1. Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the WATUDOU Remote Control Shark Toy. This manual provides essential information for the safe and optimal use of your new product. Please read it thoroughly before operation and retain it for future reference.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

- 1 x Remote Control Shark Toy
- 1 x 2.4GHz Remote Control
- 2 x Rechargeable Batteries for Shark
- 1 x USB Charging Cable
- 2 x Spare Propellers
- 1 x Small Screwdriver
- 1 x Instruction Manual (this document)

3. SETUP

3.1 Installing Batteries (Shark)

- 1. Locate the battery compartment on the underside of the shark.
- 2. Use the provided screwdriver to loosen the screws on the battery compartment cover.
- 3. Carefully open the cover.
- 4. Connect one rechargeable battery to the shark's battery connector.
- 5. Place the battery inside the compartment and close the cover.
- 6. Secure the cover with the screws using the screwdriver.

3.2 Installing Batteries (Remote Control)

- 1. Locate the battery compartment on the back of the remote control.
- 2. Open the battery cover.
- 3. Insert 2 x 1.5V AA batteries (not included), ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
- 4. Close the battery cover.

3.3 Charging the Shark Battery

Use the provided USB charging cable to charge the shark's rechargeable batteries. Connect the battery to the charging cable, then plug the USB end into a compatible USB power source (e.g., computer, power bank, USB adapter). The indicator light on the charger will show charging status. A full charge typically takes approximately 60 minutes and provides about 25 minutes of play time per battery.




Image 3.3: USB charging cable connected to the shark's rechargeable battery.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The remote control shark is designed for water use only. Ensure the shark is placed in water before attempting to operate it.

4.1 Remote Control Functions

- Power Button: Turns the remote control ON/OFF.
- Left Joystick: Controls forward and backward movement.
- Right Joystick: Controls left and right turns.
- Spray Water Button: Activates the water spray function.
- Light Button: Toggles the shark's indicator light.
- One-Key Demo Button: Initiates an automatic demonstration sequence.

4.2 Basic Movement

Once the shark is in water and the remote control is powered on, you can control its movement:

- Forward: Push the left joystick forward.
- Backward: Pull the left joystick backward.
- Turn Left: Push the right joystick left.
- Turn Right: Push the right joystick right.

4.3 Special Features

- Water Spray Function: Press the 'Spray Water' button on the remote to activate the shark's water spray feature, adding an interactive element to play.
- Indicator Light: The shark is equipped with an indicator light for enhanced visibility, especially in low-light conditions. Use the 'Light' button to control it.
- One-Key Demo: For an automatic display of the shark's movements, press the 'One-Key Demo' button.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 After Use

- Always remove the shark from water after use.
- Gently wipe the shark and remote control with a dry cloth to remove any moisture.
- Ensure the battery compartment of the shark is dry before closing it.

 Remove batteries from both the shark and the remote control if storing for an extended period to prevent leakage.

5.2 Storage

- Store the toy in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Keep out of reach of small children when not in use.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues, please refer to the following table:

Problem	Possible Solution
Shark does not move in water.	Ensure the shark's battery is fully charged and correctly installed. Verify the remote control batteries are fresh and correctly inserted. Make sure the shark is fully submerged in water for the propellers to engage.
Remote control not responding.	Check remote control battery levels and replace if necessary. Ensure the remote control is within the operating range (up to 110 feet). Re-pair the remote with the shark if connection is lost (refer to pairing instructions in the full manual if available).
Water spray function not working.	Check if the shark is sufficiently submerged in water. Ensure the water intake for the spray function is not blocked.
Short play time.	Ensure batteries are fully charged. Consider using the second provided rechargeable battery for extended play.




Image 7.1: Dimensions of the WATUDOU Remote Control Shark Toy.
