Introduction

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and effective use of your Deepsoon Electric Heating Pad, model TK-HP4020. Please read thoroughly before first use and retain for future reference. This product is designed to provide soothing heat therapy for various body areas.

Important Safety Information

WARNING: To reduce the risk of burns, electric shock, fire, and injury, this product must be used in accordance with the following instructions.

- Always unplug the heating pad when not in use.
- Ensure the heating pad is completely dry before use.
- Set the timer to automatically turn off after the desired time to prevent overheating.
- Do not use while sleeping.
- Do not fold, crease, or bunch the heating pad during use.
- Do not use on infants, children, or persons insensitive to heat.
- Do not use pins or other metallic objects to fasten the heating pad.
- Never pull the heating pad by the supply cord.

Indications: This heating pad is intended for temporary relief of minor muscle aches, joint stiffness, menstrual cramps, and localized discomfort. Consult a physician for persistent pain or any medical conditions.

Setup

Before first use, follow these steps to prepare your heating pad:

1. Carefully unpack the heating pad and controller from its packaging.
2. Inspect the pad and cord for any signs of damage. Do not use if damaged.
3. Ensure the heating pad and controller connection is secure and dry.
4. Plug the power cord into a standard 120V AC electrical outlet.

Operating Instructions

Follow these steps to operate your heating pad:

1. **Power On:** Plug the heating pad into a 120V AC electrical outlet. The controller will illuminate.

2. **Select Heat Setting:** Use the controller to choose one of the 6 available heat settings. The default setting is typically level 3. Adjust to your comfort level.
3. **Set Timer:** Use the timer button on the controller to select an automatic shut-off time (e.g., 30, 60, 90, 120 minutes). This feature enhances safety by preventing prolonged use.
4. **Moist Heat Option:** For moist heat therapy, lightly dampen the fabric of the heating pad with water using a spray bottle. Do not soak the pad.
5. **Power Off:** To turn off, press the power button on the controller or unplug the unit from the wall outlet.

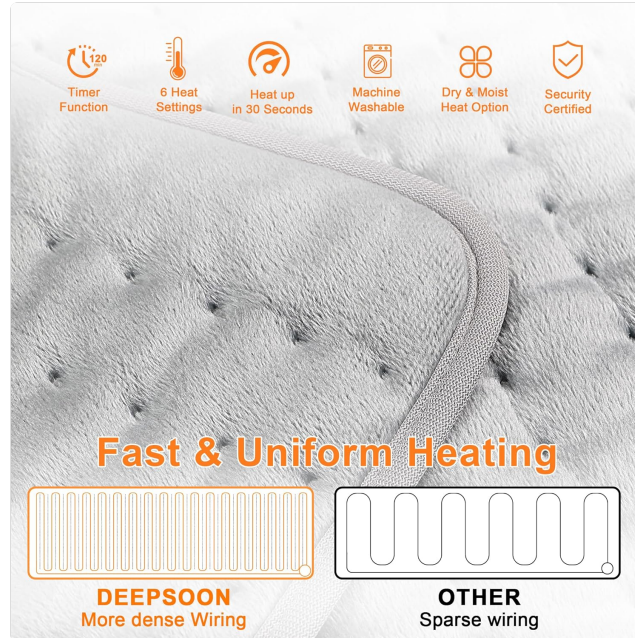


Image: Close-up of the heating pad's digital controller, displaying buttons for power, temperature adjustment (6 settings), and timer function (up to 120 minutes).

Maintenance and Cleaning

Proper care ensures the longevity and hygiene of your heating pad.

1. **Disconnect:** Always unplug the heating pad from the power outlet and detach the controller before

cleaning.

2. **Machine Wash:** The heating pad is machine washable. Wash on a gentle cycle with cold water (maximum 86°F/30°C).
3. **Drying:** Do not tumble dry. Hang to air dry naturally. Ensure the pad is completely dry before reassembling the unit and storing or using again.
4. **Do Not Iron:** Do not iron the heating pad.

Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Pad not heating:**
 - Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into both the pad and the wall outlet.
 - Check if the wall outlet is functional by plugging in another appliance.
 - Verify that a heat setting has been selected on the controller.
- **Pad heats unevenly:**
 - Ensure the pad is laid flat and not folded or bunched during use.
 - Allow a few minutes for the pad to reach its full temperature evenly.
- **Controller not responding:**
 - Unplug the unit from the wall outlet, wait a few minutes, then plug it back in.
 - Ensure the connection between the pad and the controller is secure.





Image: A visual representation of the heating pad's dimensions (40 inches by 20 inches) and the length of its power cord (75 inches).
