Introduction

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, installation, and maintenance of your Cecotec Bolero Dresscode Dry 10500 Inverter Heat Pump Dryer. Please read these instructions thoroughly before using the appliance and retain them for future reference.

Safety Information

Always adhere to the following safety guidelines to prevent injury or damage to the appliance:

- Ensure the dryer is installed on a stable, level surface in a well-ventilated area.
- Do not block ventilation openings.
- Connect the appliance to a properly grounded electrical outlet.
- Do not dry items that have been soiled with flammable substances.
- Regularly clean the lint filter to maintain efficiency and prevent fire hazards.
- Keep children and pets away from the appliance during operation.
- Unplug the dryer before performing any maintenance or cleaning.

Product Overview

The Cecotec Bolero Dresscode Dry 10500 Inverter is a 10 kg capacity heat pump dryer designed for efficient and gentle garment care. It features an Inverter Motor Plus for quiet and durable operation, along with advanced functions for optimal drying results.

Key Features:

- **10 kg Capacity:** Suitable for large laundry loads.
- **Heat Pump Technology:** Energy-efficient and gentle drying.
- **Inverter Motor Plus:** Ensures quiet, long-lasting, and energy-efficient performance.

- **UV Care Feature:** Uses ultraviolet light to sterilize clothes during drying, reducing bacteria.

- **Delay Start Function:** Program the drying cycle to start at a convenient time.
- **My Fav Function:** Save and quickly access your preferred drying program.
- **KidLock Function:** Prevents accidental program changes by children.
- **Energy Efficiency:** Rated A+++ (old scale) / C (new scale) for reduced power consumption.

Control Panel:

The control panel allows you to select programs and activate various functions. Familiarize yourself with the dial and buttons for optimal use.

Setup and Installation

1. Unpacking

Carefully remove all packaging materials. Inspect the dryer for any transit damage. Keep packaging materials away from children.

2. Placement

Place the dryer on a firm, level floor. Ensure there is adequate space around the appliance for ventilation. Do not

install the dryer in areas prone to freezing temperatures or excessive humidity. Adjust the leveling feet to ensure stability.

3. Electrical Connection

Connect the dryer to a dedicated, grounded electrical outlet that matches the voltage and current requirements specified on the appliance's rating label. Do not use extension cords or adapters.

Operating Instructions

1. Loading Laundry

Open the dryer door and load your laundry. Do not overload the dryer; ensure clothes can tumble freely. For best results, sort laundry by fabric type and drying requirements.

2. Program Selection

Turn the program selection dial to choose one of the 14 available drying programs. The display will show the estimated drying time. Consult the program guide in the full manual for detailed descriptions of each program.

3. Special Functions

- **UV Care:** Activate this function for enhanced sterilization of garments using UV light during the drying cycle. This helps eliminate bacteria and ensures thorough cleaning.

- **Light Ironing:** Select this option to reduce creasing and make ironing easier after the drying cycle.
- **Comfort Mode (Silence):** For ultra-quiet operation, activate Comfort Mode. This is ideal for running the dryer during night hours or in environments where noise reduction is critical.

- **Delay Start:** Use this function to set a delayed start time for your drying cycle, allowing your laundry to be ready when you need it.
- **My Fav:** After selecting your preferred program and options, use the My Fav function to save these settings for quick access in future cycles.

4. KidLock Function

To prevent accidental changes to the drying program by children, activate the KidLock function. Refer to the full manual for specific instructions on how to engage and disengage this safety feature.

Maintenance

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your dryer.

1. Cleaning the Lint Filter

Clean the lint filter after every drying cycle. Pull out the filter, remove accumulated lint, and rinse if necessary. A clogged lint filter reduces drying efficiency and can be a fire hazard.

2. Emptying the Water Tank

The heat pump dryer collects condensed water in a removable tank. Empty this tank after each cycle. If the tank is full, the dryer will pause operation.

3. Cleaning the Condenser

Periodically clean the condenser unit as instructed in the full manual. This typically involves removing the condenser

cover and gently cleaning any accumulated lint or debris.

4. Exterior Cleaning

Wipe the exterior surfaces of the dryer with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your dryer, refer to the following common solutions before contacting customer service:

- **Dryer not starting:** Check if the power cord is securely plugged in, the door is fully closed, and the program is selected.
- **Clothes not drying properly:** Ensure the lint filter is clean, the water tank is empty, and the load size is appropriate for the selected program.
- **Unusual noise:** Check for foreign objects in the drum or filter area. Ensure the dryer is level.
- **Error codes:** Consult the comprehensive troubleshooting section in the full user manual for specific error code meanings and solutions.




Image: The EU Energy Label for the Cecotec dryer, indicating its energy efficiency class C, annual energy consumption, capacity, noise level, and program duration.
