

3. READING THE COMIC (OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS)

Reading a graphic novel is a straightforward process, but understanding the flow can enhance your experience:

1. **Open the Book:** Gently open the paperback to the first page.
2. **Panel Progression:** In Western comics, panels are typically read from left to right, and then from top to bottom on each page. Follow the speech bubbles in the same order.
3. **Speech Bubbles:** Read the text within speech bubbles to follow character dialogue. Thought bubbles (often cloud-shaped) indicate a character's internal thoughts.
4. **Sound Effects:** Onomatopoeia (e.g., "POW!", "WHAM!") are integrated into the artwork to convey sounds.
5. **Page Turning:** Turn pages carefully to avoid damage.

- **Cleaning:** For minor dust, gently wipe the cover with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners.
