INTRODUCTION

SAFETY INFORMATION

To ensure safe operation, always observe the following precautions:

- Do not expose the unit to extreme temperatures, humidity, or direct sunlight.
- Avoid placing the unit near heat sources or in areas with poor ventilation.
- Do not place objects containing liquids on the unit.
- Use only the specified power adapter.
- Keep the unit away from children.
- Disconnect the power cord during lightning storms or when unused for long periods.

SETUP

1. Assembling the Keyboard Stand

Unfold the FocusProAudio Adjustable Double X Keyboard Stand and adjust it to a comfortable playing height. Ensure all locking mechanisms are securely fastened to provide stable support for the digital piano.

2. Setting up the Keyboard Bench

Unfold the Knox Gear Adjustable X-Style Keyboard Bench. Adjust the bench height to your preference. The bench

features a 2-inch padded cushion for comfort and rubber-tipped feet for stability.

3. Placing the Digital Piano

Carefully place the Roland RD-2000 EX Digital Piano onto the assembled keyboard stand. Ensure it is centered and stable.

4. Connecting the Sustain Pedal

Connect the On Stage KSP100 Keyboard Piano Style Sustain Pedal to the designated pedal input on the rear panel of the RD-2000 EX. This pedal provides sustain control for your playing.

5. Powering On/Off

Connect the power adapter to the DC IN jack on the rear panel of the digital piano, then plug the adapter into a power outlet. Press the power button located on the control panel to turn the unit ON or OFF.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Basic Controls

The RD-2000 EX features a streamlined control panel for intuitive operation. Adjust the master volume using the dedicated slider. The power button controls the unit's on/off state.

2. Sound Engines and Keybed

The digital piano is equipped with dual sound engines and a PHA-50 Progressive Hammer-action Keybed, providing a realistic piano playing experience. The keybed offers a graded hammer feel, mimicking an acoustic grand piano.

MAINTENANCE

To maintain your Roland RD-2000 EX Digital Piano and accessories in optimal condition:

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the surface of the piano and accessories. For stubborn dirt, slightly dampen the cloth with water and a mild detergent, then wipe dry immediately. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** When not in use, cover the piano with a dust cover to protect it from dust and debris. Store in a stable environment away from direct sunlight and extreme temperature changes.
- **Transportation:** When moving the piano, ensure it is properly secured in a protective case to prevent damage. Disassemble the stand and bench for easier and safer transport.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Roland RD-2000 EX, refer to the following common solutions:

- **No Sound:** Check if the power is on, the volume is turned up, and headphones are not plugged in (unless intended). Ensure all cables (audio, pedal) are securely connected.
- **Keys Not Responding:** Verify the unit is powered on. If specific keys are unresponsive, contact customer support.
- **Distorted Sound:** Check the volume levels of the piano and any connected audio equipment. Ensure cables are not damaged and connections are secure.
- **Pedal Not Working:** Confirm the sustain pedal is correctly plugged into the designated jack on the rear panel.
