1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the HWWR Portable Bluetooth Karaoke Machine MS80. This device is designed to provide an immersive audio experience with powerful sound, dual wireless microphones, and dynamic lighting effects. 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Do not expose the device to water or excessive moisture.
- Avoid extreme temperatures.
- Do not attempt to disassemble or repair the unit yourself. Refer all servicing to qualified personnel.

- Use only the provided charging cable and power adapter.
- Ensure proper ventilation when operating the device.

4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The HWWR MS80 features a robust design with intuitive controls and multiple connectivity options. It includes a 6.8-inch subwoofer for deep bass and a full-frequency speaker for clear audio. The top panel integrates a slot for holding a phone or tablet.

SIMPLE OPERATION

With separate function buttons for easy setup

Control Panel Functions:

- **Microphone/Instrument Input (6.35mm):** Connect wired microphones or instruments.
- **Mic Vol:** Adjust microphone volume.
- **DC 5V Input:** Charging port.
- **USB Port:** For USB drive playback.
- **TF Card Slot:** For TF card playback.
- **Echo:** Adjust echo effect for microphones.
- **Power/Master Volume:** Power ON/OFF and main volume control.
- **AUX Input:** For external audio devices.
- **Mode/Loop Button:** Switch between input modes (Bluetooth, USB, TF, AUX) and control loop playback.
- **Prev/Next Buttons:** Navigate tracks.
- **Play/Pause Button:** Control media playback.
- **Priority Mic/Accompany Button:** Activates microphone priority or accompany mode.
- **REC Button:** Initiate recording (requires USB/TF storage).
- **LED Button:** Cycle through or turn off LED light modes.

5. SETUP

5.1 Charging the Karaoke Machine

1. Connect the provided Type-C charging cable to the DC 5V input port on the karaoke machine.
2. Connect the other end of the cable to a compatible USB power adapter (not included) or a USB port.
3. The charging indicator will illuminate. Allow approximately 4-6 hours for a full charge.
4. A full charge provides up to 24 hours of continuous playback.

5.2 Installing Microphone Batteries

Each wireless microphone requires 2 AA batteries (not included).

1. Unscrew the bottom part of the microphone handle.
2. Insert 2 AA batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
3. Screw the bottom part back on securely.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Power On/Off

Rotate the **Power/Master Volume** knob clockwise to turn on the machine. Rotate counter-clockwise until it clicks to turn off.

6.2 Bluetooth Connection

1. Turn on the karaoke machine. It will automatically enter Bluetooth pairing mode, indicated by a flashing 'BLUE' on the display.
2. On your device (smartphone, tablet, etc.), enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
3. Select "HWWR MS80" from the list.
4. Once connected, the 'BLUE' indicator will stop flashing, and a confirmation sound will play.

6.3 Microphone Usage

1. Turn on the wireless microphones by pressing the power button. They will automatically pair with the karaoke machine.
2. Adjust the microphone volume using the **Mic Vol** knob on the main unit.
3. Adjust the echo effect using the **Echo** knob.
4. The microphones feature an HD display for power and frequency, and built-in chips for excellent voice pickup and anti-whistle technology.

6.4 Media Playback (USB/TF Card/AUX)

1. Insert a USB drive or TF card into the respective slot. The machine will automatically switch to the corresponding mode and begin playback.
2. To use AUX input, connect an external audio device (e.g., MP3 player) to the AUX port using the

provided AUX cable. Press the **Mode/Loop** button to select AUX mode.

3. Use the **Prev**, **Next**, and **Play/Pause** buttons to control playback.

6.5 DJ Lights

Press the **LED** button to cycle through 6 dynamic colorful lighting effects or to turn them off. The lights sync to the music, enhancing the party atmosphere.

6.6 Special Functions

- **Mic Priority:** Press the **Priority Mic/Accompany** button to activate microphone priority. When active, music volume will automatically lower when you speak into the microphone.
- **Accompany Mode:** Press the **Priority Mic/Accompany** button again to switch to accompany mode, which can remove vocals from certain tracks.
- **Recording (REC):** With a USB drive or TF card inserted, press the **REC** button to start recording your performance. Press again to stop.
- **Connecting to TV:** The karaoke machine can connect to a TV via Bluetooth (if your TV supports it) or using an AUX cable. This allows you to display lyrics on the TV while audio plays through the karaoke machine.

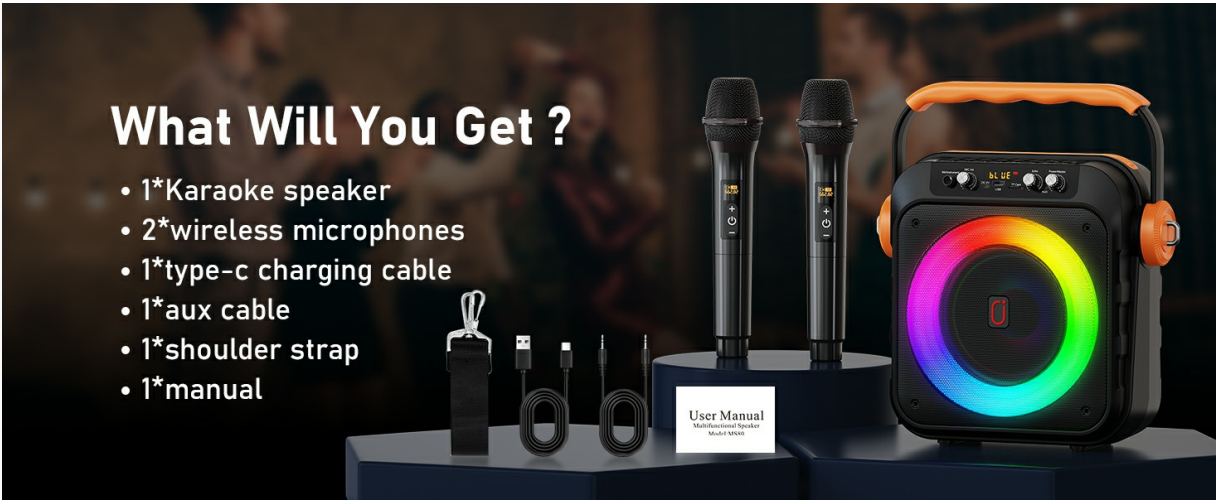


Image 6.5: Connecting the karaoke machine to a TV for lyric display.

7. MAINTENANCE

- Clean the device with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Store the karaoke machine in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- If not used for extended periods, charge the battery every 3 months to maintain its lifespan.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Battery depleted; Power switch off	Charge the unit; Turn the Power/Master Volume knob clockwise
No sound	Volume too low; Incorrect mode selected; Device not connected	Increase Master Volume; Press Mode/Loop to select correct input; Reconnect Bluetooth/AUX
Microphone not working	Microphone batteries low/dead; Microphone not paired; Mic Vol too low	Replace AA batteries; Power cycle microphone; Increase Mic Vol knob
Bluetooth disconnection	Device out of range; Interference	Move device closer to karaoke machine; Avoid obstacles or other wireless devices






Image 9.1: Internal speaker components and audio technology.
