1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Brigii Handheld Vacuum M2. This versatile device is designed for efficient cleaning in various environments, offering a 3-in-1 multifunctionality as a handheld vacuum, a blower, and a hand pump. Its compact and cordless design makes it ideal for cleaning hard-to-reach areas in your car, desk, furniture, and other indoor spaces. This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your new device.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Please verify that all items listed below are included in your package:

- Brigii Handheld Vacuum M2 Unit
- Crevice Nozzle (for narrow gaps)
- Brush Nozzle (for dusting and delicate surfaces)
- Flexible Hose Nozzle (for extended reach)
- USB Charging Cable
- HEPA Filter (2 pieces)

3. SETUP AND CHARGING

3.1 Initial Charging

Before first use, fully charge the vacuum. Connect the USB charging cable to the charging port on the vacuum and plug the other end into a compatible USB power adapter (not included). The indicator light will show charging status and turn off or change color when fully charged. A full charge typically takes 3-4 hours.

3.2 Attaching Nozzles

Select the appropriate nozzle for your cleaning task. Firmly insert the desired nozzle into the vacuum's suction port until it clicks into place. For blower or hand pump functions, attach the nozzle to the exhaust port.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Powering On/Off and Suction Levels

Press the power button once to turn on the vacuum at the standard suction level. Press again to switch to the higher suction level. Press a third time to turn off the device. The Brigii M2 features 2 power levels for varying cleaning needs.

4.2 Vacuuming Function

Attach the desired nozzle (e.g., crevice tool for tight spaces, brush tool for delicate surfaces) to the suction inlet. Turn on the vacuum and move the nozzle over the area to be cleaned. This function is ideal for hard floors, car interiors, desks, and furniture.

4.3 Blower Function (Air Duster)

To use the blower function, attach a nozzle to the exhaust port of the vacuum. This function is useful for blowing dust out of keyboards, camera lenses, or other intricate electronics where vacuuming is not suitable.

4.4 Hand Pump Function

The hand pump function allows for quick inflation or deflation of small items. Attach the appropriate nozzle to the exhaust port for inflation, or to the suction port for deflation, depending on the item's valve type. Refer to the item's instructions for proper inflation/deflation procedures.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your Brigii Handheld Vacuum M2.

5.1 Emptying the Dust Bin

After each use or when the dust bin is full, detach it from the main unit and empty its contents into a waste bin. Tap the dust bin gently to dislodge any stuck debris.

5.2 Cleaning the HEPA Filter

The HEPA filter is washable and reusable. It is recommended to clean the filter regularly, especially when suction power decreases.

1. Remove the dust bin and carefully pull out the HEPA filter.
2. Rinse the filter under cool, running water until the water runs clear. Do not use detergent or hot water.
3. Allow the filter to air dry completely for at least 24 hours before reinserting it into the vacuum. Ensure it is completely dry to prevent mold or damage to the vacuum.

5.3 General Cleaning

Wipe the exterior of the vacuum with a soft, damp cloth. Do not immerse the main unit in water or use harsh chemicals.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Brigii Handheld Vacuum M2, please refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power / Does not turn on	Battery is low or depleted.	Charge the vacuum fully.
Weak suction power	Dust bin is full. HEPA filter is clogged. Nozzle or hose is blocked.	Empty the dust bin. Clean or replace the HEPA filter. Check and clear any blockages in the nozzles or hose.
Unusual noise during operation	Debris caught in the motor or fan. Loose component.	Turn off the vacuum immediately. Check for and remove any foreign objects. If the noise persists, contact customer support.
Charging indicator not working	Faulty charging cable or adapter. Charging port issue.	Try a different USB cable and power adapter. Ensure the charging port is clean and free of debris.
