1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Aheaplus Closet System. This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly, configuration, use, and maintenance of your new 86.8-inch L-shaped closet organizer. Designed for versatility and durability, this system includes three sets with six drawers and four hanging rods to help you organize your space efficiently. Please read this manual thoroughly before beginning assembly or use to ensure proper installation and long-term satisfaction.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Anti-Tipping Accessories:** Always install the provided anti-tip kits to secure the closet system to the wall. This is crucial to prevent accidental tipping, especially in households with children or pets.
- **Load Capacity:** The closet system is designed for significant weight. The overall load capacity is up to 2000 lbs. Each single hanging rod can support up to 100 lbs. Do not exceed these limits to ensure stability and prevent damage.
- **Assembly Caution:** The system is constructed from premium wood board. During assembly, exercise care when tightening screws and cam locks. Overtightening can damage the material. Hand-tighten all fasteners to a snug fit.
- **Two-Person Assembly:** For safety and ease of assembly, it is highly recommended that two people install this closet system.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

- Installation Hardware Kit (screws, cam locks, dowels, anti-tip kits, small screwdriver)

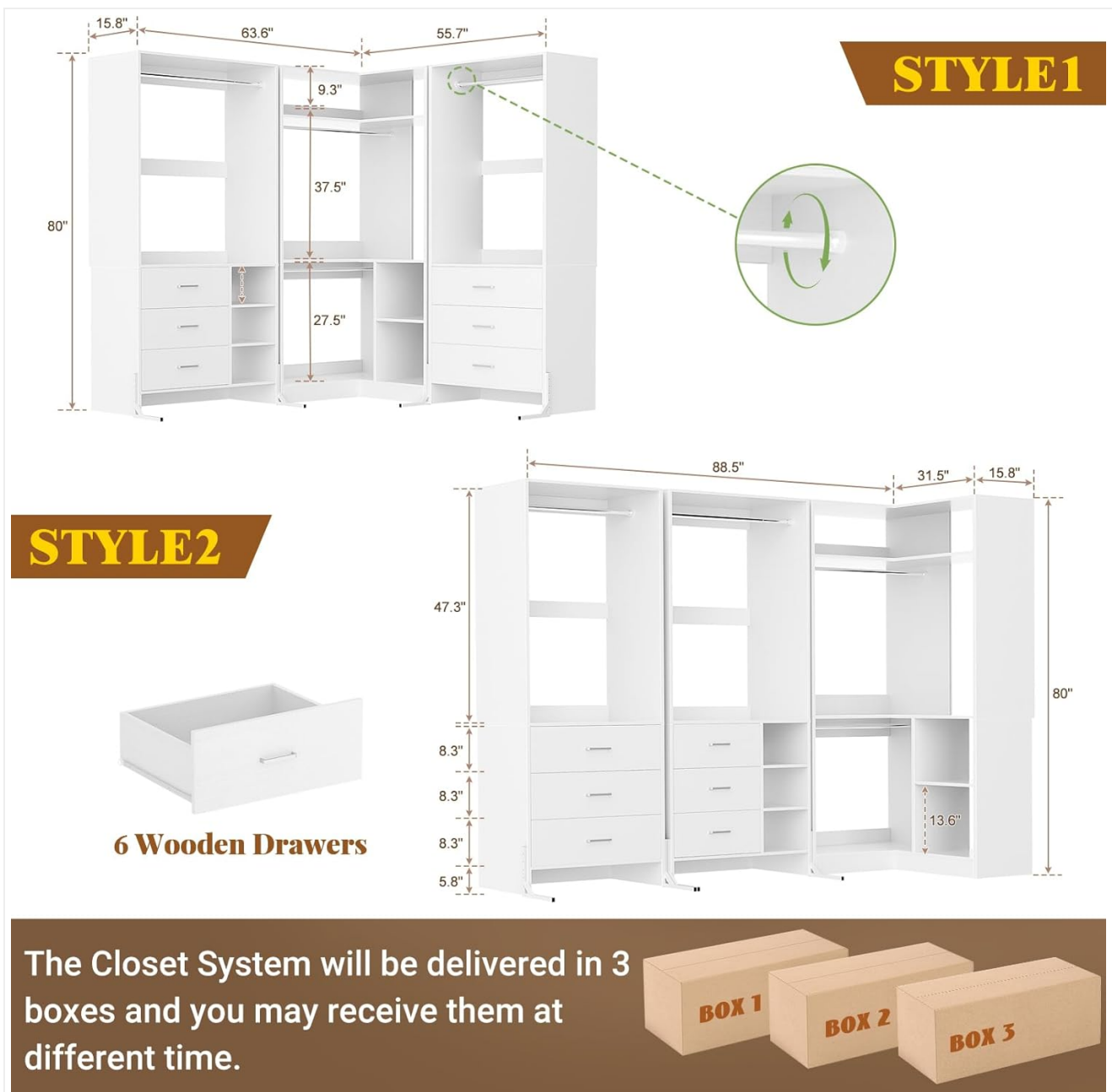

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly of the Aheaplus Closet System requires attention to detail. All necessary hardware and tools are included, and each part is clearly labeled to facilitate the process. We recommend having two people for installation.

Preparation:

1. Unpack all boxes and carefully lay out all components on a clean, soft surface to prevent scratches.
2. Identify all parts and hardware using the provided parts list in your physical manual.
3. Ensure you have sufficient space for assembly.

General Assembly Steps:

1. Follow the step-by-step diagrams and instructions provided in the physical assembly manual.
2. Pay close attention to the orientation of panels and the alignment of pre-drilled holes. Incorrect alignment may require disassembly and reassembly.

3. Insert dowels and screws into their designated holes.
4. Connect panels using cam locks. Turn cam locks clockwise until snug. Avoid overtightening to prevent damage to the wood board material.
5. Assemble drawers according to the specific instructions for drawer components. Ensure drawer bottoms are properly seated.
6. Install hanging rods securely into the designated supports.
7. Once the main structure is assembled, attach the anti-tip kits to the top rear of the unit and secure them to a wall stud using appropriate hardware.

5. CONFIGURATION OPTIONS

The Aheaplus Closet System is designed for flexibility, allowing you to arrange it freely to suit your space and storage needs. It can be configured as a single multi-function unit or as three separate closet organizers.

- **L-Shaped Configuration:** The standard L-shaped setup for this model measures approximately 86.8 inches (L) x 31.5 inches (W) x 80 inches (H).
- **Reversible Design:** The system offers various installation options, allowing you to customize the layout to fit your room's dimensions and personal preferences.
- **Expandability:** For larger spaces or different configurations (e.g., U-shaped walk-in wardrobe), additional Aheaplus series items can be purchased separately from the Aheaplus store and combined with your existing system.

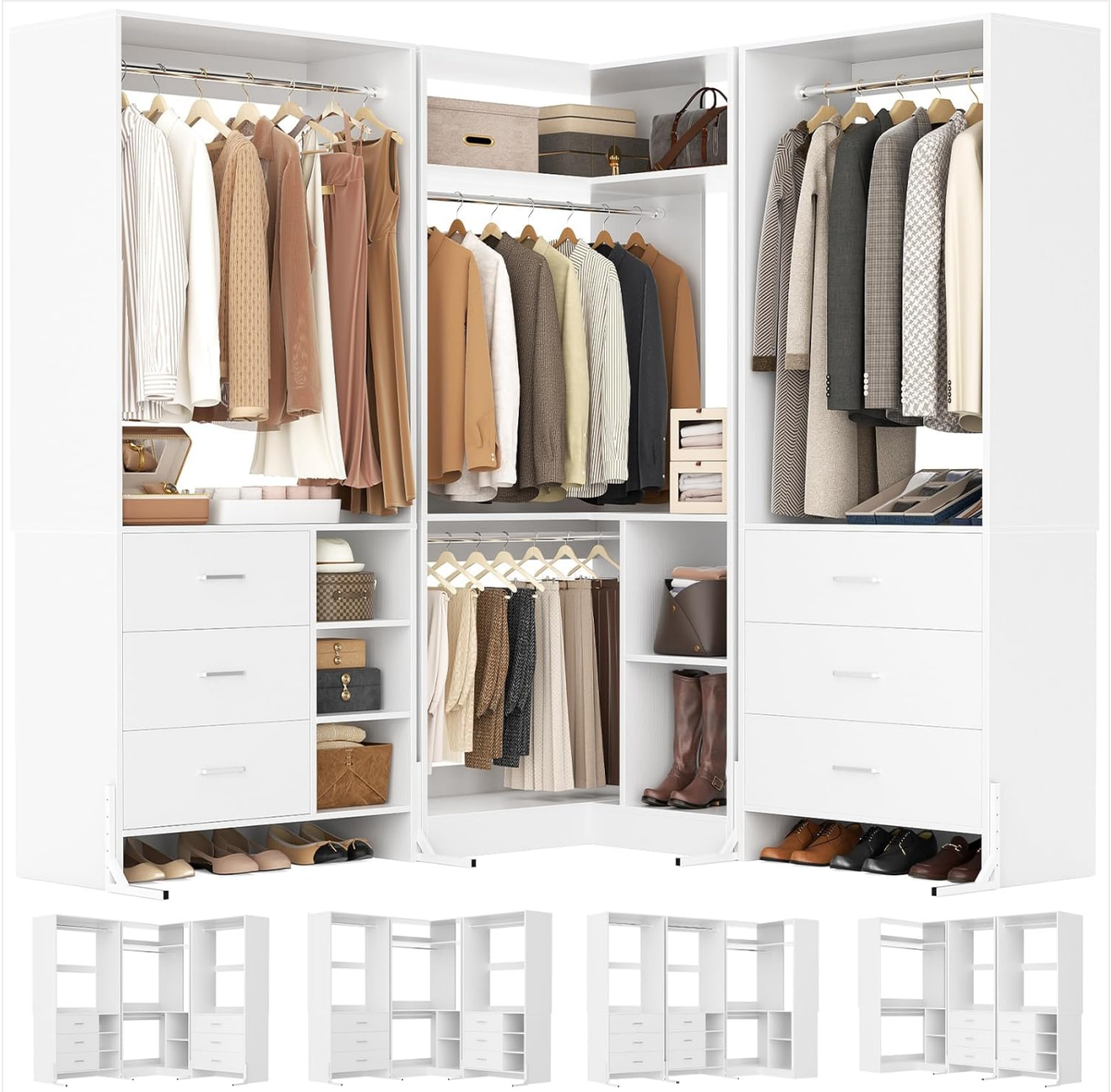
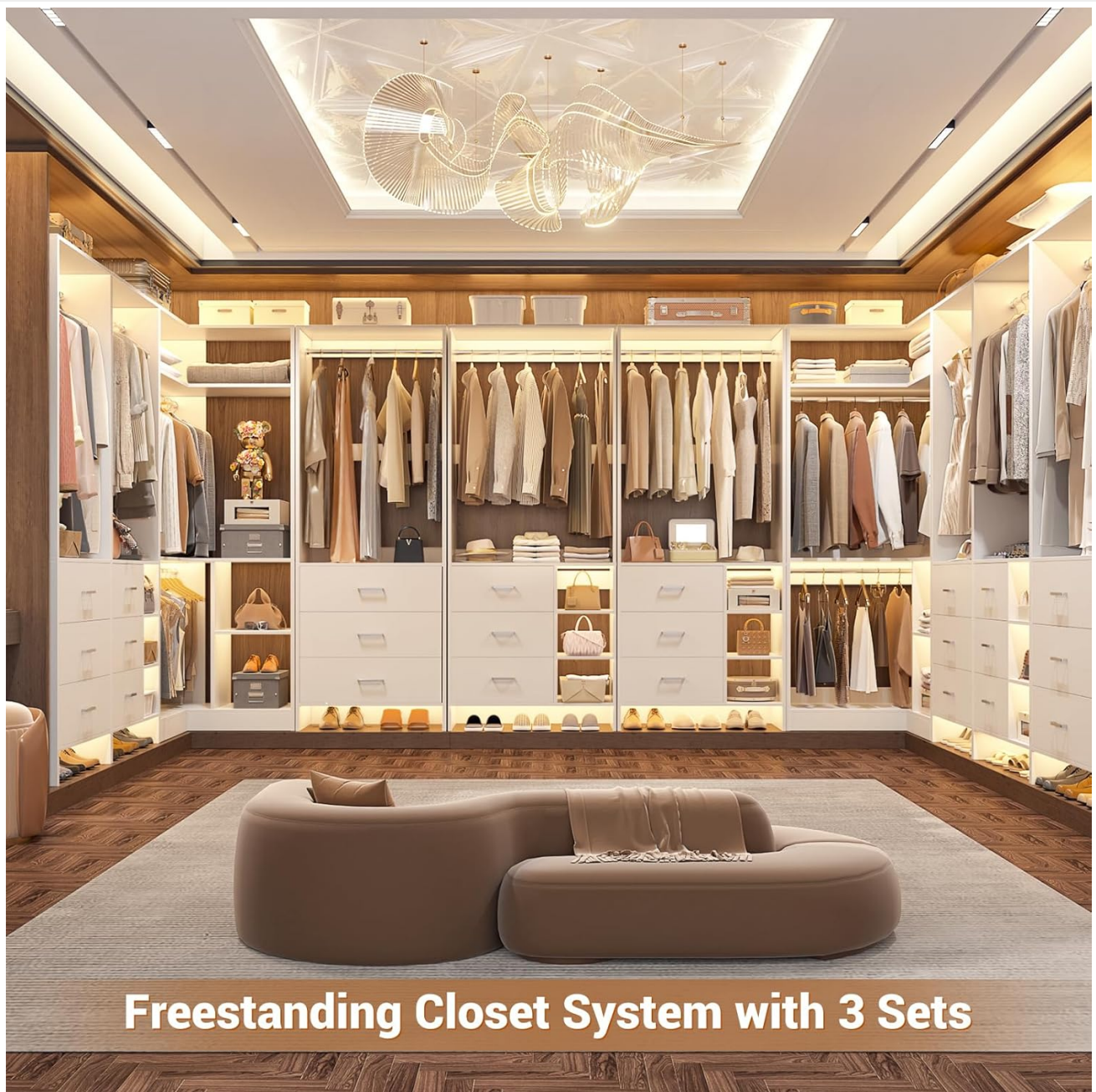

- **Dusting:** Regularly dust all surfaces with a dry, soft cloth to prevent buildup.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically check all screws, cam locks, and connections to ensure they remain tight. Retighten if necessary, but avoid overtightening.
- **Weight Distribution:** Distribute weight evenly across shelves and hanging rods to prevent stress on the structure.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Aheaplus Closet System, please refer to the following common solutions:

- **Missing or Damaged Parts:** If you find any parts missing or damaged upon delivery or during assembly, please contact Aheaplus customer service immediately. Do not attempt to force damaged parts into place.
- **Wobbling Unit:** Ensure all connections are securely tightened. Verify that the anti-tip kits are properly installed and anchored to a wall stud. Uneven flooring can also cause wobbling; consider using shims if necessary.
- **Drawers Not Sliding Smoothly:** Check that the drawer slides are correctly installed and aligned. Ensure no objects are obstructing the drawer's path. Avoid overloading drawers beyond their capacity.
- **Difficulty with Assembly:** Review the assembly manual carefully, paying close attention to diagrams and part labels. If you are still having difficulty, consider seeking assistance from a second person or contacting customer support.
