1. INTRODUCTION

This user manual provides comprehensive instructions for the Lenovo IdeaCentre AIO 24IRH9 All-in-One Desktop. It is designed to assist users with the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of their device. Please read this manual thoroughly before using your new desktop to ensure proper functionality and to maximize your user experience.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Do not attempt to disassemble or repair the device yourself. Refer to qualified service personnel.
- Disconnect the power cord during electrical storms or when unused for long periods.

4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Lenovo IdeaCentre AIO 24IRH9 is an integrated desktop solution featuring a 23.8-inch Full HD touchscreen display. Below are various views of the device and its components.

The following ports are available on the rear and side of the device:

- **1x USB-C 3.2 Gen 2:** Supports data transfer up to 10Gbps.
- **1x USB 3.2 Gen 2:** Supports data transfer up to 10Gbps.
- **2x USB 2.0:** For connecting standard USB devices.
- **1x HDMI 1.4:** For connecting an external display.
- **1x RJ-45:** Ethernet port for wired network connection.
- **1x Headphone/microphone combo jack:** For audio input and output.

5. SETUP

Follow these steps for the initial setup of your Lenovo IdeaCentre AIO 24IRH9:

1. **Unpack the Device:** Carefully remove the All-in-One desktop, keyboard, mouse, power cord, and other accessories from the packaging.
2. **Position the Desktop:** Place the desktop on a stable, flat surface with adequate ventilation.
3. **Connect Peripherals:** Insert the USB receiver for the wireless keyboard and mouse into an available USB port on the desktop. Ensure batteries are installed in the keyboard and mouse.
4. **Connect Power:** Connect the power cord to the desktop's power input and then plug it into a wall outlet.
5. **Power On:** Press the power button, typically located on the side or rear of the display stand, to turn on the desktop.

6. **Initial Windows Setup:** Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the Windows 11 Pro setup, including language, region, network connection, and user account creation.

6. OPERATING YOUR DESKTOP

Your Lenovo IdeaCentre AIO 24IRH9 comes pre-installed with Windows 11 Pro, offering a user-friendly interface and a range of features.

6.1 Basic Navigation

- **Mouse and Keyboard:** Use the wireless mouse to navigate the cursor and click on items. The keyboard is used for typing and executing commands.
- **Touchscreen:** The 23.8-inch FHD display supports touch input. You can tap, swipe, pinch, and zoom directly on the screen for intuitive interaction.

6.2 Connecting to the Internet

- **Wi-Fi:** Click the network icon in the taskbar, select your desired Wi-Fi network, enter the password, and click Connect.
- **Ethernet:** Connect an Ethernet cable from your router or modem to the RJ-45 port on the desktop. The connection should be established automatically.

6.3 Using the Webcam

The integrated 5.0MP camera with a privacy shutter can be used for video calls and conferences. Ensure the privacy shutter is open when using the camera.

7. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Regular maintenance helps ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your desktop.

- **Cleaning the Screen:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water or a screen cleaner specifically designed for electronic displays. Do not spray cleaner directly onto the screen.
- **Cleaning the Chassis:** Wipe the exterior surfaces with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners.
- **Software Updates:** Regularly check for and install Windows updates and driver updates to maintain system security and performance.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure that the ventilation openings are not blocked to prevent overheating.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your desktop.

8.1 No Power

- Ensure the power cord is securely connected to both the desktop and a working power outlet.
- Verify that the power outlet is functional by plugging in another device.

8.2 Display Issues

- If the screen is blank, ensure the desktop is powered on and not in sleep mode.
- Adjust the display brightness settings.

8.3 Keyboard or Mouse Not Responding

- Check the batteries in the wireless keyboard and mouse and replace them if necessary.
- Ensure the USB receiver is properly inserted into a USB port.
- Try moving the receiver to a different USB port.

8.4 No Internet Connection

- For Wi-Fi, ensure you are connected to the correct network and have entered the password correctly.
- For Ethernet, check that the cable is securely connected to both the desktop and the router/modem.
- Restart your router/modem.
