SETUP GUIDE

1. Unpacking and Placement

Carefully remove the sewing machine from its packaging. Place the machine on a stable, flat surface with adequate lighting. Ensure there is enough space around the machine for comfortable operation and fabric handling.

2. Power Connection


Connect the power cord to the machine's power input and then plug it into a suitable electrical outlet. Connect the foot pedal to its designated port on the machine. The machine is equipped with an on/off switch, typically located near the power input.

3. Winding the Bobbin

Place a spool of thread on the spool pin. Follow the winding path indicated on the machine to guide the thread to the bobbin winder. Place an empty bobbin onto the bobbin winder spindle and push it to the right. Start the machine using the foot pedal; the bobbin will wind automatically. Stop when the bobbin is full and trim the thread.

4. Threading the Machine

Raise the presser foot and the needle to their highest positions. Place a spool of thread on the main spool pin. Follow the numbered threading guides on the machine, ensuring the thread passes through all tension discs and take-up lever correctly. Use the automatic needle threader for convenience, or manually thread the needle from front to back. Pull approximately 6 inches of thread through the needle eye.



The built-in needle threader simplifies the threading process.

5. Inserting the Bobbin

Open the bobbin cover plate. Insert the wound bobbin into the bobbin case, ensuring the thread unwinds in the correct direction (usually counter-clockwise). Guide the bobbin thread through the tension spring and into the thread guide.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Selecting a Stitch


Turn the Stitch Selector Dial to choose your desired stitch pattern. The machine offers a variety of utility, decorative, and stretch stitches. Refer to the stitch chart on the machine for visual guidance.

2. Adjusting Stitch Length and Width

Use the Stitch Length Dial to adjust the length of your stitches. A higher number indicates a longer stitch. For certain stitches, the Stitch Width Dial can be used to adjust the width of the stitch pattern.

3. Sewing

Place your fabric under the presser foot, aligning the edge with the desired seam allowance guide on the needle plate. Lower the presser foot lever. Gently press the foot pedal to start sewing. Control your sewing speed by varying the pressure on the foot pedal. To reverse stitch and secure seams, press and hold the reverse lever.

4. Finishing a Seam

When you reach the end of your seam, press the reverse lever to backstitch a few stitches to secure the seam. Raise the needle to its highest position and lift the presser foot. Pull the fabric away from the machine, guiding the threads to the thread cutter located on the side of the machine.

MAINTENANCE

1. Cleaning

Regularly clean your sewing machine to ensure optimal performance. Turn off and unplug the machine before cleaning. Remove the needle plate and bobbin case. Use the included lint brush to remove lint and dust from the bobbin area and feed dogs. Do not use compressed air, as it can push lint further into the machine.

2. Needle Replacement

Replace the needle frequently, especially after every 8-10 hours of sewing or when working with new fabric types. A dull or bent needle can cause skipped stitches, thread breakage, or damage to your fabric. Use only SINGER-approved needles appropriate for your fabric type.

3. Lubrication

Your SINGER Heavy Duty 4423 sewing machine is designed to require minimal lubrication. Refer to the full user manual for specific lubrication points and recommended frequency, if any. Over-lubrication can attract lint and dust.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your sewing machine, consult the following common troubleshooting tips. For detailed solutions, always refer to the comprehensive user manual.

- **Skipped Stitches:** Ensure the needle is inserted correctly and is not bent or dull. Check that the machine is threaded properly, including the bobbin. Use the correct needle type and size for your fabric.
- Thread Breaking: Verify that the machine is threaded correctly and the thread tension is appropriate for your fabric. Check for burrs on the needle plate or bobbin case. Ensure you are using good quality thread.
- **Uneven Stitches:** Adjust the thread tension dials. Ensure the bobbin is wound evenly and inserted correctly. Check that the presser foot pressure is set appropriately for your fabric.
- Machine Not Feeding Fabric: Ensure the presser foot is lowered. Check if the feed dogs are engaged (not dropped for free-motion sewing). Clean any lint from the feed dog area.
