1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly, setup, usage, and maintenance of your Outsunny 2-piece Galvanized Raised Garden Bed. Designed for outdoor gardening, these metal planter boxes offer a stable and supportive environment for growing vegetables, flowers, and other plants. Please read this manual thoroughly before beginning assembly or use to ensure proper installation and safe operation.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Adhere to the following safety guidelines to prevent injury and ensure the longevity of your raised garden beds:

- **Sharp Edges:** While the product includes protective rubber edging, exercise caution during assembly and handling of metal panels to avoid cuts. Wear the provided gloves.
- **Stable Placement:** Ensure the garden bed is placed on a level, stable surface to prevent tipping once filled with soil and plants.
- **Weight:** Once filled with soil, the garden beds will be very heavy. Do not attempt to move them after filling. Plan your placement carefully.
- **Children and Pets:** Keep children and pets away from the assembly area. Supervise children around the filled garden beds.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present before beginning assembly. The package includes:

- Galvanized Steel Panels (for two raised beds)

- Fasteners (screws, nuts, washers)
- Rubber Strap Edging (for top perimeter)
- Metal Plant Support Stakes
- Assembly Tools (wrench, screwdriver)
- Gardening Gloves
- Instruction Manual

4. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly is required for the Outsunny Galvanized Raised Garden Beds. Follow these steps carefully:

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging. Lay them out and identify each component using the parts list in your manual.
2. **Form the Bed Shape:** The galvanized steel panels are flexible. Connect the panels using the provided screws, nuts, and washers to form the desired oval or rectangular shape for each bed. Ensure all connections are secure but do not overtighten initially.
3. **Install Internal Braces (if applicable):** For longer configurations, internal braces may be included to maintain structural integrity. Attach these as indicated in the specific diagram for your chosen shape.
4. **Apply Safety Edging:** Once the main structure is assembled, carefully fit the rubber strap edging along the top perimeter of the metal panels. This protects against sharp edges and provides a finished look.
5. **Tighten All Fasteners:** After the rubber edging is in place, go back and securely tighten all screws and nuts.

5. SETUP AND PLACEMENT

Consider the following when choosing a location and setting up your raised garden beds:

- **Sunlight:** Most vegetables and flowers require at least 6-8 hours of direct sunlight per day. Choose a location that receives adequate sun exposure.
- **Drainage:** The beds feature an open-bottom design, allowing for direct contact with the ground and natural drainage. Ensure the chosen area has good soil drainage to prevent waterlogging.
- **Accessibility:** Position the beds in a way that allows easy access for planting, watering, and harvesting from all sides.
- **Level Ground:** Place the beds on level ground to ensure even soil distribution and prevent structural stress.

6. USAGE

Once assembled and placed, your raised garden beds are ready for planting:

1. **Fill with Soil:** Fill the beds with a high-quality gardening soil mix. The open bottom allows roots to extend into the native soil, so consider the soil composition beneath the bed.
2. **Planting:** Plant your desired vegetables, herbs, or flowers according to their specific spacing and depth requirements.
3. **Utilize Plant Support Stakes:** For climbing plants like tomatoes or peas, insert the included metal plant support stakes into the soil within the bed to provide vertical support as they grow.
4. **Watering:** Water plants regularly, especially during dry periods, ensuring the soil remains consistently moist but not waterlogged.

7. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will extend the life of your galvanized raised garden beds:

- **Cleaning:** Periodically clean the exterior of the metal panels with a mild soap and water solution to remove dirt and debris. Avoid abrasive cleaners that could damage the galvanized finish.
- **Inspect Fasteners:** Annually check all screws and nuts for tightness and re-tighten if necessary to maintain structural stability.
- **Edging Inspection:** Ensure the rubber strap edging remains securely in place. Replace if it becomes damaged or dislodged.
- **Rust Prevention:** The galvanized steel is designed to be rust-resistant. However, if any scratches or damage occur to the coating, touch up with a rust-inhibiting paint to prevent corrosion.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are solutions to common issues you might encounter:

- **Bowing Sides:** If the sides appear to bow outwards after filling with soil, ensure all fasteners are fully tightened. For very long beds, consider adding additional internal bracing if available or reducing the

soil volume slightly.

- **Poor Drainage:** If water pools in the bed, check that the open bottom is not obstructed. You may need to improve the drainage of the native soil beneath the bed by adding a layer of gravel or coarse sand before filling with topsoil.
- **Loose Edging:** If the rubber edging becomes loose, re-seat it firmly onto the metal edge. If it's stretched or damaged, it may need replacement.




Image 9.1: Product dimensions diagram.
