

SAFETY INFORMATION

To ensure safe operation and prevent damage to the unit, please observe the following:

- Always fully charge the cleaner before its first use.
- The cleaner is designed to operate only when fully submerged in water. Do not run it dry.
- Ensure the pool is flat-bottomed for optimal performance.
- Regularly clean the filter box to prevent clogging and maintain efficiency.
- If the cleaner is small and light for your pool, consider draining a portion of the water before use to ensure proper contact with the pool floor.
- · Keep children and pets away from the pool area during operation.
- Do not attempt to repair or modify the cleaner yourself. Contact customer service for assistance.

SETUP

Follow these steps to prepare your Redkey S100 for its first use:

1. **Charge the Cleaner:** Connect the charger to the cleaner and a power outlet. Ensure the cleaner is fully charged before its initial operation. A full charge typically takes 3-4 hours.

2. **Install Bottom Scrapers (if not pre-installed):**Locate the bottom scrapers and insert them into the designated slots on the underside of the cleaner. Ensure they are securely in place.

OPERATION

Operating your Redkey S100 is simple:

- 2. **Place in Pool:** Gently lower the cleaner into the pool. The automatic cleaning function will begin once the unit is fully submerged.

- 3. **Cleaning Cycle:** The S100 will autonomously navigate the pool floor, collecting debris. Its physical autoturnaround mechanism ensures it covers the entire flat surface.
- 4. **Self-Parking & Retrieval:** Once the cleaning cycle is complete or the battery is low, the cleaner will automatically move to the nearest pool wall. Use the provided retrieval hook to easily lift the cleaner out of the water without getting wet.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and longevity of your Redkey S100:

1. Clean the Filter Basket: After each use, remove the filter basket from the cleaner. Dispose of collected debris and rinse the filter thoroughly with a hose until clean. The filter is designed for easy removal and cleaning.

- 2. **Clean the Unit Exterior:** Rinse the exterior of the cleaner with fresh water to remove any pool chemicals or residue. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- 3. **Storage:** Store the cleaner in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures when not in use. Ensure it is clean and dry before storage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Redkey S100, please refer to the table below:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Cleaner does not turn on.	Battery is low or depleted.	Charge the cleaner fully (3-4 hours).
Cleaner stops prematurely.	Battery is low; Filter basket is clogged.	Recharge the cleaner; Clean the filter basket.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Poor cleaning performance.	Filter basket is full or clogged; Scrapers are worn or damaged.	Clean the filter basket; Inspect and replace scrapers if necessary.
Cleaner gets stuck.	Obstacle in pool; Pool surface not flat.	Remove obstacles; Ensure pool is suitable for flat-bottom cleaners.
Cleaner does not self-park.	Water sensor obstructed; Unit malfunction.	Clean water sensors; Contact customer service if issue persists.
