INTRODUCTION

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning assembly and retain this manual for future reference. Proper assembly and care will ensure the longevity and safety of your loft bed.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Adherence to these safety guidelines is crucial for preventing injury and ensuring the safe use of the loft bed.

- **Weight Capacity:** The bed is designed to support a maximum weight of 350 lbs (158 kg). Do not exceed this limit.
- **Guardrails:** Ensure all guardrails on the upper bunk are securely installed and maintained to prevent accidental falls.
- **Ladder Safety:** The ladder must be securely attached to the bed frame. Always use the ladder for access to and from the upper bunk.
- **Assembly:** Assembly should be performed by at least two adults. Follow all instructions precisely.
- **Mattress Thickness:** Use a mattress with a maximum thickness of 6 inches (15 cm) for the upper bunk to ensure adequate guardrail height.
- **Ventilation:** Do not attach or hang items on any part of the loft bed that are not designed for use with the bed, for example, but not limited to, hooks, belts, and jump ropes.

- **Regular Checks:** Periodically check all bolts, screws, and connections to ensure they remain tight. Tighten as necessary.
- **No Jumping:** Do not allow jumping or rough play on the bed.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Your DERCASS Full Loft Bed will arrive in two separate packages. Please verify that all components listed below are present and undamaged before beginning assembly. If any parts are missing or damaged, contact customer support immediately.

- Loft Bed Frame Components (Pine Wood+MDF)
- Slats for Mattress Support
- Built-in Wardrobe Panels and Hardware
- Desk Surface and Support Components
- Storage Shelves
- Two Drawers with Runners and Handles
- Assembly Hardware (screws, bolts, dowels, etc.)
- Assembly Tools (e.g., Allen wrench - specific tools may vary)
- Instruction Manual

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly is required for this product. It is recommended that two adults perform the assembly. Clear a spacious area for assembly and keep all hardware out of reach of children.

Step 1: Unpacking and Component Identification

Carefully unpack both packages. Lay out all components on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches. Identify each part by comparing it with the parts list provided in the separate assembly guide. Ensure all hardware is accounted for.

Step 2: Frame Assembly

Begin by assembling the main bed frame structure. Connect the long side rails to the headboard and footboard using the provided bolts and nuts. Do not fully tighten all fasteners until the entire frame is loosely assembled to allow for adjustments.

Step 3: Wardrobe and Storage Shelves Installation

Attach the wardrobe panels and storage shelf units to the designated areas of the bed frame. Follow the specific instructions in the assembly guide for securing these components. Ensure shelves are level and wardrobe doors operate smoothly.

Step 4: Desk and Drawers Integration

Install the desk surface and its supporting structure. Assemble the drawers according to the instructions, attach the runners, and slide them into their designated slots beneath the storage shelves. Ensure drawers open and close freely.

Step 5: Final Checks

Once all components are assembled, go back and fully tighten all bolts and screws. Ensure the bed is stable and level. Install the mattress slats evenly across the bed frame. Place a full-size mattress (maximum 6 inches thick) on the upper bunk.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using the Loft Bed

The upper bunk is designed for sleeping. Always use the provided ladder for safe access. Ensure the mattress fits snugly within the frame and does not exceed the recommended thickness of 6 inches to maintain guardrail effectiveness.

Utilizing the Built-in Desk

The integrated desk provides a dedicated workspace beneath the bed. It is suitable for studying, working, or creative activities. Avoid placing excessively heavy items on the desk surface.

Accessing the Wardrobe

The wardrobe features a sliding door for convenient access to stored items. Gently slide the door to open and close. Do not force the door if it encounters resistance.

Using Storage Shelves and Drawers

The three-tier storage shelves and two drawers offer ample space for books, personal items, and clothing. Distribute weight evenly across shelves and within drawers to maintain stability and prevent damage.

Maintenance and Care

Regular maintenance will help preserve the appearance and structural integrity of your loft bed.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the surfaces with a dry cloth. For stubborn marks, a slightly damp cloth followed by a dry cloth can be used. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Hardware Checks:** Periodically (e.g., every 3-6 months) inspect all bolts, screws, and connections. Tighten any loose hardware to ensure the bed remains stable and secure.
- **Environmental Conditions:** Avoid exposing the bed to extreme temperature changes or high humidity, which can affect the wood and finish.
- **Moving the Bed:** If you need to move the bed, lift it rather than dragging it to prevent damage to the frame and floor. For significant moves, partial disassembly may be necessary.

Troubleshooting

Here are solutions to common issues you might encounter:

- **Bed Wobbles:**
Solution: Check all assembly hardware. Ensure all bolts and screws are fully tightened. Make sure the bed is on a level surface.
- **Drawers Stick or Don't Close Smoothly:**
Solution: Verify that the drawer runners are correctly installed and aligned. Check for any obstructions within the drawer slides. Ensure the drawers are not overloaded.
- **Wardrobe Door Does Not Slide Easily:**
Solution: Inspect the sliding mechanism for any debris or misalignment. Ensure the door is properly seated on its tracks.
- **Missing or Damaged Parts:**
Solution: Do not proceed with assembly. Contact DERCASS customer support with your product model number and a description of the issue for assistance.
