1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the YTBDDHYUE Lower Dishrack Roller. This guide provides essential information for the safe and correct installation and maintenance of your new dishwasher part. This roller is designed as a replacement part compatible with Whirlpool WDT750SAHB0 dishwashers. Please read these instructions thoroughly before beginning the installation process.

4. INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps carefully to replace the lower dishrack roller.

1. Prepare the Dishwasher:

- Ensure the dishwasher is completely empty.
- Disconnect the dishwasher from its power supply by unplugging it or turning off the circuit breaker.
- Pull the lower dishrack out of the dishwasher as far as it will go.

2. Remove the Old Roller:

- Locate the damaged or worn roller on the lower dishrack.
- Depending on the design, the roller may snap into place or be held by a small clip. Gently pry off the old roller using a flathead screwdriver or your fingers. Be careful not to damage the dishrack.
- Some rollers might require a slight twist to unlock them from their mounting post.

3. Install the New Roller:

- Align the new YTBDDHYUE Lower Dishrack Roller with the mounting post on the dishrack.
- Press the new roller firmly into place until it snaps securely onto the post. Ensure it is seated correctly and does not wobble.
- If the old roller required twisting, twist the new roller in the opposite direction to secure it.

4. Test and Reassemble:

- Once all necessary rollers are replaced, gently slide the lower dishrack back and forth to ensure it moves smoothly and without obstruction.
- Reconnect the dishwasher to its power supply.

- Perform a test run of the dishwasher to confirm proper operation.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance can extend the life of your dishrack rollers and ensure smooth operation of your dishwasher.

- **Regular Cleaning:** Periodically inspect and clean the rollers and their tracks to remove any food debris, grease, or mineral deposits that may hinder smooth movement. Use a damp cloth and mild detergent if necessary.
- **Avoid Overloading:** Do not overload the dishrack, as excessive weight can put undue stress on the rollers and cause premature wear.
- **Gentle Handling:** Always slide the dishrack in and out gently. Avoid forcing it, which can damage the rollers or the dishrack itself.
- **Inspect for Wear:** Regularly check the rollers for signs of wear, cracks, or flat spots. Replace them promptly if damage is observed to prevent further issues with the dishrack or dishwasher.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues after replacing the dishrack roller, refer to the following common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Dishrack not sliding smoothly	Roller not properly seated; debris in track; damaged track.	Ensure rollers are securely snapped into place. Clean tracks of any debris. Inspect tracks for damage and repair if necessary.
Roller falls off	Improper installation; worn mounting post on dishrack.	Re-install roller, ensuring it clicks into place. If the mounting post is damaged, the dishrack itself may need replacement.
Dishrack is wobbly	One or more rollers are missing or damaged; dishrack frame bent.	Check all rollers for proper installation and condition. Replace any missing or damaged rollers. Inspect dishrack for structural damage.
