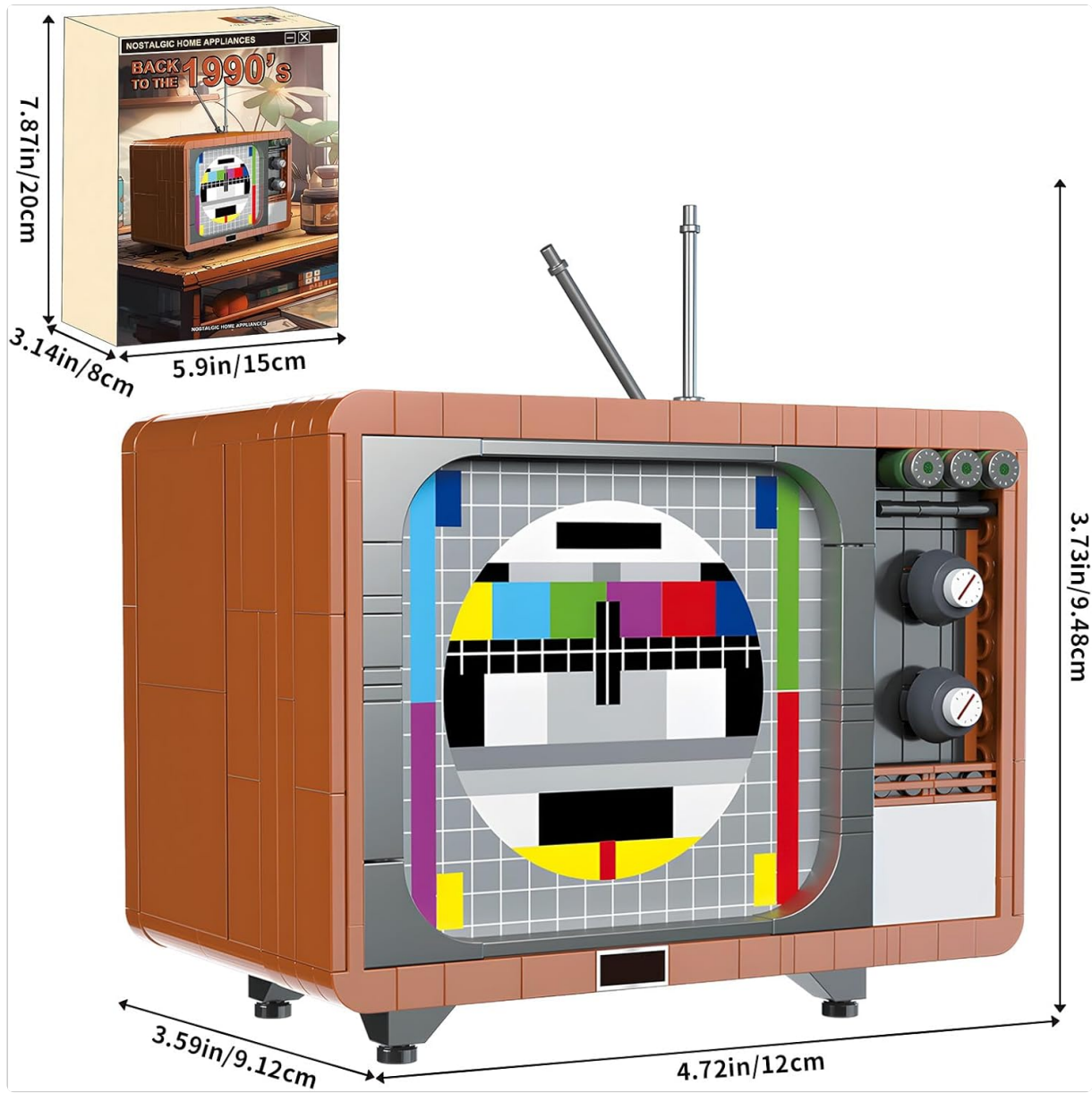
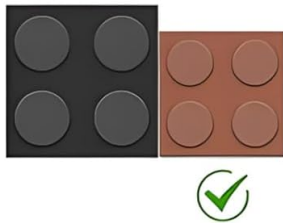


Image: Detailed dimensions of the Retro TV Mini Building Block Set, showing height, width, and depth.

Normal Block

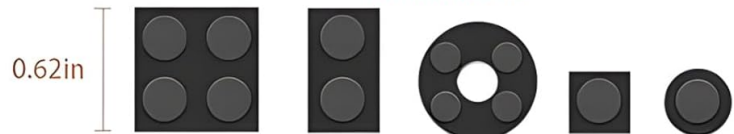


Image: A visual comparison illustrating the size difference between mini blocks and standard building blocks.

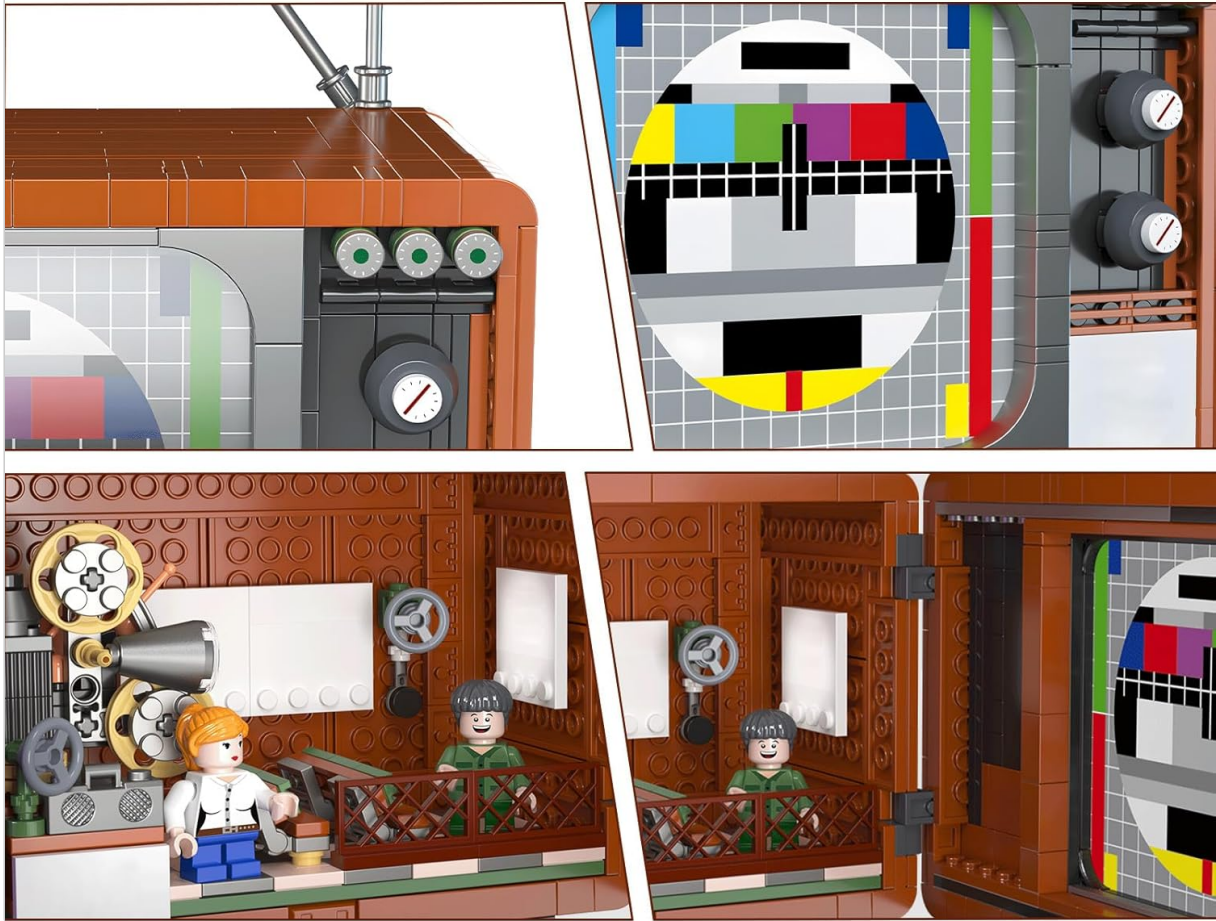


Image: Close-up views highlighting intricate details and internal structures of the Retro TV model.
