- Built to Last with Lightweight Strength:** Crafted from high-quality stainless steel for durability and daily use in gardens, lawns, or yards.



## SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The WORKPRO Weed Puller Tool is designed for quick and easy assembly.

- Unpack Components:** You should find three connector rods and one 4-claw steel head.
- Connect Rods:** Screw the connector rods into each other securely. Ensure all connections are tight to prevent wobbling during use.
- Attach Head:** Screw the 4-claw steel head onto the end of the assembled rods.
- Adjust Handle Length:** The handle can be adjusted to 33 inches or 46 inches by adding or removing one of the middle rod sections. Choose the length that is most comfortable for your height.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps for effective weed removal:

- 1. Position the Tool:** Place the 4-claw steel head directly over the center of the weed you wish to remove.
- 2. Engage the Claws:** Press the tool downwards into the soil. Use the foot pedal to apply additional leverage, ensuring the claws fully penetrate the soil around the weed's root system.
- 3. Extract the Weed:** Once the claws are firmly gripping the weed's roots, tilt the tool towards the foot pedal. This action will leverage the weed and its root system out of the ground.
- 4. Release the Weed:** To release the weed from the claws, simply push the handle forward or use your foot to dislodge it into a collection bin.



## Recommended Use

- Best results are achieved in moist, but not waterlogged, soil.
- Target weeds such as dandelions, thistles, crabgrass, creepy charlie, and chickweed.


## MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and performance of your weed puller.

- Cleaning:** After each use, rinse the 4-claw steel head and rods with water to remove soil and plant debris. Allow to air dry completely to prevent rust.
- Storage:** Store the tool in a dry place. The detachable design allows for compact storage in a garage or garden shed. Utilize the square hanging hole for convenient wall storage.
- Inspection:** Periodically check all screw connections to ensure they remain tight. Tighten if necessary.

# WEEDING FROM THE ROOTS

With foot pedals, you can push the claws into the ground to easily remove weeds, helping surrounding plants thrive.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your WORKPRO Weed Puller Tool, consider the following:

- **Difficulty Penetrating Soil:**

- Ensure the soil is adequately moist. Dry, hard soil can make penetration difficult. Water the area before weeding if necessary.
- Apply more pressure to the foot pedal to drive the claws deeper.

- **Weeds Not Being Pulled Completely:**

- Verify that the claws are centered over the weed's base and have fully gripped the root system.
- Ensure the tool is tilted sufficiently to leverage the weed out.

- **Tool Feels Loose:**

- Check all threaded connections between the handle sections and the head. Tighten any loose parts.

- **Weeds Stuck in Claws:**

- Use a stick or another tool to gently dislodge any stubborn weeds from the claws.
