Thomas Earnshaw Analog Blue Dial Men's Watch ES-8306-01 User Manual

This manual provides instructions for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your Thomas Earnshaw ES-8306-01 watch.

INTRODUCTION

The Thomas Earnshaw ES-8306-01 is an automatic mechanical watch featuring a blue dial, dual time zones, and a power reserve indicator. This timepiece is designed for precision and elegance.

Please read this manual carefully to ensure correct usage and to maximize the lifespan of your watch.

WATCH COMPONENTS

Familiarize yourself with the main components of your watch.

- **Crown:** Used for winding the movement and setting the time.
- **Main Dial:** Displays the primary time.
- **Sub-dials (Zone 1 & Zone 2):** Display secondary time zones.
- **Power Reserve Indicator:** Shows the remaining power in the mainspring.
- **Case Back:** Transparent case back revealing the automatic movement.

SETUP AND INITIAL OPERATION

1. Winding the Watch

Your Thomas Earnshaw ES-8306-01 is an automatic mechanical watch. It is powered by the motion of your wrist. However, for initial setup or after a period of inactivity, manual winding is recommended.

1. Ensure the crown is in position 1 (fully pushed in).
2. Turn the crown clockwise approximately 30-40 times. This will build up a sufficient power reserve to start the watch.
3. The power reserve indicator on the dial will show the winding progress.

2. Setting the Time

1. Gently pull the crown out to position 2.
2. Turn the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise to set the desired time for the main dial.
3. Once the time is set, push the crown back into position 1.

3. Setting Dual Time Zones (Zone 1 & Zone 2)

The two sub-dials allow for tracking additional time zones.

1. To set Zone 1, locate the small recessed button on the left side of the watch case. Use a small, non-sharp tool (like a toothpick) to press this button. Each press advances the hour hand of Zone 1 by one hour.
2. To set Zone 2, locate the small recessed button on the right side of the watch case (opposite the crown). Press this button to advance the hour hand of Zone 2 by one hour.
3. Ensure the main time is set correctly before adjusting the sub-dials.

OPERATING YOUR WATCH

Automatic Movement

The watch is powered by an automatic mechanical movement. This means it winds itself through the natural motion of your arm. When worn daily for at least 8-10 hours, it should maintain its power reserve.

Power Reserve Indicator

The indicator at the top of the dial shows the remaining power. "F" indicates full power, and "E" indicates empty. When the indicator is near "E", manually wind the watch or wear it to replenish the power reserve.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Water Resistance

This watch has a water resistance rating of 5 ATM (50 meters). This means it is suitable for everyday use, such as accidental splashes, rain, and showering. It is **not** suitable for swimming, diving, or prolonged water immersion.

- Do not operate the crown or pushers when the watch is wet.
- Ensure the crown is fully pushed in before any contact with water.

Cleaning

To clean your watch, wipe the case and crystal with a soft, dry cloth. For the leather strap, use a slightly damp cloth and allow it to air dry. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

Storage

When not wearing the watch for extended periods, store it in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and strong magnetic fields. A watch winder can be used to keep the automatic movement running and

maintain time accuracy.

Leather Strap Care

The leather strap is susceptible to wear and tear. Avoid prolonged exposure to water, sweat, and direct sunlight to preserve its quality and appearance.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Watch Stops Running

- **Cause:** Insufficient power reserve.
- **Solution:** Manually wind the watch by turning the crown clockwise 30-40 times, or wear it consistently for 8-10 hours.

Time is Inaccurate

- **Cause:** Watch not fully wound, exposure to strong magnetic fields, or requiring service.
- **Solution:** Ensure the watch is fully wound. If exposed to magnetic fields, demagnetization may be required by a professional. If issues persist, contact customer support.

Water Condensation Inside Crystal

- **Cause:** Exposure to extreme temperature changes or compromised water resistance.
- **Solution:** Immediately take the watch to an authorized service center. Do not attempt to open the watch yourself.


