INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Yaheetech Kitchen Island Cart. This versatile cart is designed to enhance your kitchen space with additional storage, a convenient power outlet, and mobility. Please read this manual thoroughly before assembly and use to ensure safe and optimal performance.

SAFETY INFORMATION

To prevent injury or damage, please adhere to the following safety guidelines:

- Do not stand or sit on the item.
- Do not exceed the weight capacity of 317 pounds.
- Ensure all parts are properly secured before use.
- Do not allow children to play on, with, or around the cart.
- Always unplug the power cord from the wall outlet before cleaning or moving the cart.

SETUP & ASSEMBLY

Assembly is required for this kitchen island cart. For detailed, step-by-step instructions, please refer to the official Installation Manual (PDF) provided by Yaheetech. A general overview of the assembly process includes:

1. Unpack all components and verify against the parts list in the manual.
2. Assemble the metal frame structure.
3. Attach the three tiered shelves to the frame.
4. Install the power outlet unit onto the designated section of the cart.
5. Attach the wine glass holder and S-hooks.
6. Choose to install either the footpads for stationary use or the wheels for mobility. Ensure locking wheels are engaged when stationary.

FEATURES & OPERATION

Power Outlet

The cart features a built-in power outlet with two AC outlets and a master switch for convenient power access. The power cord is 6.5 feet long, providing flexibility in placement. Use this to power small kitchen appliances directly on the cart's countertop.

Storage Capacity

This 3-tier cart offers ample storage space for various kitchen items. The top surface provides a spacious work area, while the two lower shelves can accommodate appliances, cookware, and other essentials. The cart also includes:

- Integrated wine glass holder for convenient storage of stemware.
- 8 S-hooks for hanging mugs, utensils, or towels.

Mobility & Stability

The cart is designed for both mobility and stability. It comes with options for either fixed footpads or lockable wheels. The wheels allow for easy repositioning of the cart within your kitchen or dining area. When stationary, engage the wheel locks to ensure the cart remains securely in place.

MAINTENANCE

To maintain the appearance and longevity of your Yaheetech Kitchen Island Cart:

- Wipe surfaces regularly with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners.
- For spills, clean immediately to prevent staining, especially on the engineered wood surfaces.
- Periodically check all screws and connections to ensure they remain tight.
- Keep the power outlet area dry and free from debris.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your kitchen island cart, consider the following:

- **Stability Issues:** Ensure all assembly screws are tightened. If using wheels, verify that the locking mechanisms are engaged when the cart needs to be stationary. If using footpads, ensure they are level on the floor.

- **Power Outlet Not Working:** Check if the master switch on the power outlet is in the 'ON' position. Ensure the cart's power cord is securely plugged into a functional wall outlet. If issues persist, consult a qualified electrician.
- **Overloading:** Remember the maximum weight capacity is 317 pounds. Distribute weight evenly across the shelves to prevent strain on the structure.
