#### 1. Introduction

This user manual provides detailed instructions for the safe and efficient operation, installation, and maintenance of your Mora PC05R25A Portable Air Conditioner. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the appliance and retain it for future reference. This 5,000 BTU portable air conditioner is designed to provide cooling, dehumidification, and fan functions for rooms up to 150 sq. ft.

#### 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Always follow basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury to persons.

- Ensure the power supply matches the voltage specified on the unit's rating label.
- Do not operate the unit with a damaged cord or plug.
- Do not block air inlets or outlets. Maintain at least 20 inches of clearance around the unit.
- Do not use the unit in wet or damp environments.
- Unplug the unit before cleaning or servicing.
- Keep children and pets away from the unit during operation.

The Mora PC05R25A Portable Air Conditioner offers versatile 3-in-1 comfort with Fan, Dry, and Cool modes. It features a hassle-free, no-drain operation due to its self-evaporation system, intuitive controls, and an easy-to-clean washable filter.

#### 4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The Mora PC05R25A is designed for quick and easy setup. Follow these steps for proper installation.

#### 4.1 Unpacking

- Remove all packaging materials and ensure all components are present.
- Place the unit upright on a flat, stable surface.

#### 4.2 Window Kit Installation

- 1. Assemble the window slider kit according to your window's dimensions. The kit is adjustable to fit various window sizes.
- 2. Insert the exhaust hose into the adapter and then connect it to the exhaust port on the back of the unit.
- 3. Secure the other end of the exhaust hose adapter into the opening of the window slider kit.
- 4. Close the window securely against the slider kit to seal the opening.

#### 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your portable air conditioner can be operated using the control panel on the unit or the remote control.

#### **5.1 Control Panel**

- Power Button: Turns the unit on or off.
- Mode Button: Cycles through Cool, Dry, and Fan modes.
- **Temperature Adjustment (+/-):** Adjusts the desired temperature setting.
- Fan Speed: Selects between High and Low fan speeds.
- Timer: Sets a timer for automatic on/off operation.
- Sleep Mode: Activates a quiet operation mode for comfortable sleep.
- **Swing:** Activates the automatic swing function for wider air distribution.

#### **5.2 Operating Modes**

- **Cool Mode:** Provides powerful cooling. Set your desired temperature using the +/- buttons.
- Dry Mode: Functions as a dehumidifier, removing excess moisture from the air.
- Fan Mode: Circulates air without cooling. Choose between high and low fan speeds.

#### 6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and longevity of your air conditioner.

#### **6.1 Filter Cleaning**

The removable, washable filter should be cleaned regularly (every two weeks or as needed) to maintain air quality and unit efficiency.

- 1. Turn off and unplug the unit.
- 2. Remove the air filter from its housing.
- 3. Wash the filter under running water or use a vacuum cleaner to remove dust.
- 4. Allow the filter to air dry completely before reinserting it into the unit.

#### 6.2 Self-Evaporation System

This unit features a self-evaporation system that automatically evaporates and expels condensation. In extremely humid conditions, some water may accumulate. If the unit stops operating and displays an 'E5' error code, it indicates the water tank is full and needs to be drained. Refer to the troubleshooting section for draining instructions.

# **6.3 Storage**

Before storing the unit for an extended period:

- Drain any accumulated water completely.
- Clean the air filter.
- Unplug the power cord and coil it neatly.
- Store the unit in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

### 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience issues with your unit, refer to the following common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unit does not turn on.	No power, tripped circuit breaker, or power cord not fully plugged in.	Check power outlet, circuit breaker, and ensure the power cord is securely plugged in.
Unit is not cooling effectively.	Dirty air filter, blocked air intake/outlet, room size too large, or windows/doors open.	Clean the air filter. Ensure no obstructions. Close all windows and doors. Verify room size is within 150 sq. ft.
Unit is noisy.	Unit not on a flat surface, or normal operating sounds.	Ensure the unit is on a level surface. Some operational noise is normal.
Error Code 'E5' displayed.	Water tank is full.	Turn off the unit, unplug it, and drain the accumulated water from the drain port at the bottom. Restart the unit.
