INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your VIZIO 75 Inch V-Series 4K UHD HDR Smart TV. Please read these instructions carefully before using your television and retain them for future reference.

SETUP

1. Unpacking and Included Components

Carefully remove the TV from its packaging. Ensure all components are present:

- VIZIO 75 Inch V-Series 4K UHD HDR Smart TV
- Remote Control
- Power Cable
- TV Stand (2 pieces)

2. Stand Installation

If placing the TV on a table or entertainment center, attach the included stands:

1. Place the TV screen-down on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.
2. Align each stand with the corresponding slots on the bottom of the TV.
3. Secure each stand using the provided screws.

3. Wall Mounting (Optional)

For wall mounting, use a VESA-compatible wall mount kit (sold separately). This TV supports a VESA Mount Standard of 400 x 300 mm. Consult your wall mount kit's instructions for proper installation.

4. Connecting Devices

Connect your external devices to the appropriate ports on the TV. The TV features multiple HDMI ports, a USB port, and an optical audio output.

- **HDMI Ports:** Connect Blu-ray players, gaming consoles, cable boxes, etc. This model has 3 HDMI ports, with HDMI 1 supporting eARC for enhanced audio return.
- **USB Port:** Connect USB storage devices for media playback.
- **Antenna Input:** Connect an antenna for over-the-air broadcasts.
- **Optical Audio Out:** Connect to a soundbar or audio receiver for digital audio.

5. Power Connection

Once all devices are connected, plug the power cable into the TV's power input and then into a wall outlet.

OPERATING YOUR TV

1. Initial Setup and SmartCast

Upon first power-on, the TV will guide you through an initial setup process. This includes connecting to your Wi-Fi network (supporting WiFi 6 dual-band for faster streaming) and setting up VIZIO SmartCast. SmartCast provides access to a wide range of streaming apps and content.

2. Basic Controls

Use the included remote control to navigate the TV. Common functions include:

- **Power:** Turn the TV on/off.

- **Input:** Select connected devices (HDMI 1, HDMI 2, etc.).
- **Volume:** Adjust audio levels.
- **Navigation:** Use arrow keys and the OK button to browse menus and content.

3. Smart TV Features

Your VIZIO Smart TV offers integrated access to popular streaming services and an App Store. Navigate through the SmartCast home screen to find and launch applications like Netflix, YouTube, Fubo, and Apple TV. The TV operates on an Android operating system.

4. Picture Settings

Optimize your viewing experience with advanced picture technologies:

- **4K UHD Resolution:** Enjoy incredibly sharp and detailed images.
- **Dolby Vision HDR10+, HLG:** Experience enhanced contrast, brightness, and color with High Dynamic Range content.
- **DLED Backlighting:** Provides uniform brightness across the screen.
- **Active Pixel Tuning:** Fine-tunes picture quality for optimal performance.

5. Audio Settings

The TV features DTS Virtual X technology for an immersive 3D surround sound experience. Adjust audio modes and settings through the TV's menu to suit your preferences.

6. Gaming Features

For gamers, the TV includes features designed to reduce lag and provide smoother gameplay:

- **Auto Low Latency Mode (ALLM):** Automatically switches to a low-latency mode when a gaming console is detected.
- **Variable Refresh Rate (VRR):** Synchronizes the TV's refresh rate with the game console's output for tear-free gaming.

Connect Bluetooth-compatible devices, such as headphones or soundbars, for private listening or enhanced audio. Access Bluetooth pairing options in the TV's settings menu.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning Your TV

To clean the screen, gently wipe it with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth. For stubborn marks, slightly dampen the cloth with water. Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or alcohol-based solutions, as these can damage the screen. Clean the TV's exterior with a soft, dry cloth.

Software Updates

Your VIZIO Smart TV may receive automatic software updates to improve performance and add new features. Ensure your TV is connected to the internet to receive these updates.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your TV, refer to the following common solutions:

- **No Power:** Ensure the power cable is securely connected to both the TV and the wall outlet. Try a different outlet.
- **No Picture/Sound:** Verify the correct input source is selected. Check all cable connections (HDMI, antenna). Restart connected devices.
- **Poor Picture Quality:** Check the source resolution. Adjust picture settings (brightness, contrast, color). Ensure HDR content is being played from a compatible source.
- **No Internet Connection:** Check your Wi-Fi router and modem. Reconnect the TV to your Wi-Fi network through the settings menu.
- **Remote Not Working:** Replace the remote control batteries. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV's IR sensor.
