1. Introduction

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your DOMO DO1122FR 4L Hot Air Fryer. This appliance uses hot air circulation to cook food, offering a healthier alternative to traditional deep frying with up to 80% less fat. Please read these instructions carefully before first use and retain them for future reference.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Always ensure the appliance is placed on a stable, heat-resistant surface, away from walls or other appliances to allow adequate air circulation.
- Do not immerse the appliance, cord, or plug in water or any other liquid.
- · Keep the appliance out of reach of children.
- Do not block the air inlet or outlet openings during operation.
- Unplug the appliance from the power outlet when not in use and before cleaning.
- Do not operate the appliance if the cord or plug is damaged, or if the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- The exterior surfaces may become hot during use. Use oven mitts when handling hot components. The cool-touch handle is designed for safe handling of the basket.
- This appliance is equipped with overheat protection. If the internal temperature exceeds a safe limit, the appliance will automatically shut off.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the components of your DOMO DO1122FR Hot Air Fryer:

- 1. Main Unit
- 2. Control Panel with Touch Screen
- 3. Frying Basket (with non-stick coating)
- 4. Basket Handle (cool-touch)

- 5. Air Inlet
- 6. Air Outlet Vents
- 7. Power Cord

4. SETUP

- 1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all packaging materials and stickers from the appliance.
- 2. Initial Cleaning: Wipe the exterior of the appliance with a damp cloth. Wash the frying basket and pan with hot

- water, dish soap, and a non-abrasive sponge. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely.
- 3. **Placement:** Place the air fryer on a stable, level, and heat-resistant surface. Ensure there is at least 10 cm (4 inches) of free space around the back and sides of the appliance for proper ventilation.
- 4. **First Use:** It is recommended to run the air fryer empty for about 10-15 minutes at 180°C (356°F) before first use to eliminate any manufacturing odors. A slight smell or smoke may occur, which is normal. Ensure good ventilation during this process.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Control Panel Overview

The DOMO DO1122FR features an intuitive touch screen control panel for easy operation:

• Power Button: Turns the appliance on/off.

- Pre-set Program Icons: Select from 6 pre-programmed cooking modes (e.g., fries, chicken, meat).
- Temperature Control (+/-): Adjust cooking temperature from 80°C to 220°C.
- Time Control (+/-): Adjust cooking time (up to 60 minutes).
- Start/Stop Button: Initiates or pauses the cooking process.
- Shake Reminder: An icon may illuminate to remind you to shake the basket for even cooking.
- Interior Light: Allows you to monitor cooking progress without opening the basket.

5.2 General Operation Steps

- 1. **Prepare Food:** Place your ingredients into the frying basket. Do not overfill the basket to ensure proper air circulation.
- 2. Insert Basket: Slide the frying basket firmly back into the main unit.
- 3. Power On: Plug the appliance into a grounded wall outlet. The display will light up.
- 4. Set Time and Temperature:
 - Manual Setting: Use the Temperature (+/-) and Time (+/-) buttons to set your desired cooking parameters.
 - Pre-set Program: Select one of the 6 pre-set program icons. The appliance will automatically set the
 recommended time and temperature for that food type. You can adjust these settings manually if needed.
- 5. Start Cooking: Press the Start/Stop button to begin the cooking process. The fan and heating element will activate.
- 6. Monitor Cooking: Use the interior light to check on your food without interrupting the cooking cycle.
- 7. **Shake Reminder:** For some foods, the appliance may beep and display a "SHAKE" icon to remind you to shake the basket for even cooking. Carefully pull out the basket, shake the contents, and reinsert it. The cooking will resume automatically.
- 8. End of Cooking: The appliance will beep when the set cooking time has elapsed and automatically shut off.
- 9. **Remove Food:** Carefully pull out the basket using the cool-touch handle. Place the basket on a heat-resistant surface. Empty the cooked food into a serving dish.
- 10. Cool Down: Allow the appliance to cool down completely before cleaning or storing.

6. Cooking Programs

The DOMO DO1122FR offers 6 pre-set programs for common dishes. These programs provide recommended time and temperature settings, which can be adjusted manually.

- Fries: Ideal for crispy French fries and potato wedges.
- Chicken: Suitable for chicken pieces, wings, or small whole chickens.
- Meat: For various cuts of meat, such as steaks or pork chops.
- Fish: Perfect for cooking fish fillets or smaller whole fish.
- Quiche/Cake: For baking small quiches, muffins, or cakes.
- Snacks: For quick preparation of snacks like spring rolls, chicken nuggets, or onion rings.

7. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your air fryer.

- 1. Before Cleaning: Always unplug the appliance and allow it to cool down completely before cleaning.
- 2. **Frying Basket and Pan:** The non-stick frying basket and pan are dishwasher safe, but hand washing with hot water, dish soap, and a non-abrasive sponge is recommended to preserve the non-stick coating. Do not use metal utensils or abrasive cleaning materials.
- 3. Interior: Wipe the interior with a damp cloth. For stubborn food residues, a soft brush can be used after soaking.
- 4. **Exterior:** Wipe the exterior of the appliance with a damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- 5. Storage: Ensure all parts are clean and dry before storing the appliance in a cool, dry place.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your air fryer, consult the following table before contacting support.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Appliance does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outlet malfunction.	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working outlet.
Food not cooked evenly.	Basket overloaded; food not shaken.	Do not overload the basket. Shake the basket halfway through cooking.
White smoke coming from appliance.	Grease residue from previous use; fatty food.	Clean the basket and pan thoroughly after each use. For fatty foods, ensure excess oil is drained.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Food not crispy.	Too much moisture; insufficient cooking time/temperature.	Pat food dry before cooking. Increase cooking time or temperature slightly.


