# Dpofirs 48MP Digital Camera User Manual

Model: Dpofirs5k0ac9du13-11

## 1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Dpofirs 48MP Digital Camera. This compact and versatile camera is designed for ease of use, offering high-resolution imaging and video recording capabilities. Please read this manual thoroughly to understand the camera's features and ensure optimal performance.

This camera is equipped with a high-transmittance glass lens, capable of capturing 48MP photos and recording 4K videos. It features a 2.4-inch screen for clear viewing and a 16x digital zoom to bring distant subjects closer. Advanced functions like AF auto-focus, anti-shake, and face detection enhance your photography experience. Multiple shooting modes are available to suit various scenes and conditions.

## 2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Upon unpacking your Dpofirs Digital Camera, please ensure all the following items are present:

- 1 x Dpofirs Digital Camera
- 1 x Instruction Manual
- 1 x Data Cable (for charging and data transfer)
- 1 x Lanyard

## 3. SETUP

### 3.1 Charging the Battery

The camera comes with a built-in 700mAh battery. Before first use, fully charge the camera using the provided data cable connected to a USB power source (e.g., computer USB port or a USB wall adapter, not included). The charging indicator light will typically show the charging status and turn off or change color when fully charged.

## 3.2 Inserting a Memory Card

This camera requires a Small Memory Card (up to 128GB, not included) for storing photos and videos.

1. Locate the memory card slot on the camera.
2. Insert the memory card with the metal contacts facing the correct direction (refer to the diagram near the slot if available) until it clicks into place.
3. To remove, gently push the card in until it springs out.

*Note: Ensure the camera is powered off before inserting or removing the memory card to prevent data corruption.*

## 3.3 Powering On/Off

Press and hold the power button (usually located on the top or side of the camera) for a few seconds to turn the camera on or off.

# 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

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## 4.1 Basic Photography and Video Recording

Once powered on, the camera will typically default to photo mode. Press the shutter button to take a picture. To switch to video mode, locate the mode button (often indicated by a camera or video icon) and press it. Press the shutter button again to start/stop video recording.

## 4.2 Using the 2.4-inch Screen

The 2.4-inch high-definition screen displays your live view, captured images, and video playback. Use the navigation buttons (up, down, left, right) and the 'OK' or 'SET' button to navigate through menus and settings.

## 4.3 16x Digital Zoom

To use the 16x digital zoom, use the zoom in/out buttons (often marked with 'W' for wide and 'T' for telephoto) while in photo or video mode. Digital zoom magnifies the image electronically.

#### 4.4 AF Auto Focus

The camera features an AF auto-focus function. When taking a photo, lightly press the shutter button halfway down to allow the camera to focus on your subject. Once focus is achieved (often indicated by a green frame on the screen), press the shutter button fully to capture the image.

#### 4.5 Multiple Shooting Modes

The camera offers various shooting modes to optimize settings for different scenarios. Access these modes through the camera's menu. Available modes include:

- **Auto:** General purpose mode for most situations.
- **Landscape:** Optimizes for wide outdoor scenes.
- **Portrait:** Ideal for capturing people, often with a softer background.
- **Sports:** Designed for capturing fast-moving subjects.
- **Aerial:** For photography from an elevated perspective.
- **Night Scene:** Enhances low-light photography.
- **Highlight:** For scenes with bright areas.
- **Backlight:** Adjusts exposure for subjects with strong light behind them.

#### **4.6 Built-in Flash**

The built-in flash provides additional illumination in low-light conditions. You can usually set the flash to Auto, On, Off, or Red-eye Reduction through the camera's menu or a dedicated flash button.

#### **4.7 Anti-Shake Function**

The anti-shake function helps to reduce blur caused by camera movement, resulting in clearer images and videos, especially in challenging conditions.

#### 4.8 Additional Functions

The camera includes several other useful features:

- **Face Detection:** Automatically detects and focuses on faces in the frame.

- **Timer:** Sets a delay before taking a photo, useful for self-portraits or group shots.
- **Slow Motion:** Records video at a higher frame rate for slow-motion playback.
- **Time Lapse:** Captures a series of images over time to create a sped-up video.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the camera body. For the lens, use a specialized lens cleaning cloth and solution. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- **Storage:** Store the camera in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and high humidity. If storing for an extended period, remove the battery.
- **Protection:** Avoid dropping the camera or exposing it to water, dust, or sand. Consider using a protective case when traveling.
- **Battery Care:** Do not expose the battery to fire or extreme heat. Charge the battery regularly, even if the camera is not in frequent use, to maintain its health.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

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If you encounter issues with your camera, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Camera does not turn on	Low battery; Battery not inserted correctly; Faulty battery.	Charge the battery fully. Ensure the battery is correctly inserted. Try a different compatible battery if available.
Images are blurry	Camera shake; Out of focus; Dirty lens; Low light.	Hold the camera steady or use a tripod. Ensure AF auto-focus is engaged. Clean the lens. Use the built-in flash or shoot in brighter conditions. Activate anti-shake function.
Memory card error	Card not inserted correctly; Card is full; Card is corrupted; Incompatible card.	Reinsert the memory card. Delete unnecessary files or use a new card. Format the card (this will erase all data). Ensure the card type and size are compatible (up to 128GB Small Memory Card).
Flash not firing	Flash is set to 'Off'; Battery is low.	Check flash settings and set to 'Auto' or 'On'. Charge the battery.
Camera freezes	Software glitch; Memory card issue.	Remove the battery for a few seconds and reinsert it. If the problem persists, try using a different memory card.
