INTRODUCTION

The 8BitDo Ultimate 2 Wireless Controller is a versatile gaming controller designed for Windows PC and Android devices. It features advanced TMR Joysticks for enhanced precision, switchable Hall Effect/Tactile Triggers, and 8Speed Wireless Technology for ultra-low latency. This manual provides detailed instructions for setting up, operating, and maintaining your controller to ensure an optimal gaming experience.

- Customizable Controls: Features a 1000Hz Polling Rate (for 2.4G and wired connections), customizable 6-Axis Motion Control, Turbo function, and Rumble vibration. All customizable via 8BitDo Ultimate Software V2.
- Enhanced Ergonomics: Includes 2 Pro back paddle buttons, extra R4/L4 bumpers, and tactile bumpers & D-pad for improved control and faster response.
- **Convenient Charging:** Comes with a multifunctional charging dock and a USB-C adapter for seamless connectivity and charging.

SETUP

1. Initial Setup & Firmware Update

Before first use, it is highly recommended to update the controller's firmware to ensure optimal performance and compatibility, especially with newer systems. This process typically requires connecting the controller to a Windows or Mac computer.

- 1. Visit the official 8BitDo support website (support.8bitdo.com).
- 2. Locate the support page for the "Ultimate 2 Wireless Controller". Ensure you select the correct model based on its layout.
- 3. Download the latest firmware update tool for your operating system (Windows or macOS).
- 4. Connect your 8BitDo Ultimate 2 Wireless Controller to your computer using the provided USB-C cable.
- 5. Run the downloaded firmware update tool and follow the on-screen instructions to complete the update. This process may take some time.

2. Connecting to Windows PC

2.1. 2.4G Wireless Connection

- 1. Insert the 2.4G USB-C Wireless Adapter into an available USB-C port on your Windows PC. If your PC only has USB-A ports, you may need a USB-C to USB-A adapter (not included).
- 2. Ensure the mode switch on the back of the controller is set to '2.4G'.
- 3. Press the Home button on the controller to power it on. The controller should automatically connect to the adapter. The indicator lights on the controller will become solid when connected.

2.2. Wired Connection

- 1. Connect the controller to your Windows PC using the provided USB-C cable.
- 2. The controller will automatically switch to wired mode and be ready for use.

3. Connecting to Android Devices

3.1. Bluetooth Connection

- 1. Ensure the mode switch on the back of the controller is set to 'Bluetooth'.
- 2. On your Android device, go to Bluetooth settings and turn Bluetooth on.
- 3. Press and hold the Pair button on the controller (usually a small button near the USB-C port or on the back) until the indicator lights start flashing rapidly.
- 4. On your Android device, select "8BitDo Ultimate 2 Wireless Controller" from the list of available devices to pair.
- 5. The indicator lights on the controller will become solid when successfully paired.




Image: Two users playing a game on a tablet using both the white and black versions of the 8BitDo Ultimate 2 Wireless Controller, highlighting its Android compatibility.

4. Charging the Controller

The 8BitDo Ultimate 2 Wireless Controller comes with a dedicated charging dock for convenient power replenishment.

- 1. Connect the charging dock to a power source using the USB-C cable.
- 2. Place the controller onto the charging dock, aligning the charging pins. The controller will automatically begin charging.
- 3. The indicator lights on the controller or dock will show the charging status.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. TMR Joysticks

The TMR Joysticks offer superior sensitivity and precision. They are designed to provide accurate input for all your gaming needs. Their enhanced durability also means less wear and tear over time.

2. Trigger Mode Switch

Located on the back of the controller, this switch allows you to toggle between two trigger modes:

- Hall Effect Triggers: Provide linear, smooth input, ideal for racing games where precise acceleration/braking is crucial.
- Tactile Triggers: Offer a distinct, clicky feedback, suitable for shooting games where quick, responsive actions are preferred.

3. RGB Fire Ring

The joysticks feature an RGB Fire Ring that can be customized for various lighting effects and colors. Use the 8BitDo Ultimate Software V2 to personalize the lighting to your preference.

4. 6-Axis Motion Control

The controller supports 6-Axis Motion Control, allowing for enhanced motion-based actions in compatible games. This feature can also be customized through the 8BitDo Ultimate Software V2.

5. Back Paddle Buttons (P1, P2) and Bumpers (R4, L4)

The controller includes two programmable back paddle buttons (P1, P2) and additional R4/L4 bumpers. These can be mapped to various functions using the 8BitDo Ultimate Software V2 to provide quick access to commands and enhance your gameplay.

6. 8BitDo Ultimate Software V2

This software allows for extensive customization of your controller, including:

- Button remapping
- · Adjusting joystick sensitivity and dead zones
- · Customizing trigger actuation points
- · Setting up macros
- · Adjusting rumble vibration intensity
- Personalizing RGB lighting effects

MAINTENANCE

1. Battery Care

The controller features an internal rechargeable battery. Always charge the controller using the provided charging dock or USB-C cable. Avoid exposing the battery to extreme temperatures or physical damage.

2. Cleaning

To clean your controller, use a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn dirt, slightly dampen the cloth with water. Do not use harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or allow liquids to enter the controller's openings.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Controller not connecting:** Ensure the mode switch on the back is set correctly (2.4G for adapter, Bluetooth for Android). Verify the USB-C adapter is securely plugged in. For Bluetooth, ensure your device's Bluetooth is on and the controller is in pairing mode.
- Controller not recognized by PC/Android: Perform a firmware update as described in the Setup section. This is a common solution for initial compatibility issues.
- **Input lag or disconnections:** Ensure the controller is within the 10m range of the 2.4G adapter or Bluetooth device. Minimize interference from other wireless devices.
- **Buttons/Joysticks not responding:** Try resetting the controller (refer to the 8BitDo support website for specific reset procedures if needed). Ensure the controller is fully charged.
- **Software issues:** Ensure you have downloaded the correct version of 8BitDo Ultimate Software V2 for your controller model and operating system from the official website.


