equalizer settings. Inspect speakers for physical damage. Ensure adequate power supply.
One speaker not working	Loose connection, damaged speaker wire, faulty speaker	Check wiring for the specific speaker. Test the speaker with a known good audio source.
