Product Overview

Setup and Installation

- **Function Keys (F1-F12):** These keys may be programmed by the ultrasound system software to perform specific functions. Refer to your ultrasound system's user manual for details on their assignments.
- **Specialized Keys:** Keys labeled "Comment", "Alt", and "Utility" are typically integrated with the ultrasound software for quick access to specific features or modes relevant to imaging and data management. Their exact functionality is defined by the ultrasound system's software configuration.
- **Navigation Keys:** Utilize arrow keys, Page Up/Down, Home, and End for navigating through menus and data fields on the ultrasound display.
- **Numeric Keypad:** If present, the numeric keypad allows for rapid entry of numerical data.

Always ensure your hands are clean and dry before operating the keyboard to maintain hygiene and prevent damage.

Maintenance

- **Cleaning:**

 - Do not spray cleaning solutions directly onto the keyboard.
 - Clean the surface of the keys and the surrounding areas. For hard-to-reach areas between keys, use compressed air to remove dust and debris.
 - Allow the keyboard to air dry completely before reconnecting it to the system.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, store the keyboard in a clean, dry environment, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

- **Handling:** Avoid dropping the keyboard or exposing it to excessive force, as this can damage internal components.

Troubleshooting

- **Intermittent Functionality:** This could indicate a loose connection or internal damage. Re-check connections. If the problem persists, professional inspection may be required.

If troubleshooting steps do not resolve the issue, contact technical support or a qualified service professional. Do not attempt to disassemble the keyboard yourself, as this may void the warranty.
