3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The SYNCO XTALK XMAX2 features a comfortable dual-ear design with a flexible microphone boom and integrated controls for seamless operation. Each headset is equipped with dual antennas for enhanced signal stability and an easily accessible battery compartment.

- Al Noise Cancellation: Dual-mic algorithm minimizes ambient noise for clear communication.

- Boost Mode: Enhances signal strength for stable communication.
- MasterFree Algorithm: Allows any headset to become the master, supporting 2-13 users.

- One-Button Remote Muting: Dominant mode allows master unit to instantly silence all connected devices.

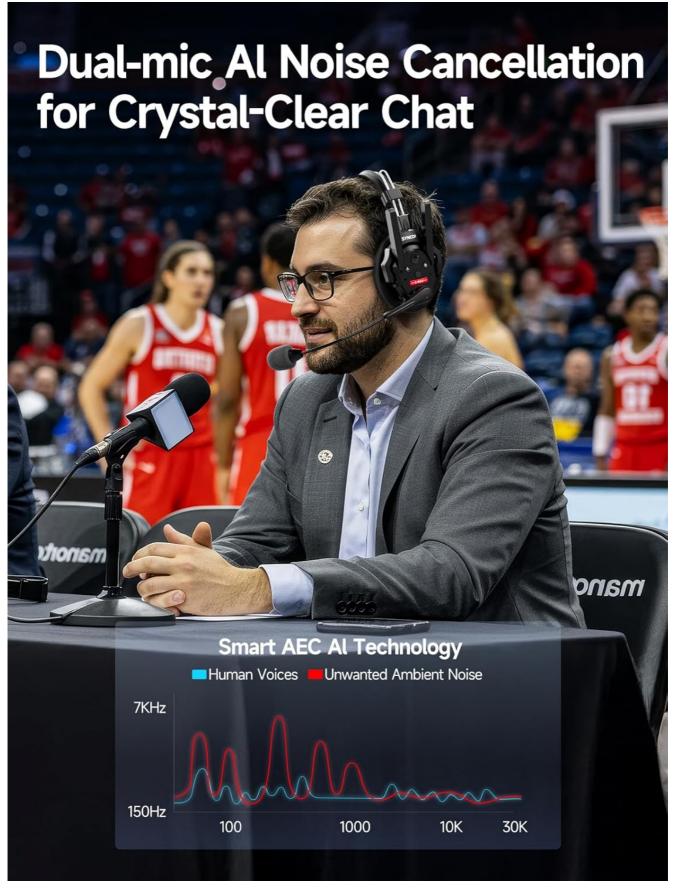


Image: A man wearing the SYNCO XTALK XMAX2 headset, illustrating the dual-mic AI noise cancellation feature for clear communication in noisy environments.

4. SETUP

4.1 Battery Installation

1. Locate the battery compartment on one of the headset earcups.

- 2. Slide the latch to unlock and open the compartment.
- 3. Insert the rechargeable battery, ensuring proper alignment with the contacts.
- 4. Close the compartment and slide the latch to lock it securely.
- 5. Repeat for all other headsets.

4.2 Power On/Off

- To power on, push the power toggle switch upwards. The headset will announce "Intercom Mode".
- To power off, push the power toggle switch downwards.

4.3 Pairing

The XTALK XMAX2 headsets are pre-paired from the factory (master X1 and ready to use). To ensure a successful auto-reconnection, always power on the headsets in the sequence of Master -> Level 1 -> Level 2.

- 1. Power on the Master headset first.
- 2. Power on the Level 1 headsets.
- 3. Power on the Level 2 headsets.

The headsets will automatically connect. You will hear "Pairing Successful" once connected.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Volume Control

- Use the '+' button to increase volume.
- Use the '-' button to decrease volume.

5.2 Al Noise Cancellation

• Press the 'B' button once to toggle AI noise cancellation on or off. The headset will announce the status.

5.3 Group Communication (MasterFree Algorithm)

The MasterFree Algorithm allows any headset to function as a master unit, enabling flexible group chats for 2 to 13 people.

- Long press button 'A' to set a headset as Master (Level 1) or Level 2.
- The Master unit can communicate with all Level 1 and Level 2 headsets.
- Level 1 headsets can communicate with each other and the Master.
- Level 2 headsets can communicate with each other and the Master.

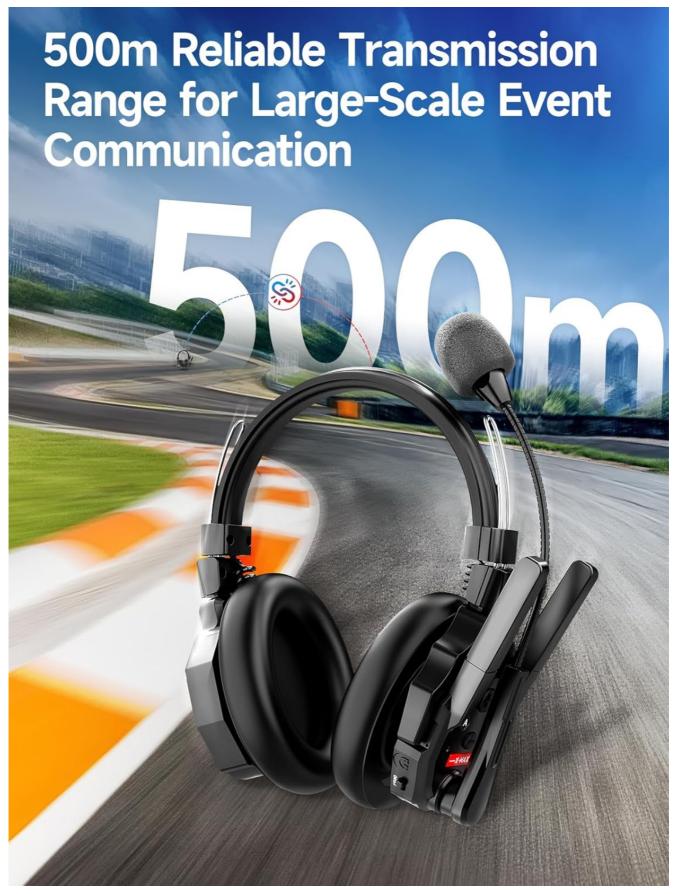


Image: A film crew utilizing SYNCO XTALK XMAX2 headsets, demonstrating efficient group communication compared to traditional methods.

5.4 Boost Mode

 Press the 'A' button once to activate Boost Mode, which enhances signal strength for stable communication over longer distances.

5.5 Phone Connectivity

- The headset supports Bluetooth connectivity. Enable Bluetooth on your smartphone and select the XTALK XMAX2 to pair.
- Once connected, you can make/receive calls and listen to music through the headset.

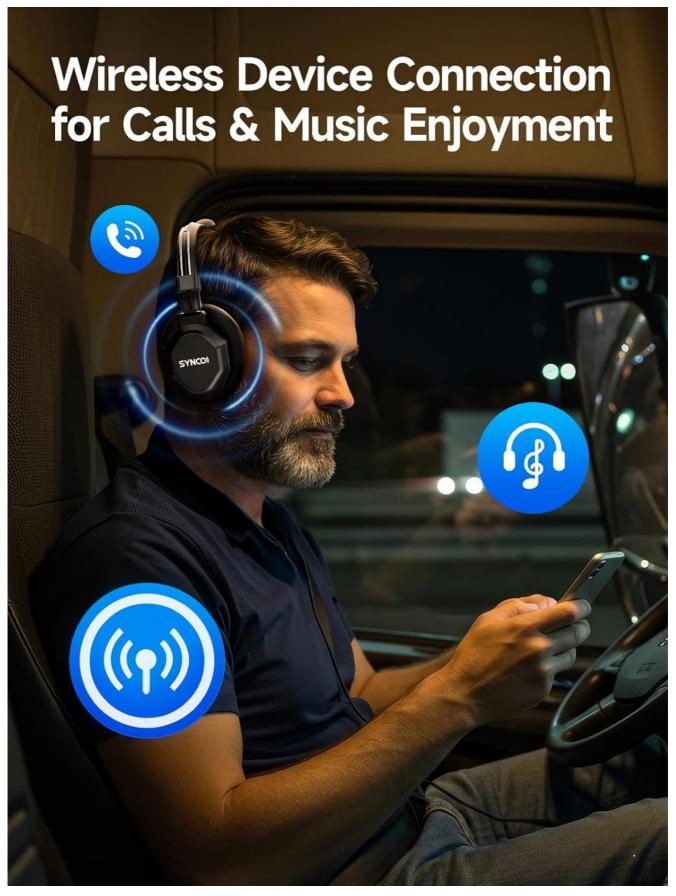


Image: A man wearing the SYNCO XTALK XMAX2 headset while using a smartphone, illustrating wireless device connection for calls and music enjoyment.

- Connect a 3.5mm audio cable from the headset's monitoring jack to your camera or recording device.
- This allows for real-time audio monitoring, ensuring clear sound capture during production.

5.7 One-Button Remote Muting (Dominant Mode)

• In Dominant mode, the master unit can instantly silence all connected remote devices by pressing a dedicated

6. MAINTENANCE

- Keep the headsets clean by wiping them with a soft, dry cloth.
- Avoid exposing the devices to extreme temperatures, moisture, or corrosive substances.

- Store the headsets in their carrying bags when not in use to prevent damage.
- Charge batteries using the provided charging station and cable.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

7.1 No Power

- Ensure batteries are correctly installed and fully charged.
- Check the power toggle switch is in the 'ON' position.

7.2 Pairing Issues

- Ensure all headsets are powered on in the correct Master -> Level 1 -> Level 2 sequence.
- If issues persist, refer to the pairing instructions in the user manual for detailed steps.

7.3 Poor Audio Quality or Range

- Ensure the antennas are properly extended.
- · Activate Boost Mode for enhanced signal strength.
- · Check for obstructions between headsets that might interfere with the signal.
- Ensure Al Noise Cancellation is enabled in noisy environments.
