ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly requires adult supervision. Please follow these steps carefully:

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging and lay them out on a clean, flat surface. Verify all parts are present against the package contents list.
2. **Assemble Main Frame:** Connect the main wooden panels and legs using the provided hardware. Ensure all connections are secure but do not overtighten.
3. **Install Sink and Faucet:** Place the removable sink into its designated opening. Attach the water reservoir and faucet according to the diagrams. Ensure the faucet is securely attached and can be operated.
4. **Attach Insect Observation Box and Planter:** Secure the insect observation box to the left side and the planter to the right side of the main structure using the appropriate hardware.
5. **Add Shelves and Hooks:** Install any internal shelves and hooks for hanging utensils.
6. **Final Check:** Once assembled, gently shake the mud kitchen to ensure stability. Tighten any loose

screws if necessary.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The ROBOTIME Mud Kitchen is designed for interactive and imaginative play. Here's how to use its main features:

- **Water Play:** Fill the water reservoir with water. The faucet can be turned to allow water to flow into the removable sink, simulating real kitchen activities. Ensure the sink is properly placed to catch water.
- **Mud & Sand Play:** Encourage children to use natural elements like mud, sand, leaves, and water in the sink and pots for creative "cooking."
- **Insect Observation:** Place small, harmless insects into the observation box for children to safely view and learn about. Remember to release them gently after observation.
- **Gardening:** Use the planter box for real or pretend gardening. Children can plant seeds, small plants, or simply use soil and gardening tools.

- **Accessory Use:** The included cups, basins, pots, and utensils are designed for use with water, mud, and other play materials.

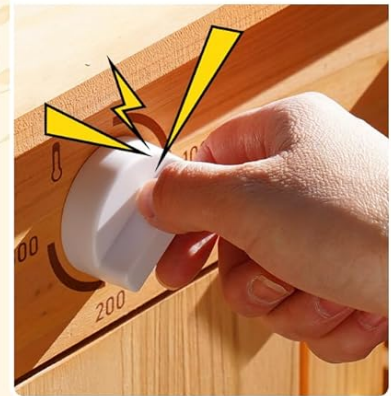


Figure 5: Real Water Flow for Role Play. This image highlights the functional faucet and sink, demonstrating how water flows for realistic washing and cooking role-play with toy food items.

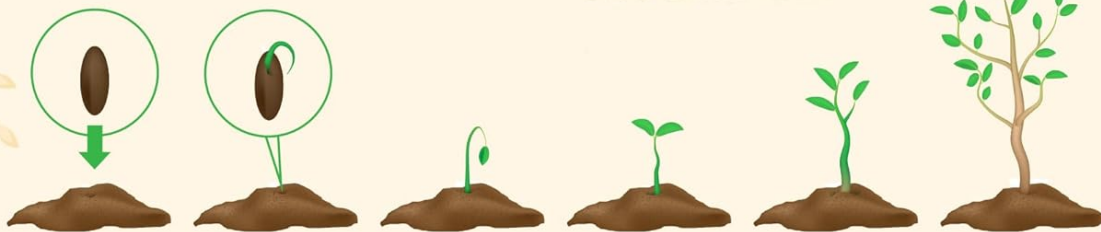


Figure 6: Planting and Observation Features. This image displays the planter box feature, encouraging children to engage in gardening activities, and the insect observation box for learning about nature.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** After each use, especially with mud or water, clean all surfaces with a damp cloth. The removable sink and basins can be washed with mild soap and water.
- **Drying:** Ensure all wooden parts are thoroughly dried after cleaning to prevent mold or warping. Do not leave the mud kitchen exposed to prolonged rain or extreme weather conditions.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, store the mud kitchen in a dry, covered area to protect the wood.
- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect all screws and connections for tightness. Tighten as needed. Check for any signs of wear or damage to wooden parts and address them promptly.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Water leaks from faucet/sink area.	Faucet not properly sealed or sink not seated correctly.	Ensure faucet connections are tight. Check that the removable sink is fully inserted into its opening.
Mud kitchen feels unstable after assembly.	Screws or bolts are loose.	Re-check all assembly points and tighten all hardware securely.
Missing parts during assembly.	Packaging error or parts misplaced.	Refer to the "Package Contents" section. Contact ROBOTIME customer support with your model number and a description of the missing part.

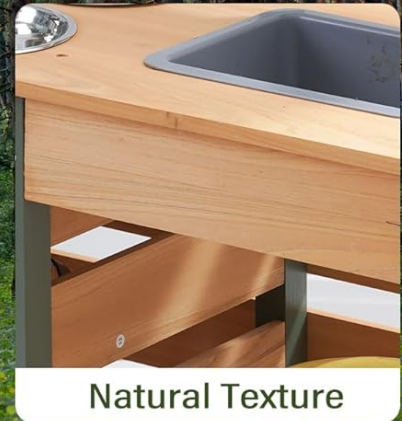


Figure 8: Detailed Dimensions. This image provides a visual representation of the mud kitchen's dimensions, including height, width, and depth, for accurate spatial planning.
